



86th Foundation Course for Civil Service officers and Indian Forest service officers August 29th to December 9th, 2011

Dr. MCR HRD Institute of Andhra Pradesh

The course began from 29th August with joining formalities. A formal inauguration of course is done on 30th August. Sri. J.M.Lingdo the Exchief election commissioner and Raman Magsaysay award winner for public service was chief guest and Sri. Shafiquz Zaman the Director General Dr. MCR HRD IAP and Ex-officio Special Chief Secretary to the Government of Andhra Pradesh presided over the inaugural function.

Altogether there are 102 Civil Services Officer trainees representing 13 services, 26 Indian Forest Service officer trainees, 29 Indian Statistical Service officer trainees and 22 Indian Economic Service officer trainees and 1 officer trainees from Bhutan Forest Service. Together the total batch strength is 180 including 51 women officer trainees. The officer trainees represent 26 states of India.

The officer trainees are grouped in to 4 sections, 18 counselor groups, 8 trek groups, 18 book review groups, 36 village visit groups and 12 AK Sinha one act play groups, 4 Athletic meet groups. Random mixed groups are made such that maximum interaction is possible among the members of the batch. Nine clubs and societies are constituted with the elected members.

Plan is executed for conduct of 240 class room sessions for the academic inputs. The eminent speakers from ISB, IIMs, IITs, 3 RBI Governors, 3 Election commissioners, 3 Raman magsaysay awardees, Dronacharya awardee, Spic macay founder, 2 Central Ministers, have addressed the officer trainees. As many as 15 senior officer from Government of Andhrapradesh also addressed the probationers. They are as follows sri/smt.
