WHY COMPARE CHINA & INDIA?

- Two largest populations: World 7,121 m
 China 1,361 million, One in Five
 India 1,236 million, One in Six
- Two Ancient Civilizations
- Both Developing Asian Countries
- Colonial Domination by Foreign Powers
- 21st Century will be of China and India

HISTORICAL BACKGROUND OF CHINA

Homogeneity

- Unified in 221 BC by Ch'in dynasty92% belong to Han stock
- One written script for Cantonese and North
- ♦ Strong Central Rule by Emperors; Confucius
- ♦ An Educated Central Civil Service 2000 yrs
- ◆ Chinese Inventions: Compass, Printing, Abacus, Paper, Gunpowder, Rudder, Porcelain, Gunpowder, Kite, Silk, Seismograph, Long bridges, Irrigation, Flying Toys, Double Hulled Ship;

HUMILIATION OF CHINA BY FOREIGN POWERS

- Opium Wars–1830's; Lin Tse-hsu, Imperial Commr. 1839 Treaty of Nanjing – Legalizn of Opium trade, "Extra-Territoriality", Freedom to spread Chr'nty; 1895-Japan deftd. China;
- Boxer Rebellion 1900—"Righteous and Harmonious Fists"—European Powers got right to maintain military in China, Hongkong came under British Rule, Civil Service exam suspended, import of arms by China banned
- 1938 Japan annexes Manchuria; Nanjing massacre 200,000 killed; Slaughter for 6 wks

MODERN CHINA

- 1911 Qing dynasty overthrown by Sun Yat-sen and Republic of China formed.
- Immediately after this Chiang Kai-shek of Kuomintang Party captures power.
- 1921 Chinese Communist Party formed.
- 1931 Mao Zedong becomes Chairman
- 1934 KMT defeats Red Army of Mao
- Long March 9600 km in 370 days by 130,000;
- Dr.Dwarakanath Shantaram Khotnis

AGRICULTURE IN CHINA

- "Speak Bitterness" meetings during Long March
- 1949 Revolution "Mass Line Approach" Mao said Peasants are backbone of China [Gandhi also said this]
- All lands nationalized, redistributed to farmers
- 1952-1956 Collective Farming
- 1958 Communes & Great Leap Forward
- 53,000 Communes, popn. ≤ 80,000 &≤ 20,000 households each; Brigade 400 h/h, team 40 h/h

AGRI. in CHINA (contd...)

- 1961-1980 Adjustment & Best Balance, 15% private plots allowed, but no ownership of land; only tenancy is allowed even now;
- 1981 onwards Household Responsibility System – No compulsory procurement, no agri. tax, all sale to State at market price
- "Sideline Production" of piggery, poultry, fishery, sericulture and "Diversification" into fruits, vegetables encouraged.

Agricultural Productivity in China

- China-96 m ha sown land, India 170 mn ha
- China's food grain prdn. 515mt,India 252 mt
 & per capita con. 380 kg/yr & India 173 kg/yr
- China pdvty, 1,035 kg/ha in 1949 to 4,000kg in 1995; India's pdvty is ½ in Rice, ⅔ in Wheat, ¼ in Cotton, ⅓ in Groundnut;
- Fertilizer con/ha 328 kg in China, 121 kg India
- Use of human waste, "FERTILIZER FACE"

HUMAN DEV.INDICATORS

- "BUILDING ON THE WEAK"
- Adult Literacy China 94%, India 63%
- Infant MortIty—Ch 18/1000, India 52/1000 L/b
- Life Exp.at birth—Ch 73years, Ind 64 yrs
- Likely to die before 40 yrs Ch.3%, Ind.16%
- Unemployment Ch.4.3%, Ind.11%
- HDI Rank China 101, India 136
- Women Hold Up Half the Sky; no footbinding

CORRUPTION, CHINA & INDIA

- Corruption is rampant in China esp.after 1979; Deng - "To be Rich is Glorious."
 - [Wall Street slogan Greed is Good]
- "Receipts Market"- ¥ 160 for ¥ 32 Hotel bill
- But China executes high level peopleeg.Dy Dir. Pan Qinghai, Public Sec. Bureau; "Green Slips" Money Orders

INCOME & QUALITY OF LIFE

- China was a shattered economy in 1949
- Now, its GDP (PPP) is US\$ 12.26 tn; India US\$.4.72 tn; US is \$16, Japan US\$ 4.6 tn;
- Basic Health & Edn. met in China; India has 47% malnourished children, 37% illiteracy
- Population below BPL: China 3%; India 37%
- 24 mths. military service for 18-24 is MUST
- CHINA DEVELOPING 600 TOWNS-39%; URB IND28%

BUT ALL IS NOT WELL IN CHINA

- Inequality is Gini Index- China 44, India 32.5
- Bhaijinzhuyi (money worship); Financial Scams Shen Taifu 1 bn Yuan bonds @ 24% r/i cheating 200,000; but sentenced to death;
- Grey Money; Iron Triangle- Hukou, Dangan & Danwei – Res. Permit, Confl.File, Work Unit;
- Pollution levels, Acid rains, CO₂,
 Duststorms, Deforestn, Floods; 3 Gorges;
 South/N.River Diversion;
- To sustain current Growth Rates of China & India till 2050 two planets are needed

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN INDIA AND CHINA

- CCP ideology → Development, Pragmatism
- Decisions are Implemented: eg. \$6 bn
 Beijing Green Wall to stop dust-storms, for 2008 Olympics
- India:"Not taking decision is also a decision"
 Symbolic: "Go through the motions of doing something while doing nothing & this is equivalent to having actually done something even though the situation has not altered one bit."
- Well-begun is half-done, Half begun is well-done
- Two Japanese = 1 + 1; Two Indians = 1 1
