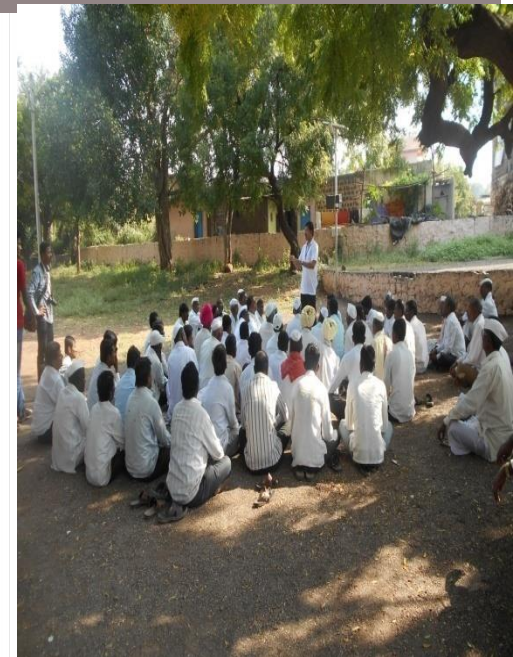

- Nirmal Gram

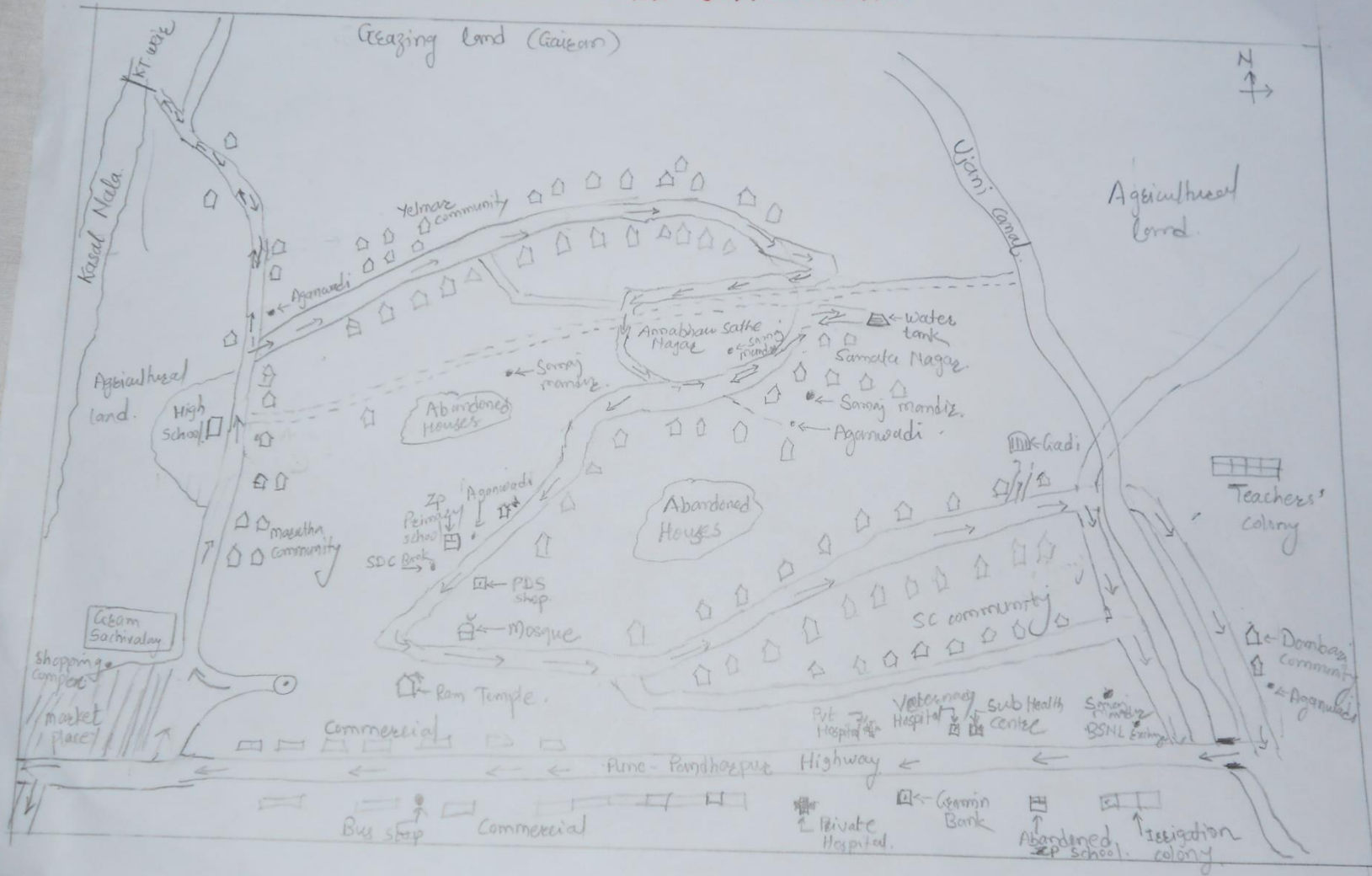

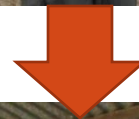

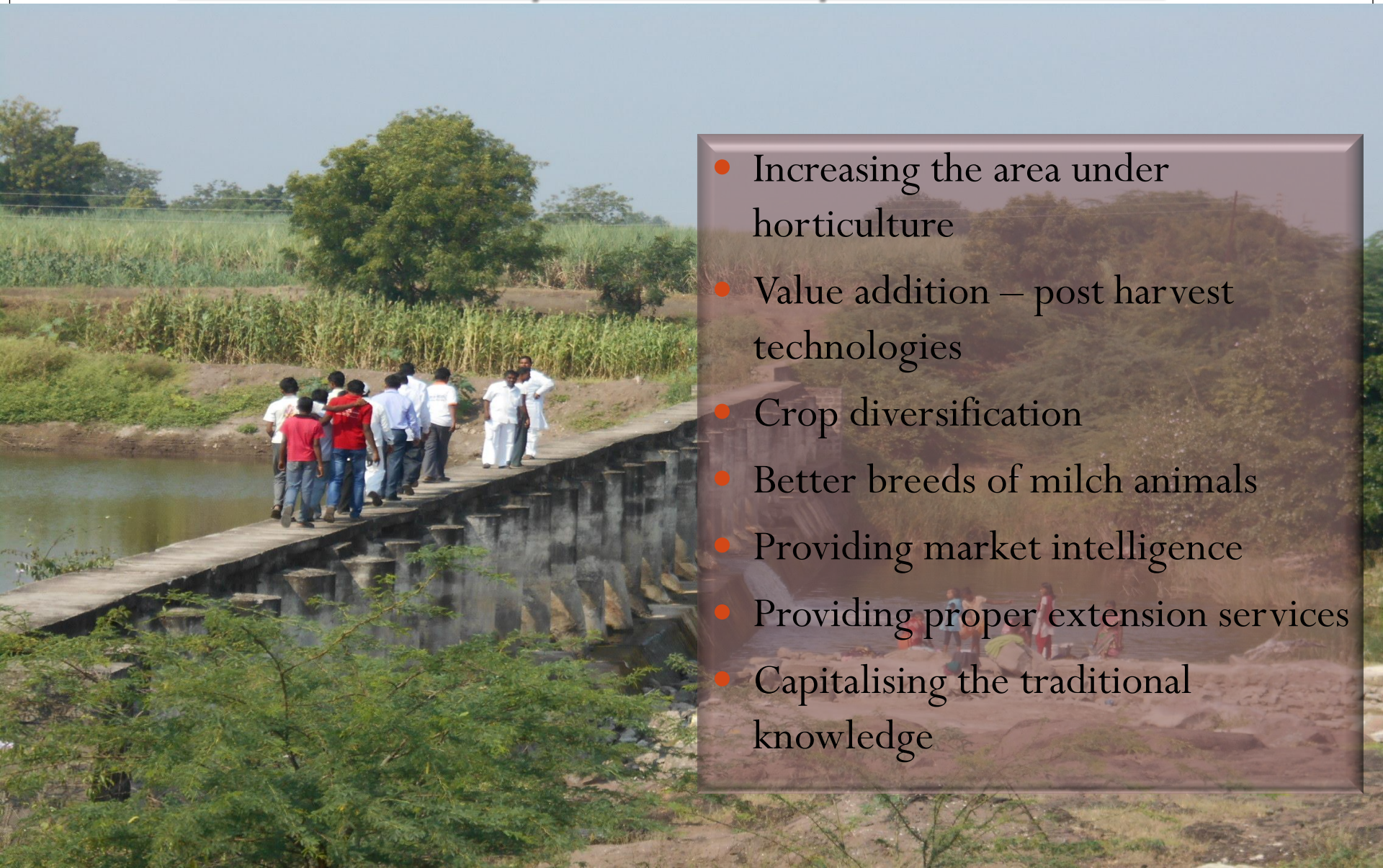
