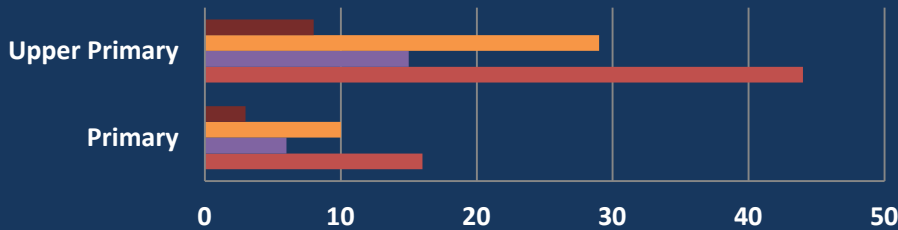

KEY CHALLENGES & ISSUES

LABOUR CRISIS

- Mostly people have their own Lands
- Area under cultivation Gone Up or Villagers actually Migrated?
- Decline in Women Labour
- Income Disparity:

Men – INR 700

Women – INR 300

LABOUR SHORTAGE

LOANS

AVAILABILITY OF LOANS/FUNDS

- **Commercial Banks are Problematic** – Asking Multiple Documents and long Processing Time
- **Large Farmers** providing Loans
- **Pvt. Financers** - Funds at higher interest rates

FARMERS' ISSUES

MECHANIZATION

NEW MACHINERY

- Shift to Mechanization due to Labour Shortage
- Limited Availability – Tractors & Cultivators only
- Few Large Farmers with new Equipments
- No Subsidies to Small Farmers to rent machinery for agriculture
- Mutual Dependence - Large Farmers renting their own machinery

NEW PROBLEM OF MONKEYS

- Mining of surrounding Hills for Granite caused Mokeys to miigrate to SINGAPUR Village.
- Continuous Threat to Crops

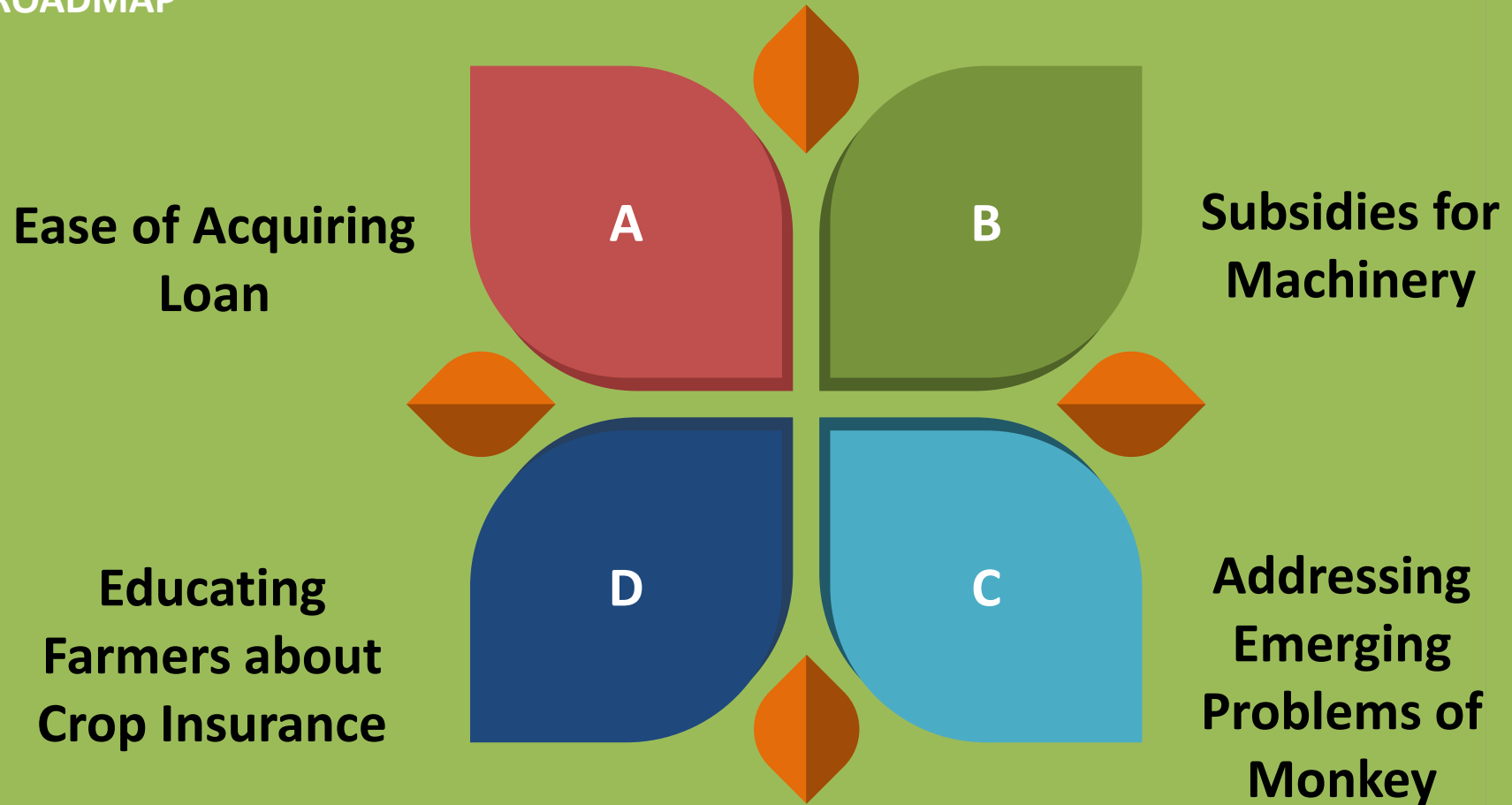
