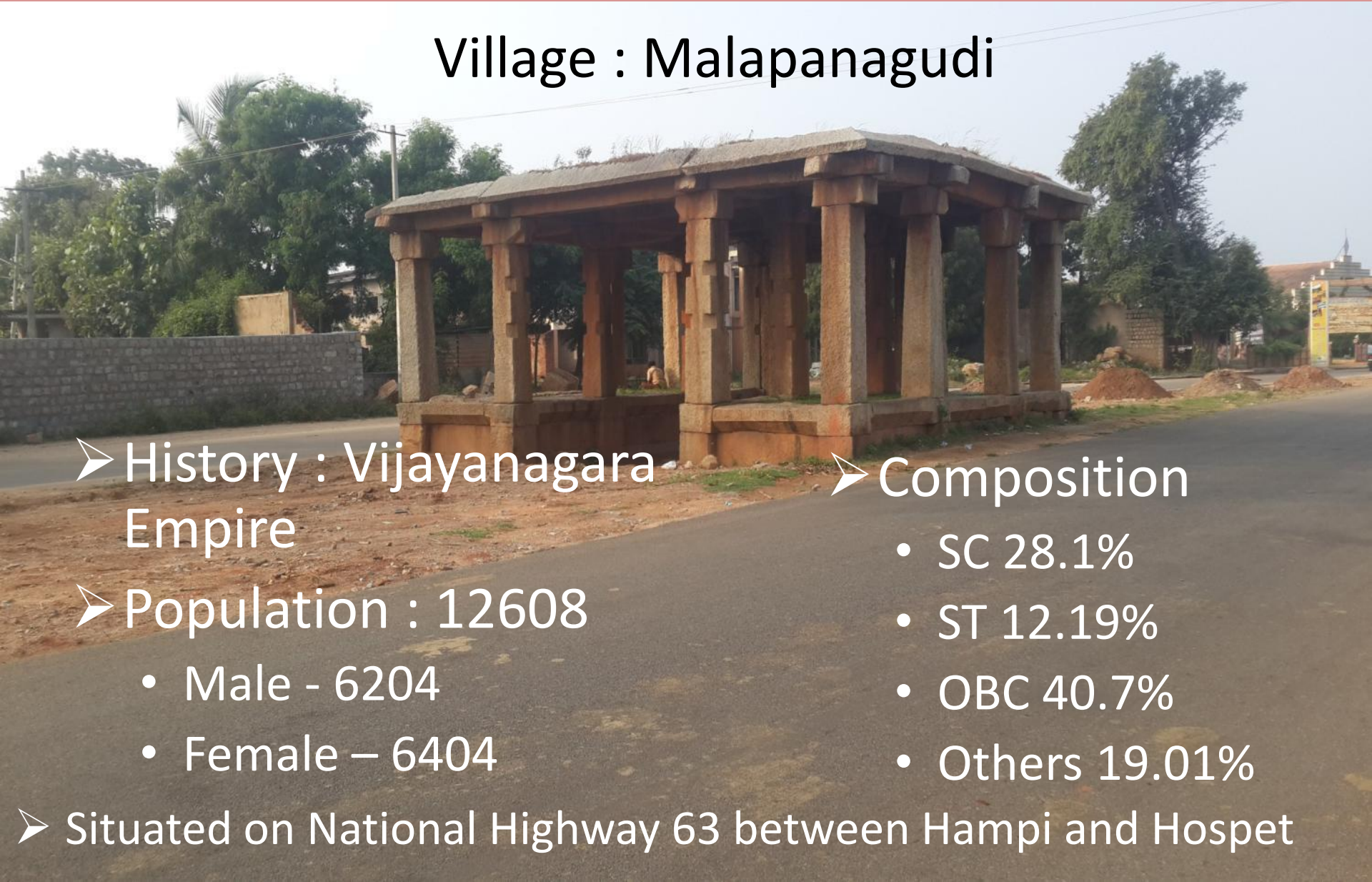

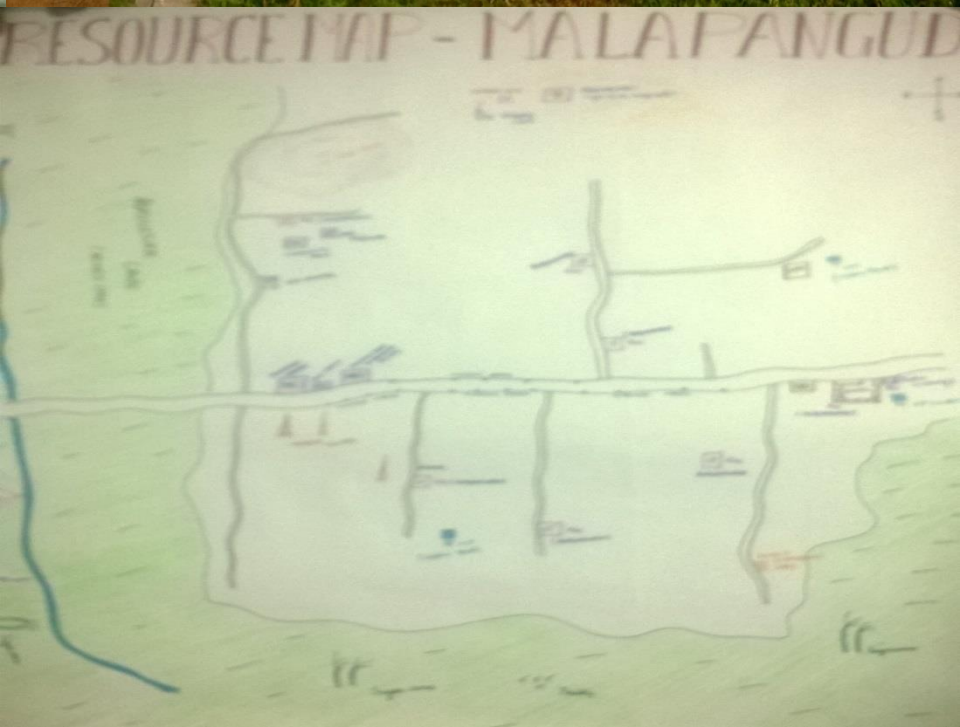

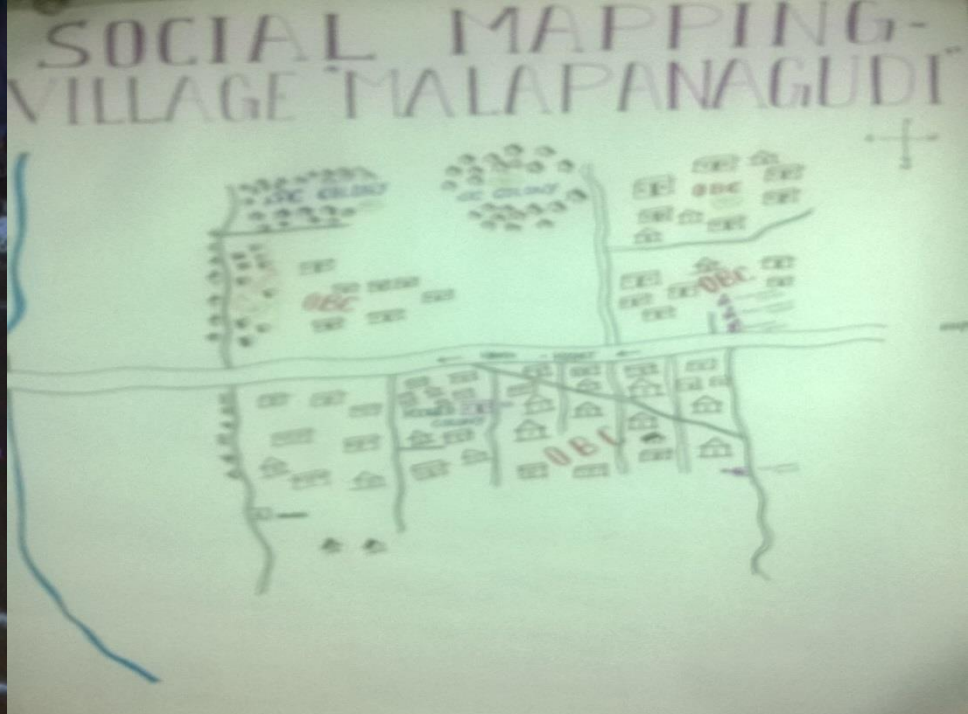

➤ Drinking Water – 3 Water Tanks (Overhead Tanks)




➤ Sanitation
