



#### VS Pandey, IAS vs. State of U.P. (2010)

- Pandey was served a charge sheet by UP Govt. on five counts for alleged violation of All India Service (Conduct) Rules, 1968 for being a signatory to an NGO - Indian Rejuvenation Initiative) in filing a WP.
- Pandey was exonerated after enquiry in Aug. 2012. UP Govt. orders for re-enquiry.
- Pandy's appeal in CAT dismissed.
- Goes to Supreme Court

#### Conts....

- Pandey's petition allowed and costs awarded to him. SC's comment:
- "The requirement of a Democratic Republic is that every action of the State is to be informed with reason.
- State is not a hierarchy of regressively genuflecting coterie of bureaucracy.
- Civil Servant independent in the country is at best nominal.
- Bureaucrat needs freedom to speak his mind in furtherance of a good goverance"

#### **Lessons Learnt**

The Courts, the people expect you to be courageous Civil Servant, able to speak your mind for good governance, be fearless in your legitimate actions, not to be coerced into condemnable passivity.



#### Transformational leaders

- Transformational leaders will be judged not merely by the style of their speeches but more by substance of their actions
- In Global Hunger Index (international food policy research institute) India is placed in 55<sup>th</sup> rank. (China 5<sup>th</sup>, Sri Lanka: 39<sup>th</sup>, Pak and Bangladesh (57<sup>th</sup>).
- Hidden hunger weakens immune system, stunts physical, intellectual growth,, prone to diseases, loss of productivity, economic growth.
- Be a transformational ethical officer to pave a better tomorrow for have-nots.


#### Be a partner in creating SMART cities


