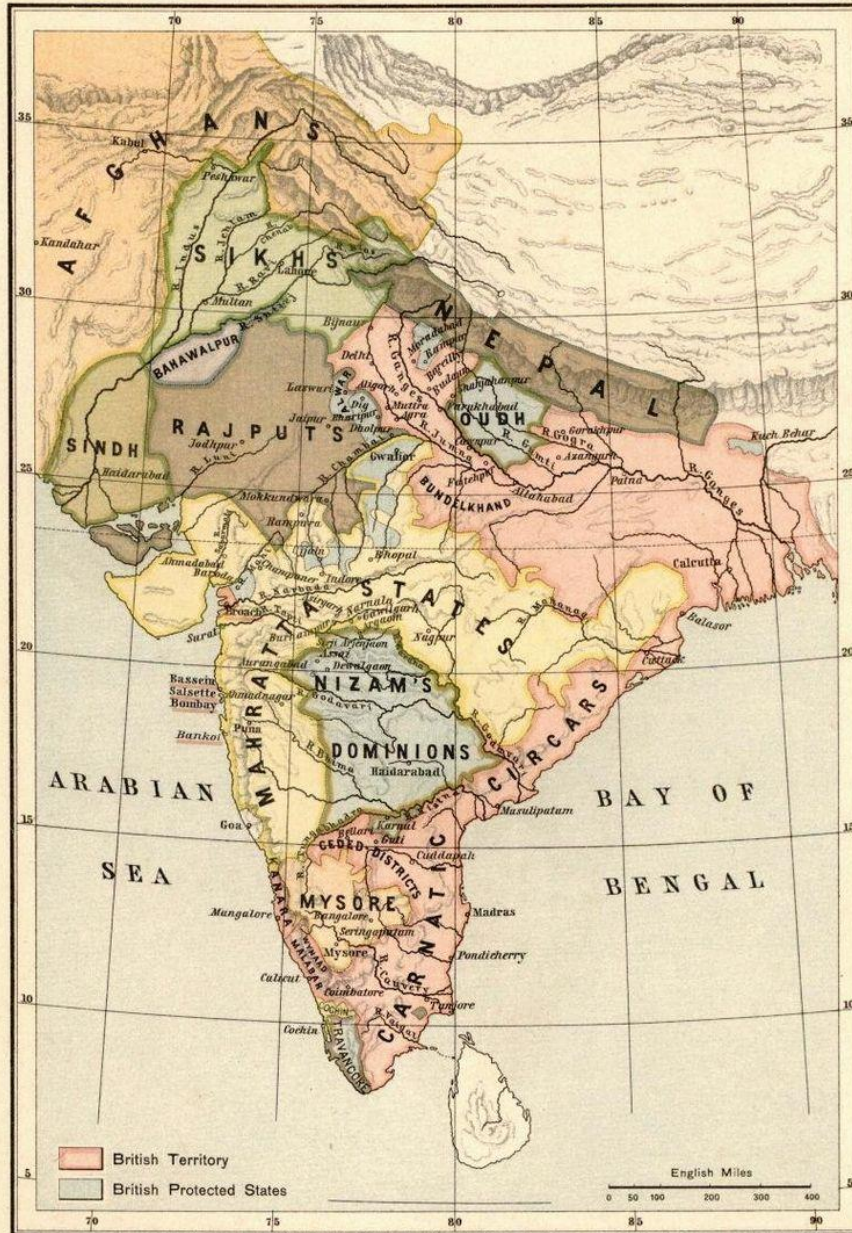

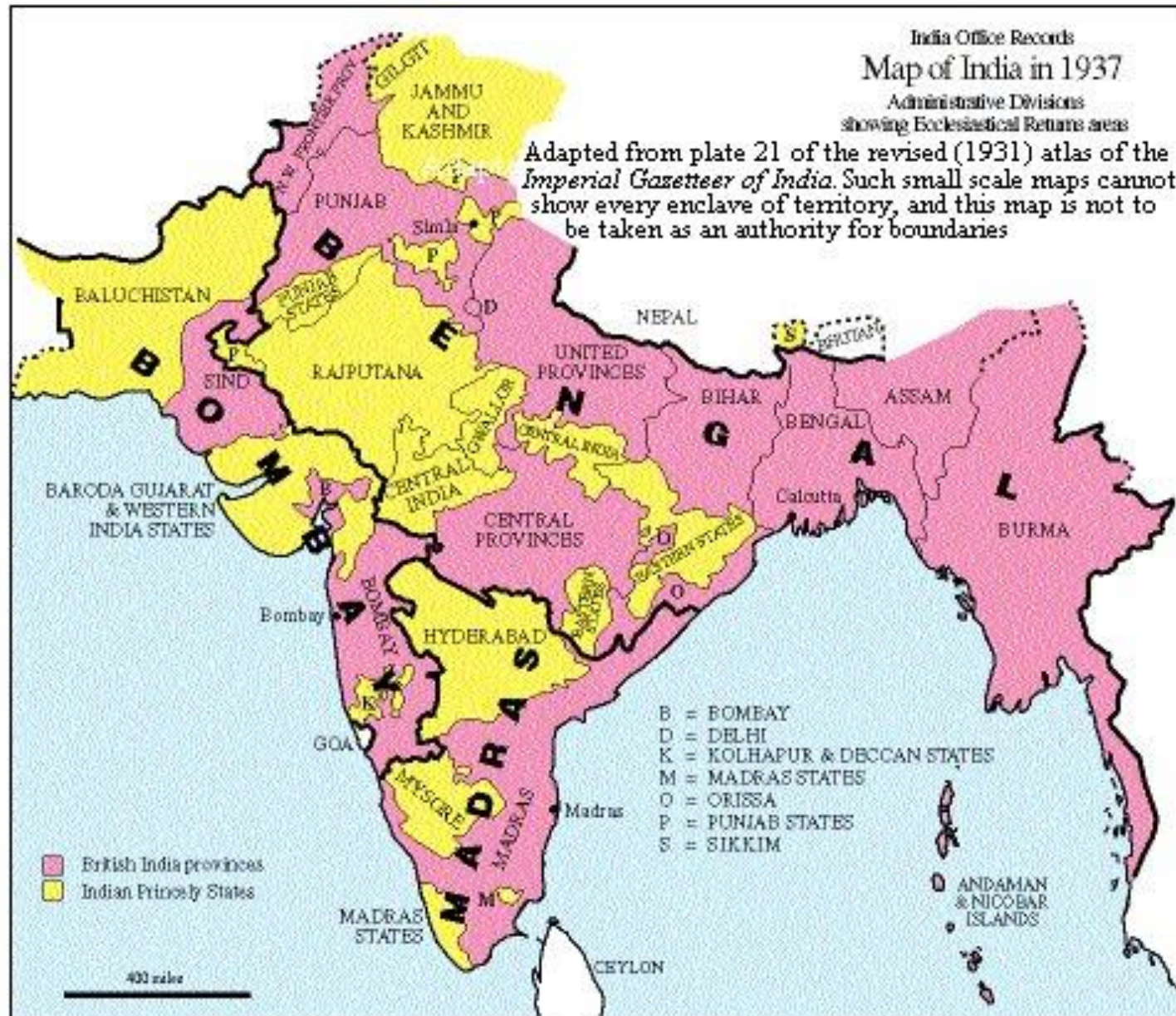




India Office Records

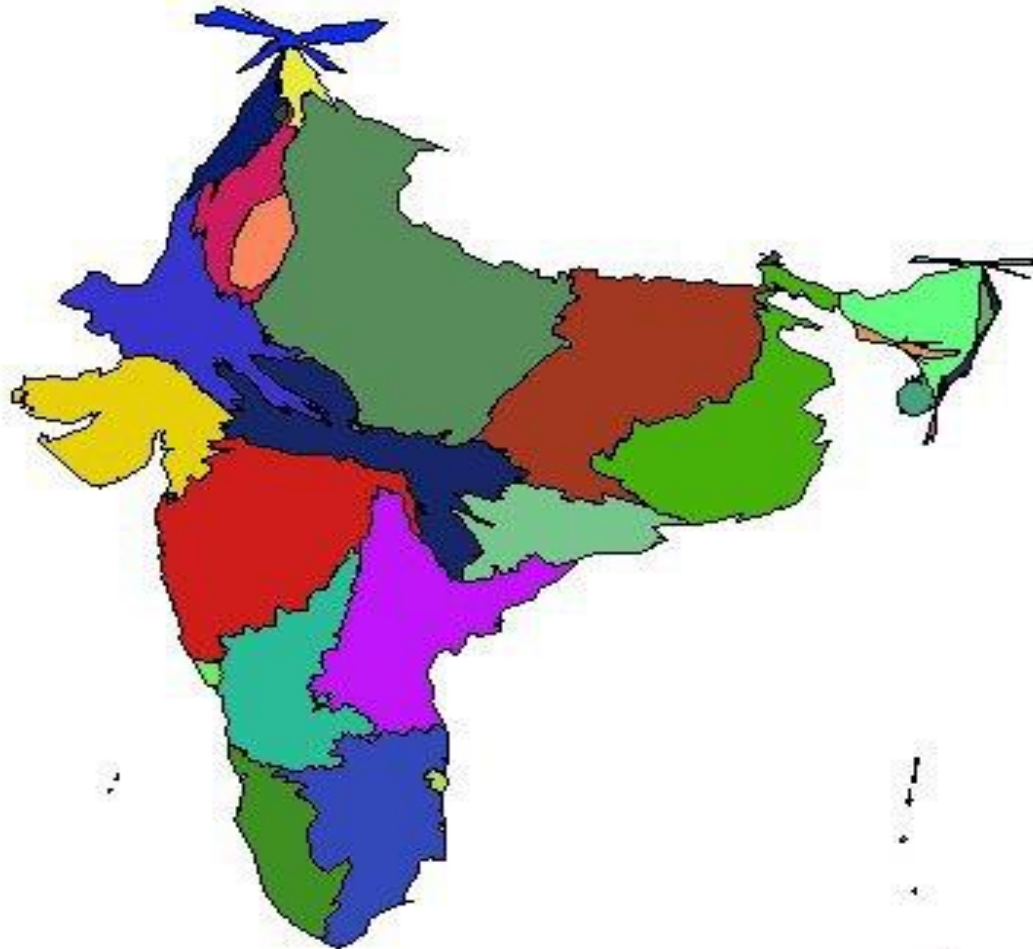

# India Population Cartogram



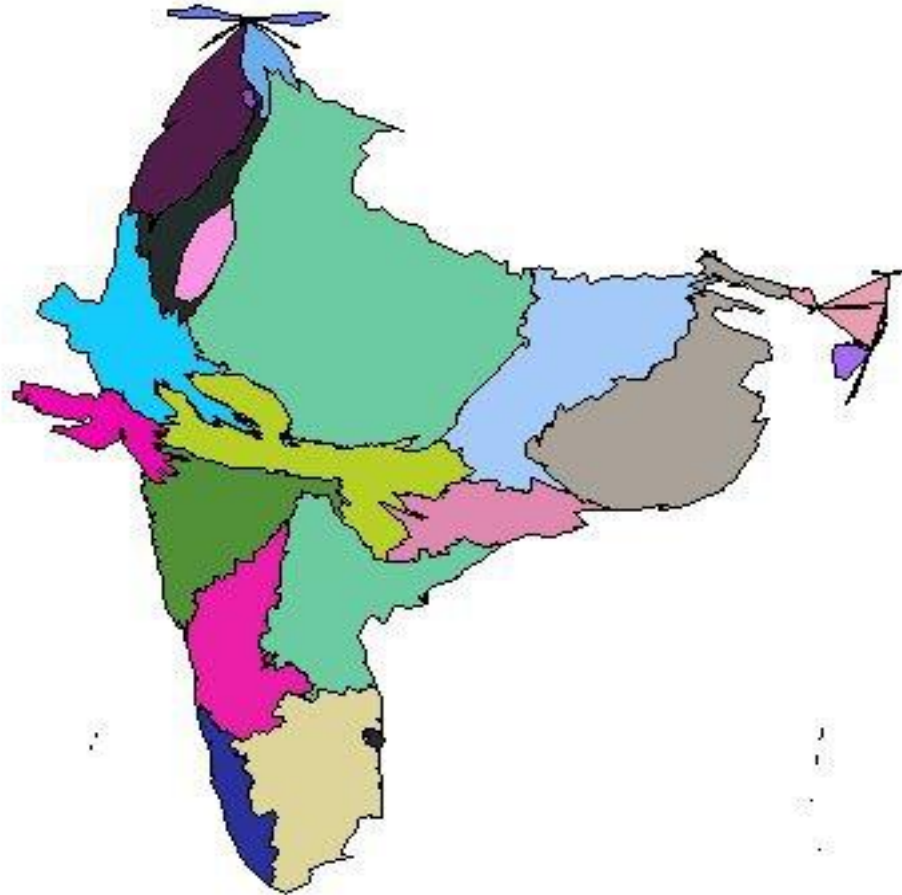
# Scheduled Tribe Population



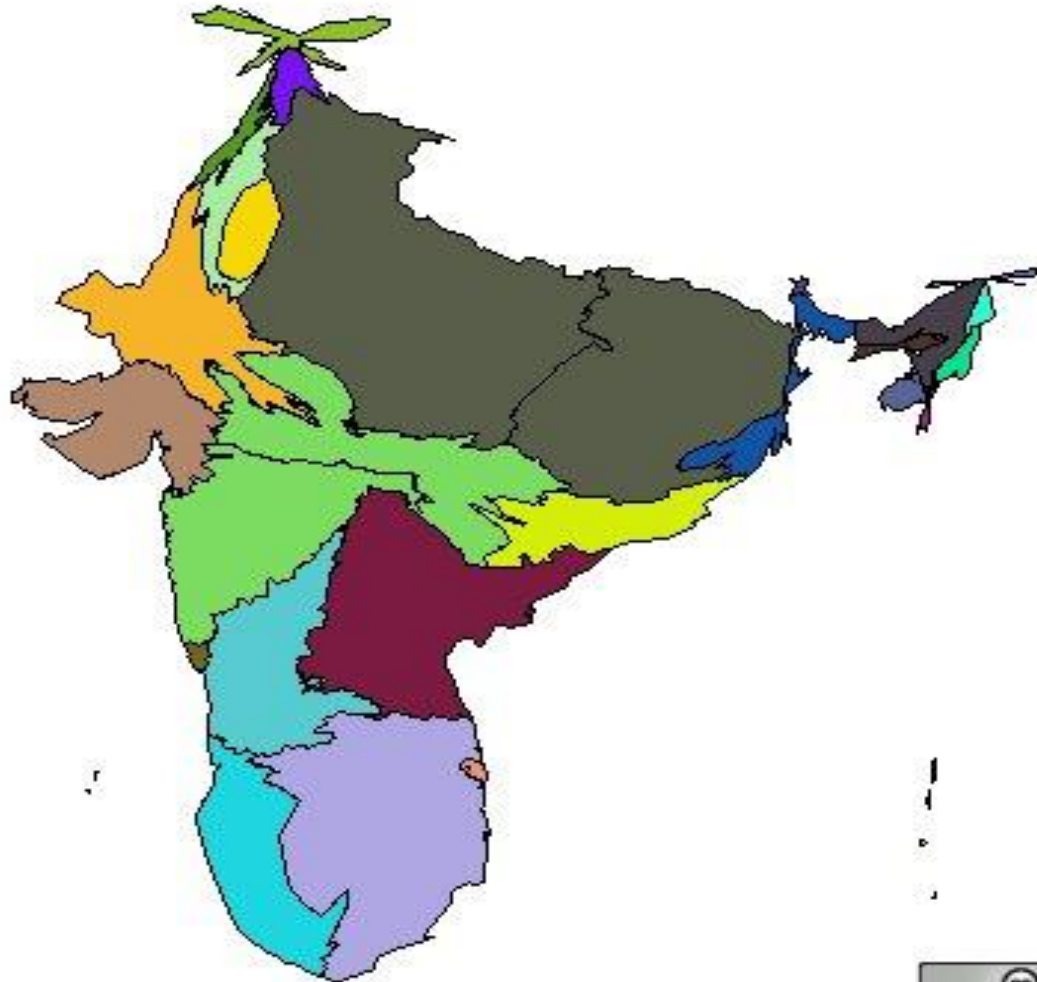


# India Scheduled Caste Population

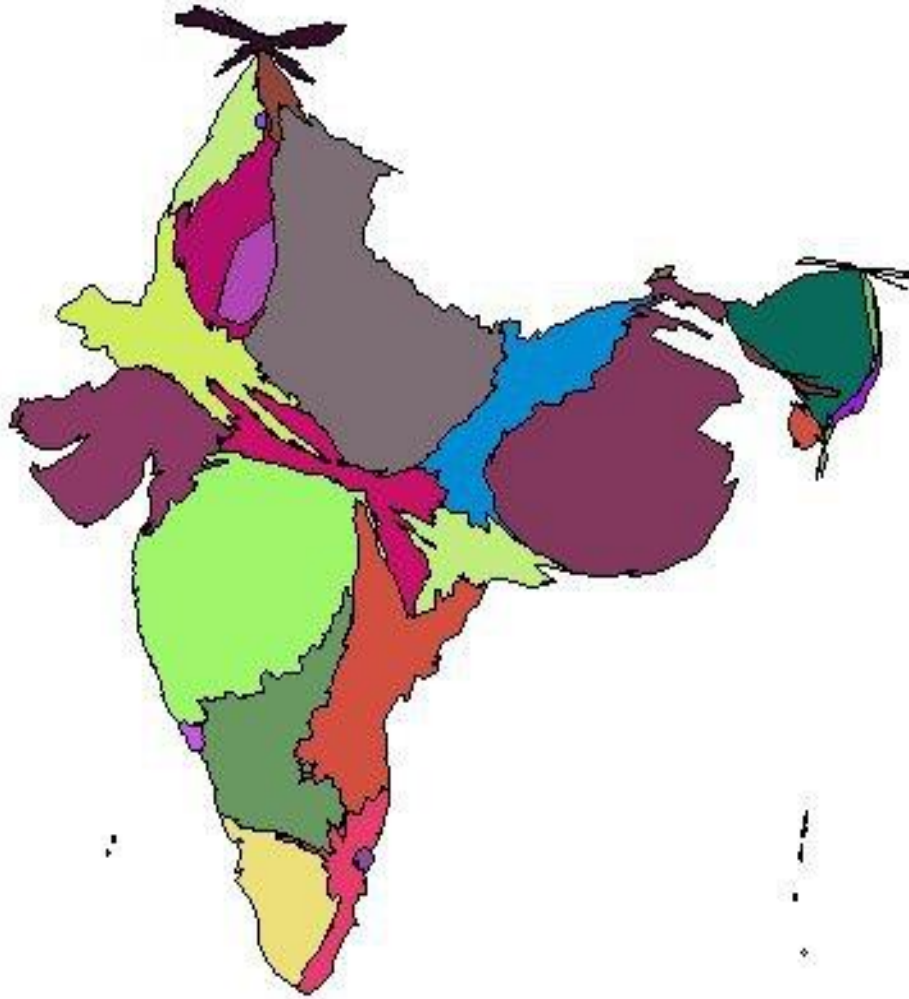

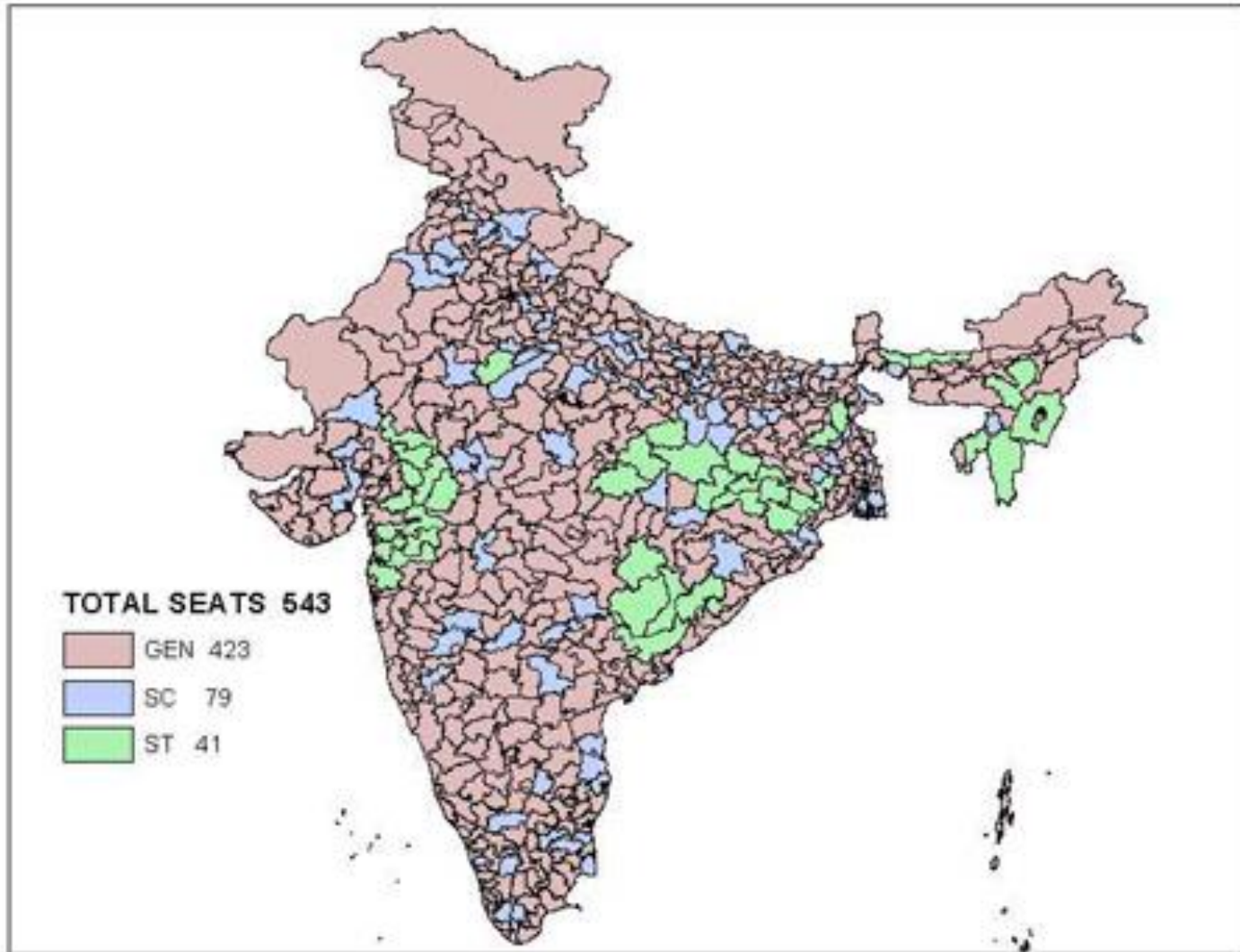


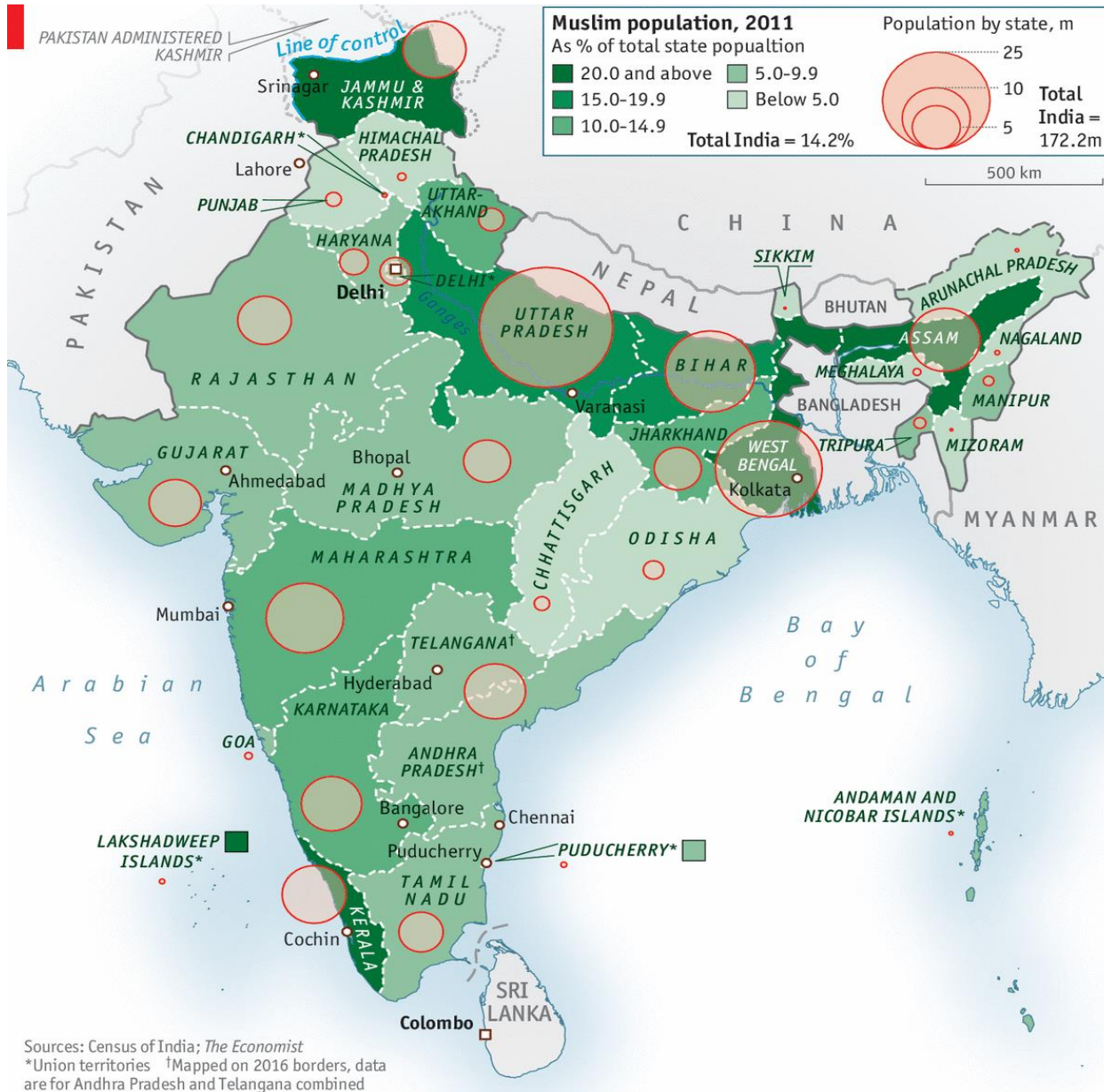

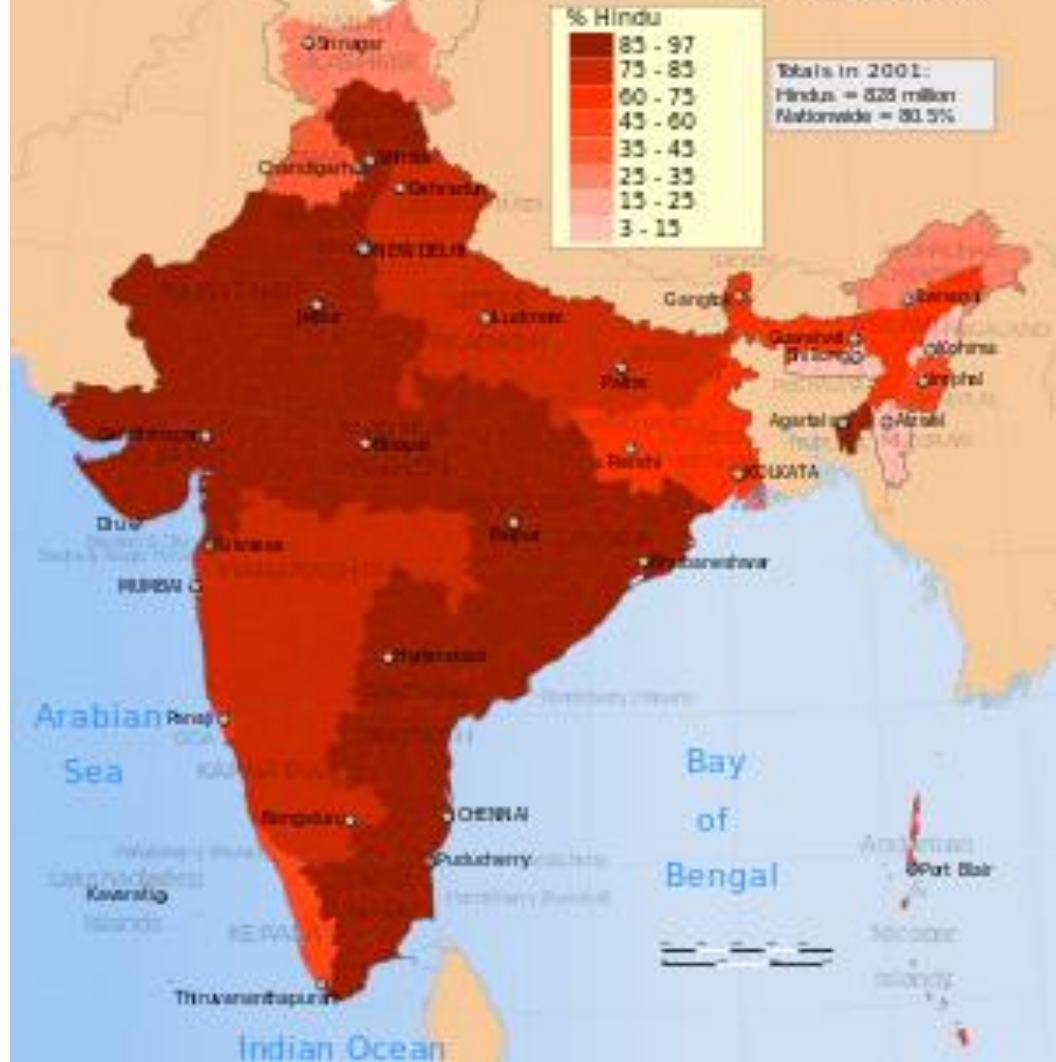
## INDIA - Existing Parliament Constituencies

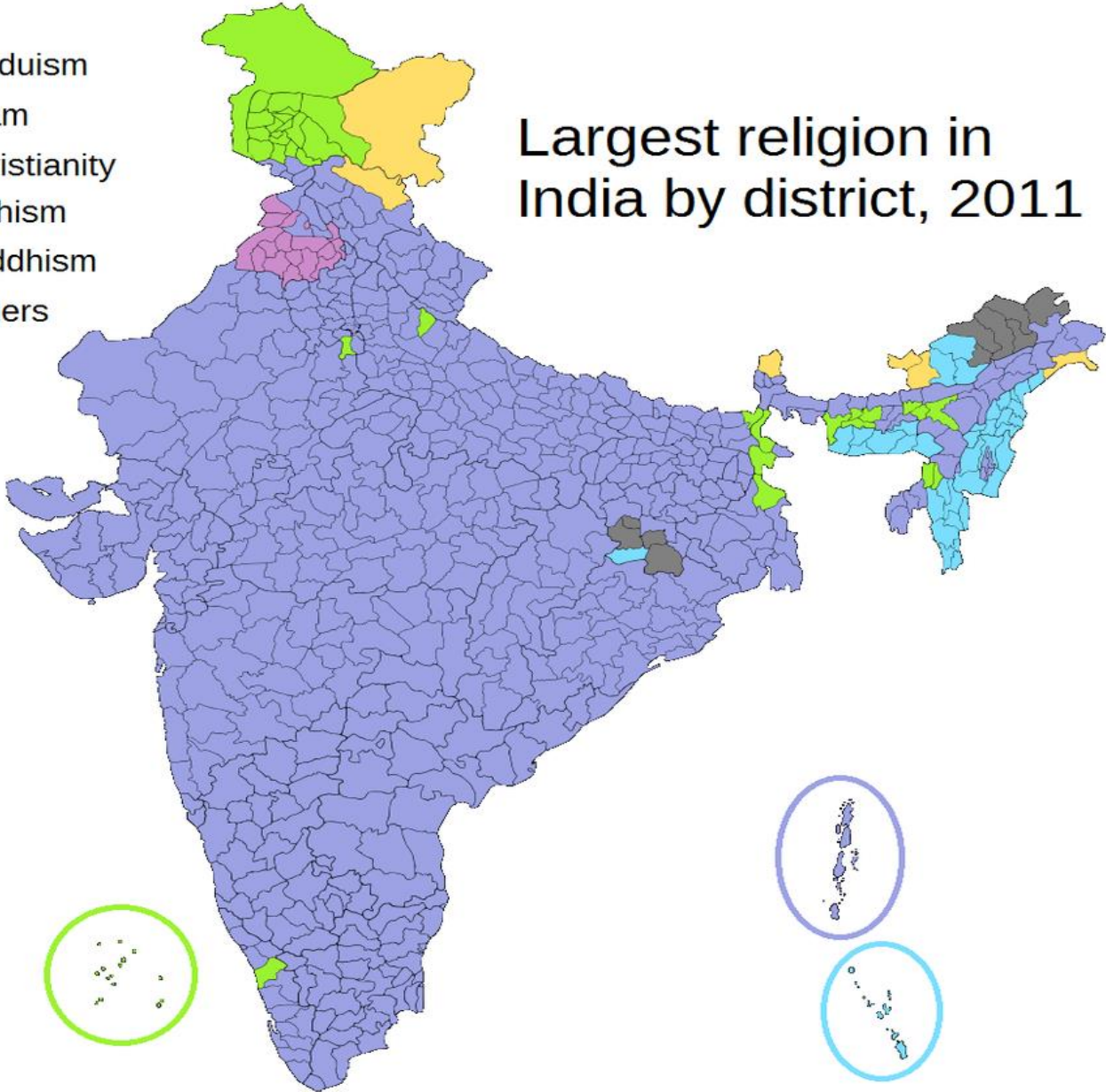
# Percent population Hindu, Indian states 2001 Census of India

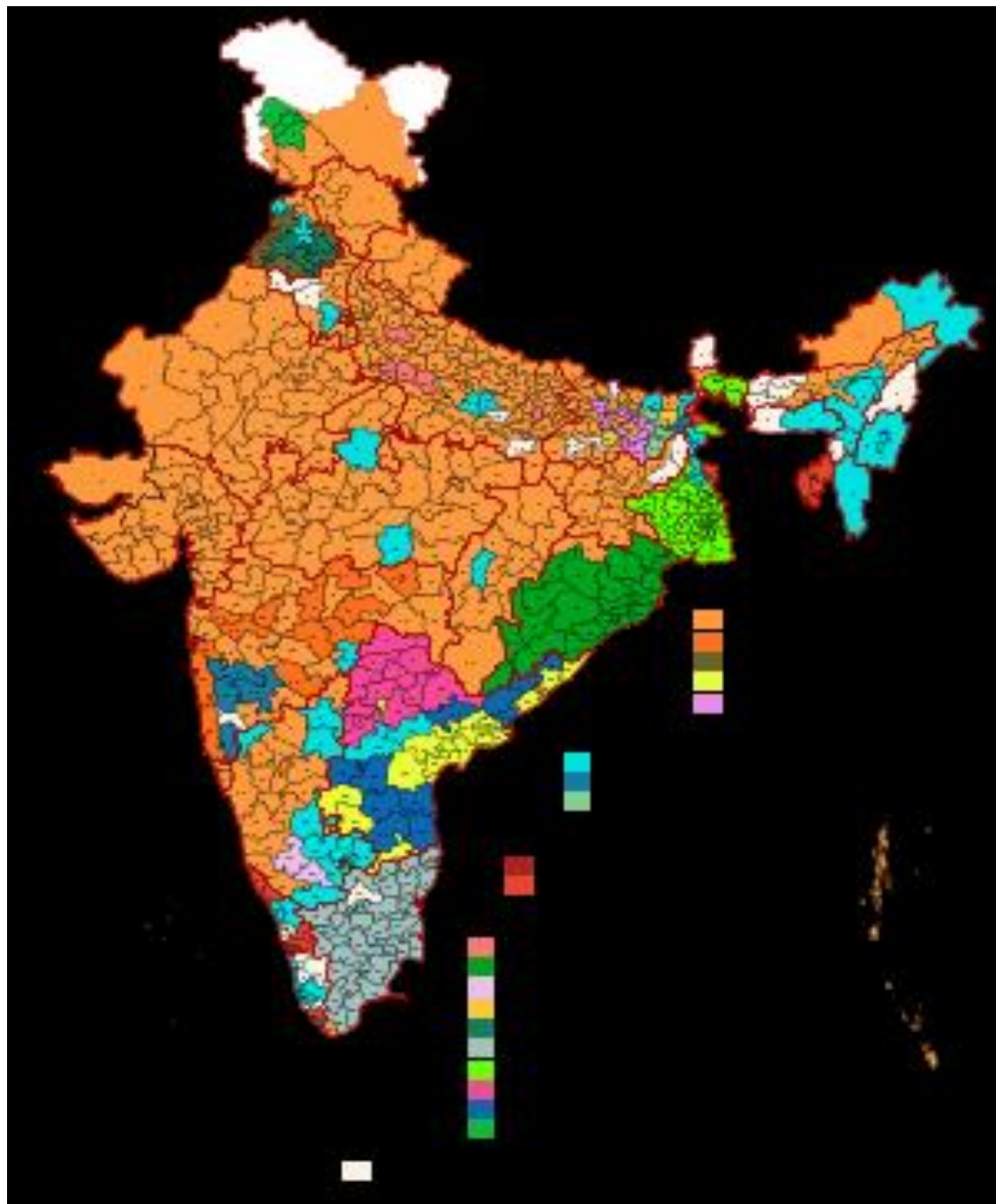


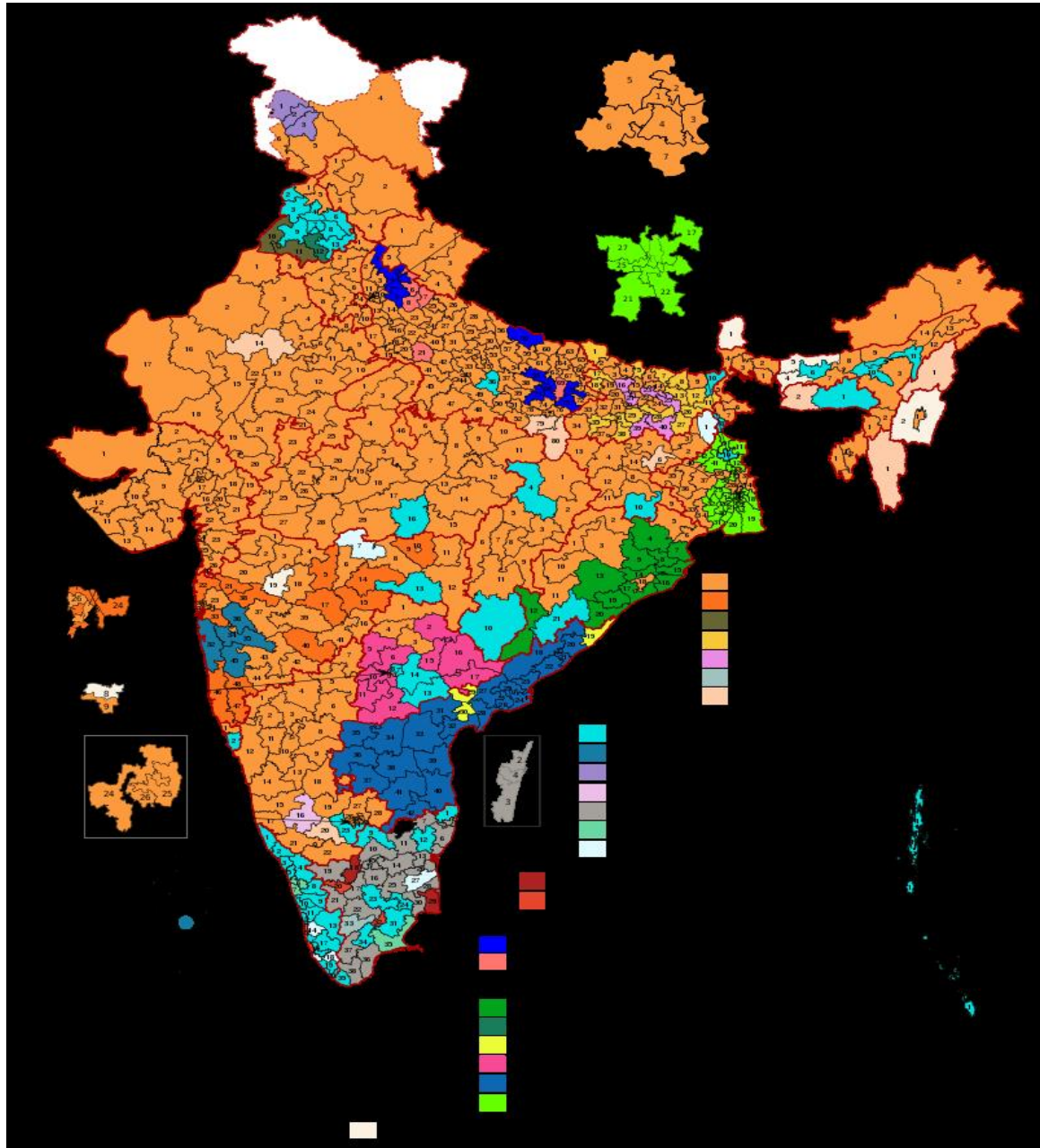


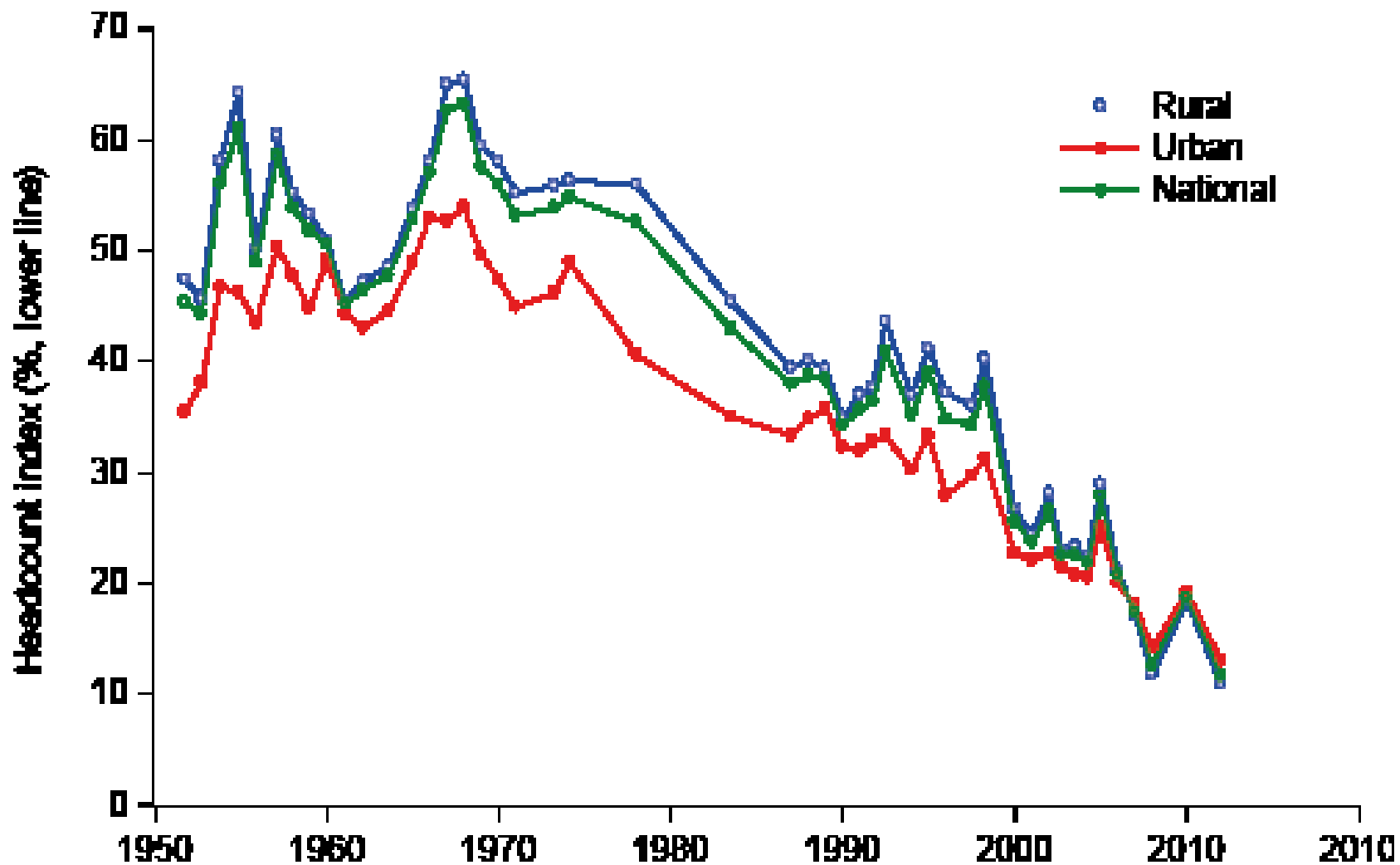
# Largest religion in India by district, 2011

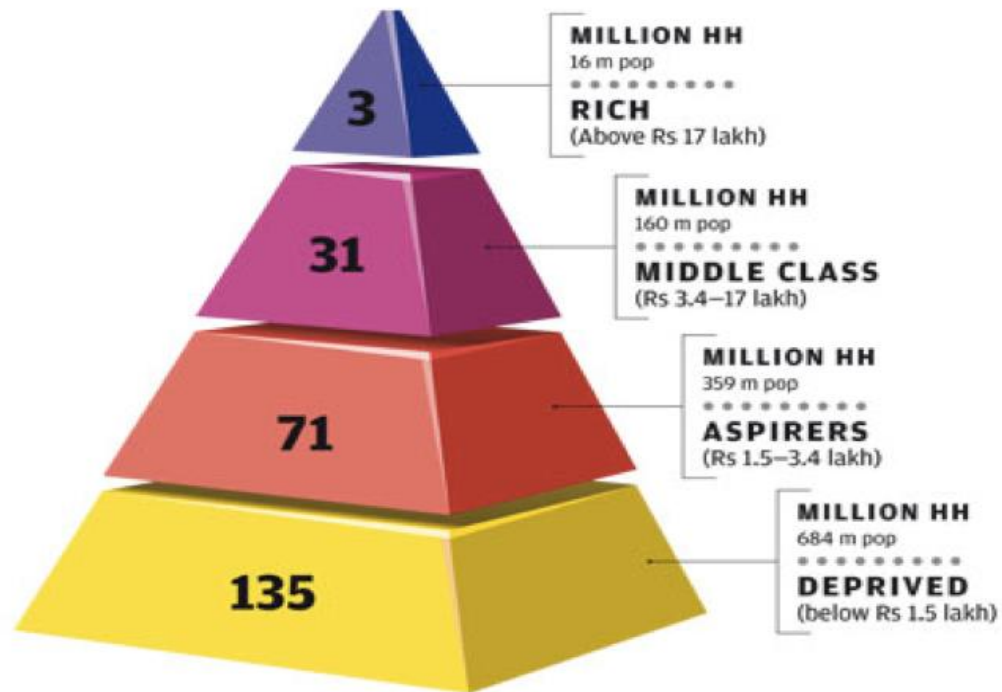






# Indian Income Pyramid

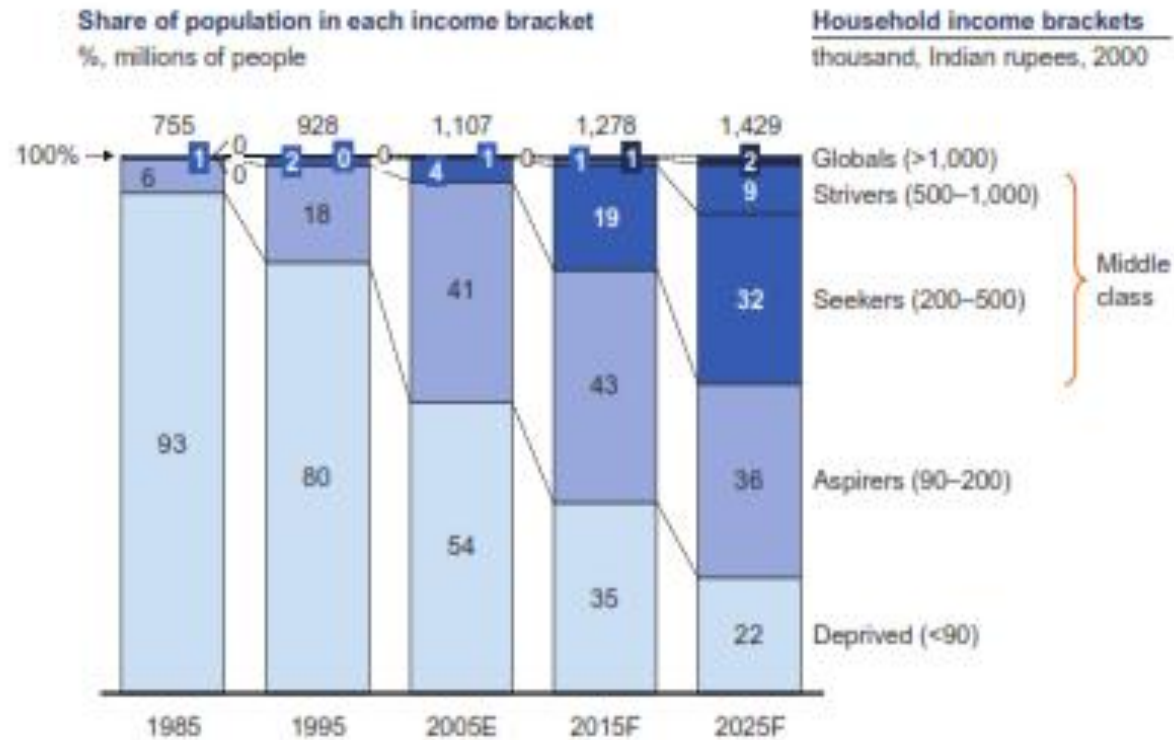
Entire country stratified by NCAER-CMCR 2010 annual income data

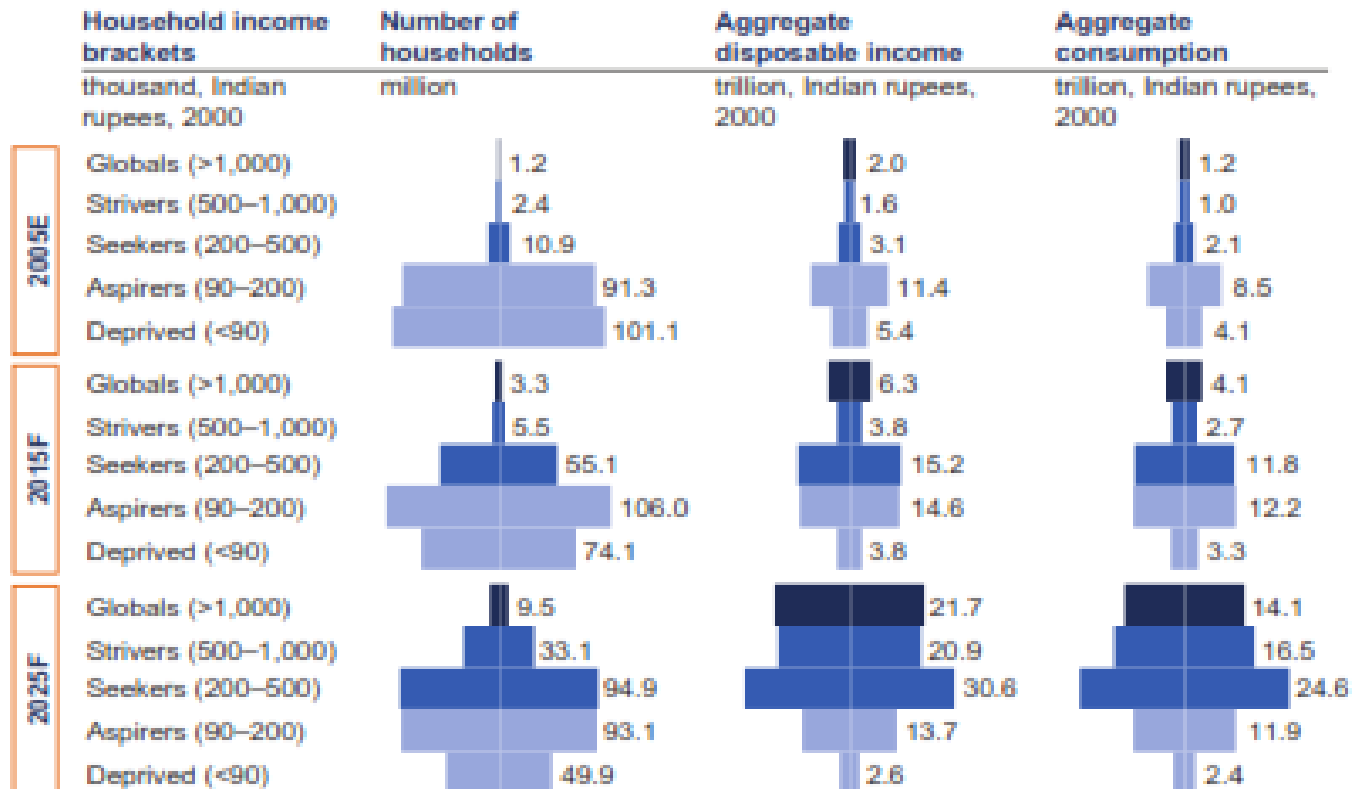
### INDIA WILL SEE FURTHER REDUCTION IN POVERTY AND GROWTH OF ITS MIDDLE CLASS
