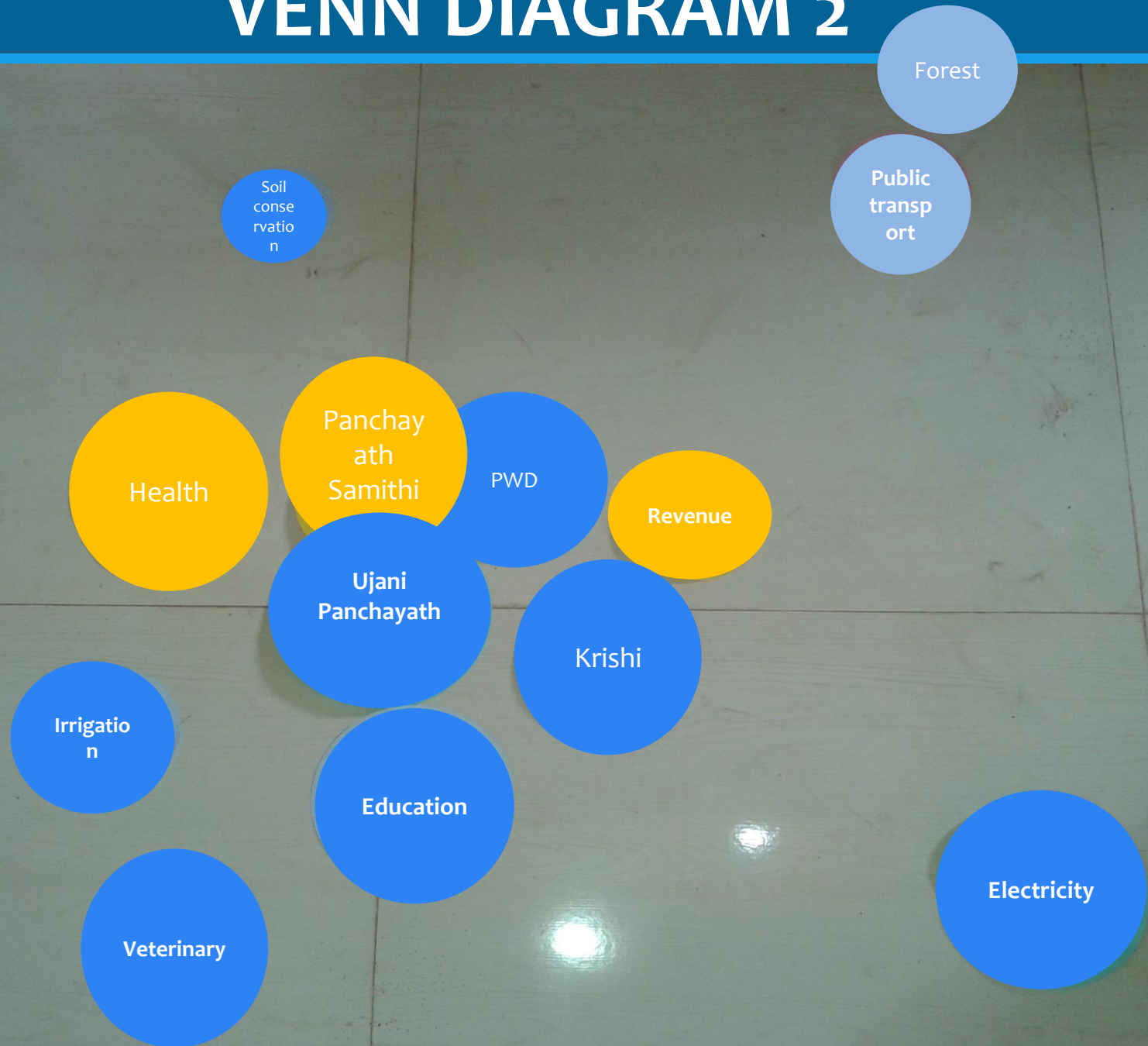

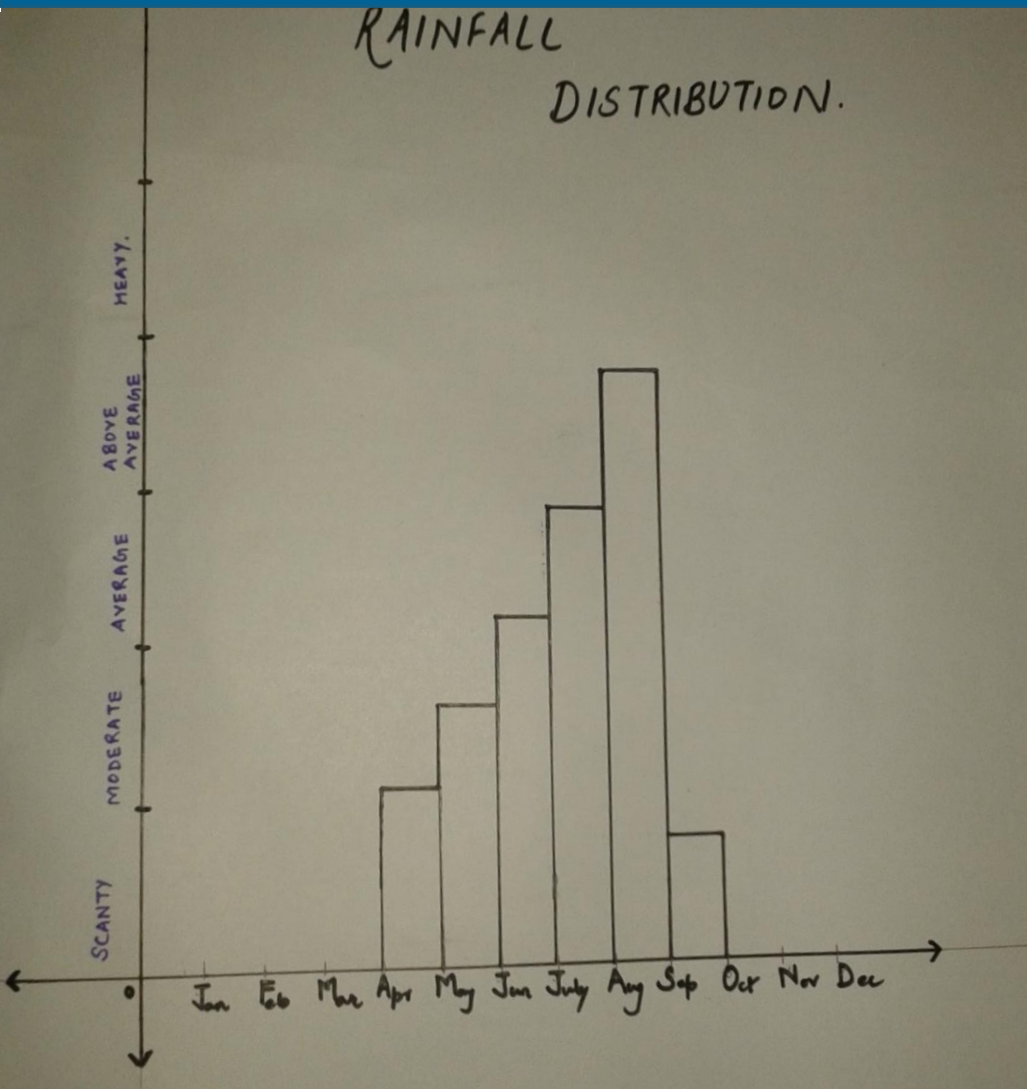

- Started in 2001-02
- One teacher and one assistant
- Two age groups: 0-3 and 3-6
- Books provided by government
- Low pay

# Financial inclusion

- \* District central co-operative bank was the main serving bank
- \* Direct cash transfers were operational
- \* Students had their accounts with Bank of India
- \* Small “path sanstha”
- \* Rate of interest: 15-18%

# ➤ Health

- \* “Epidemic and disease free”
- \* Government provision of free medicines
- \* Problems...
  - Trust deficit...
  - No quality public/private hospital
  - No veterinary doctor
  - Need for AIDS awareness
