



DRINKING WATER



Only 1 protected water tank (90 kl capacity) caters to drinking water requirement of Reddy and Chaudhary Colony

 Almost all other groups need to buy drinking water can of 20 litre for Rs.5



- Main source of drinking water in all schools is bore well and hand pumps
- Ground water is muddy and rich in iron content which is main reason for major health concerns.
- During heavy rainfall, water of the bore well gets contaminated with faecal matter of the fields which is again great concern
