













Transect Map





Resource Map




Transect Walk Map



- ILLITERATE PARENTS
- NO ELECTRICITY FOR CLASS ROOMS

MAIN PROBLEMS OF VILLAGE SCHOOL.....

- DRINKING WATER NOT AVAILABLE THERE
- NO SEPERATE GIRLS TOILET
- MIGRATION
- POLITICAL INTERFERE
- EARLY MARRIAGE
- CHILD LABOUR

BECAUSE OF THESE PROBLEMS

- PEOPLE SEND THEIR CHILDREN TO PRIVATE SCHOOLS WHICH IS FAR FROM VILLAGE
- HIGH COST OF PRIVATE EDUCATION
- AVERAGE COST PER YEAR OF A STUDENT AROUND 15000.
- STRAIN ON FAMILY BUDGET
- TRANSPOTATION IS ALSO A BIG PROBLEM




