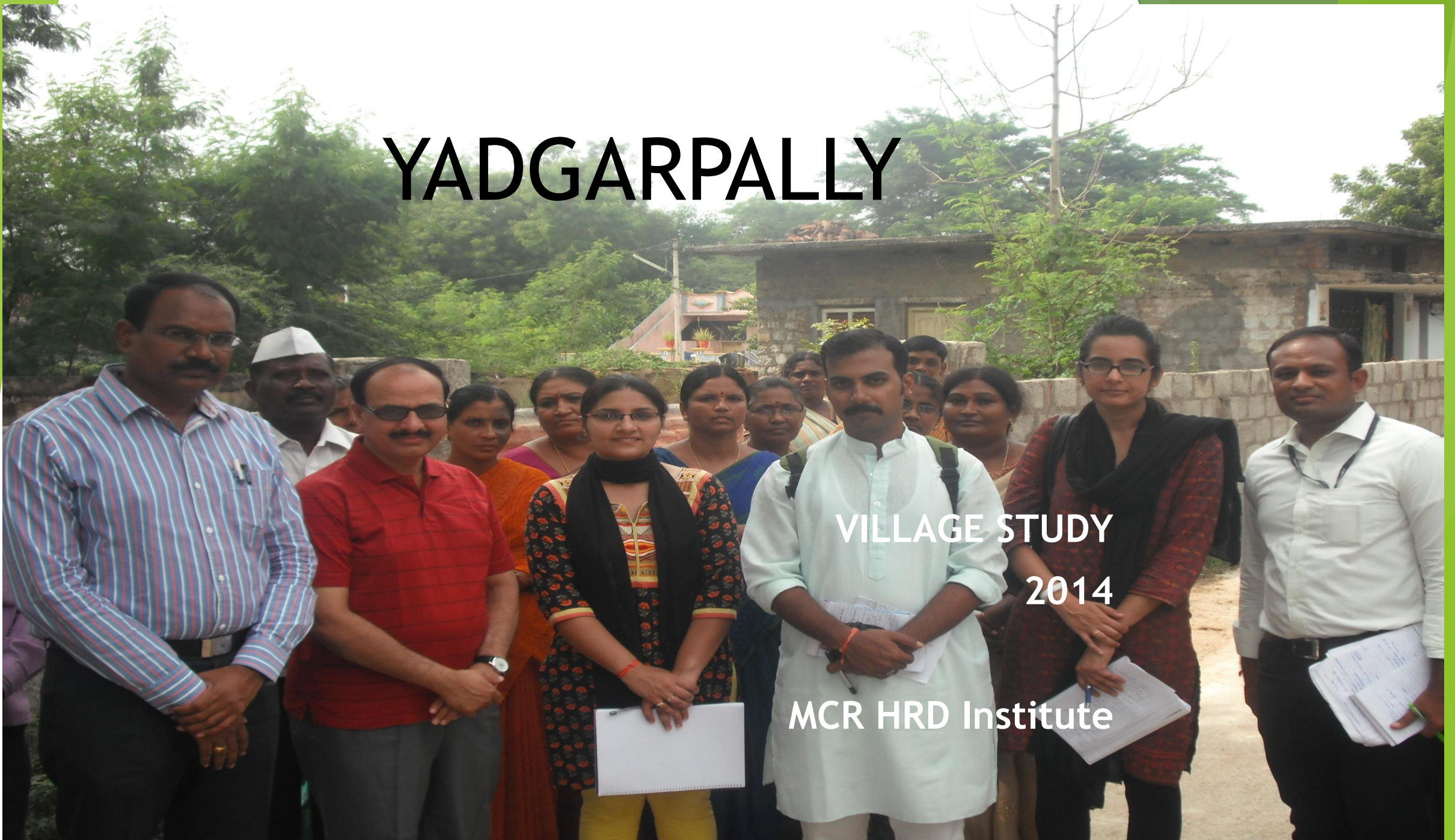

INTRODUCTION



- ▶ Situated in Miriyalguda mandal, Nalgonda district
- ▶ Established in 1555 under the name Pandinapally
- ▶ Name changed to Yadgiripally in 1634 due to the habitation and dominance of the Yadav community.
- ▶ Finally came to be known as Yadgarpally in 1834, under the rule of Nizam
- ▶ 4 people from this village went to jail in Aurangabad for standing against the Nizam government
- ▶ Got its independence from the rule of Nizam in September, 1948

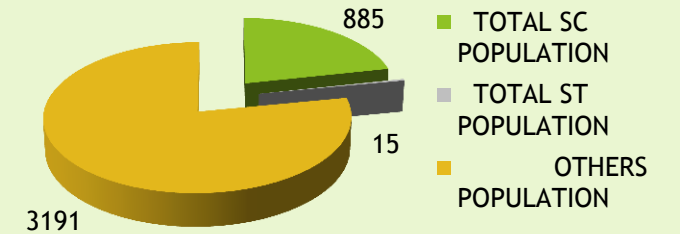

Caste Wise Population



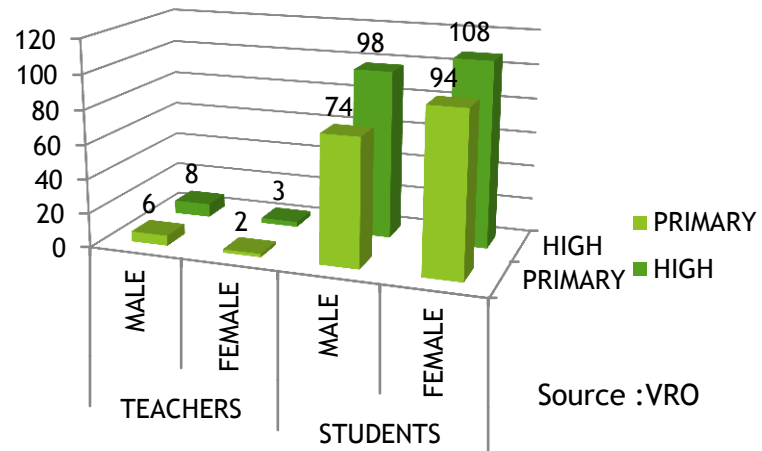

OBSERVATIONS

- ▶ Proper functioning of the anganwadi institutions
- ▶ Functional SHGs leading to women empowerment in the village
- ▶ Timely check up of the cattle by the veterinary doctor
- ▶ Good infrastructural facilities like electricity, , dish TV
- ▶ Proper maintenance of village records
- ▶ Communal harmony
- ▶ Unrestricted use of submersible motors in the village
- ▶ Lack of functional toilets
- ▶ Encroachment of the school premises by anti social elements after school hours
- ▶ High rate of alcohol consumption in the village (sendi fruit used for making intoxicating drink)
- ▶ Improper disposal of the bio-medical waste in the veterinary hospitals



LOCAL SUGGESTIONS

- ▶ Pipeline from the Krishnareddy kunta rather than ground water usage
- ▶ Improvement in the banking facilities and micro finance availability
- ▶ Improvement in toilet and sanitation facilities
- ▶ Reduction in alcohol consumption
- ▶ Increment in the number of health sub-centres
- ▶ Improvement in the drinking water facility as well as kitchen facility in schools.
- ▶ Improvement in the process of identification of beneficiaries for various government schemes.
- ▶ Construction of a library in High School.
