





Main Road is BT-Concrete Road with Potholes and Patches






### Panchayati Raj Institution

- Adequate representation of all communities with the last Sarpanch being an ST women




### **Agricultural Aspects-Major Crops**




#### Salient Features of Village Agriculture




## Seasonality Calendar of Agri Labour Demand



#### **Seasonality Calendar of Crops Sales**




