- Drainage system is non-functional




- No proper drinking water supply infrastructure
- Non-functional street lights





### AGRICULTURE

### SOCIO-ECONOMIC STATUS -Poverty

- No official estimate of poverty line at village level
- Land ownership is important
  - Inequitable Land distribution is a major reason-Ranking Method
  - MGNREGA works' selection done by gram sabha is truly democratic
  - IAY benefitted many poor households esp. In SC, ST Colony and thanda habitation
  - 35 kg foodgrains are being given to each eligible household under AAY

### **Educational Status**

- 3 primary schools, 1 high schools
- 1 school for children with disabilities (nonfunctional) & 3 aaganwadi
- Mid-Meal scheme is working well
- No funds for disabilities school (VELUGU Programme)
- Literacy rate is 48%
- Need to encourage girl students

No doctor in PHC and other staff on deputation



RMP are providing basic health care



- No mass health care awareness campaigns
- No participation from PRI



- dysfunctional VHSC
- Lack of Sanitation and piped water supply



## Gender perspective

- Sex ratio good : 1006/1000 males
- Half the members of GP are women including sarpanch
- 95 SHGs empowering women
- Dairy farming with the help of SHGs
- In Thanda habitation (ST)- girls drop out from school after 15 years of age due to marriage
