

Rajiv Vidya Mission Program (SSA)

Government of India (GoI) launched Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan(SSA) with an objective to achieve Universalization of Elementary Education of Satisfactory Quality i.e., an effort to universalize elementary education by community ownership of the School System in response to the demand for quality basic education all over the country. Later, the programme Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) is renamed as Rajiv Vidya Mission (RVM). Therefore, it is an opportunity for the State Governments to develop their own vision on elementary education in partnership with Central and local Governments.

The teacher training is one of the core components to be focused for qualitative improvement of elementary education under this Programme. Under this initiative, Dr.MCR HRD Institute of Andhra Pradesh got the opportunity to impart training to School Teachers of three Districts i.e., Mahabubnagar, Medak and Nalgonda under the title "Technology for Education".

Dr.MCR HRD IAP has taken over this program from Microsoft Corp of India (P) Ltd, on 29th May 2009 along with three Faculty Members on the request of School Education Department. Since then, the Institute has continued the training program duly availing the in-house services of qualified/experienced Faculty Members under this Programme. The School Teachers have been trained on the two Computer Programmes at the Institute and its status is as follows:

- Regular Training Program – Technology for Education (12 Days)
- Refresher Training Program(4 Days)
