- **The Quran makes it clear that Islam does not encourage corruption in any form.**
- **The lust for plenty kept you in the dark till you reach your grave” (At1 Takasur:1-2) And the Almighty warns such men of painful torment:**

- Dharma treats “Paradravya” as “Loshtha” or just a mere piece of useless rock. Vedas have extensively dealt about Hydra headed corruption. Shlokas 1-191-81, 1-28-4 and

- 2-14-3 in Rigveda calls corruption a nine headed demon that enters our body through 99 sources.
- Sama veda(913&179) terms corruption as disease.

- Thus dharma deters corruption. At a time when the entire nation is up in arms against corruption, it is important to go back to the scriptures to ensure that the struggle is not merely a passing phase , but is a permanent phenomenon.

- What Mahatma Gandhi said way back in 1948 “ corruption will go when the large number of persons given unworthily to it realize that the nation does not exist for them to exploit but that they exist to serve the nation.

- This requires morals, and extreme vigilance on the part of those who are free of the taint, Indifference will be criminal...(the Hindu, 27.1.1948).

- It is the duty of all leading men, whatever their persuasion or party, to safeguard the dignity of India. That dignity cant be saved if misgovernment and corruption always go together.(The Hindu, 16-12-1947)

- **In 1993 Mumbai Bomb explosions 257 people died. Supreme Court of India in recent judgment conferred 12 members hanging and 10 others life imprisonment.**
- **The court observed that the Police, Customs & Immigration officials were “hand in glove”**

- The terror money of 1998 Coimbatore blasts had been deposited in four local branches of well established banks.

- On July 11th , 2006, terror attacks on Mumbai trains have left 200 dead. This deadly operation needed 10000 US dollars. This came from Saudi to India via Hawala.

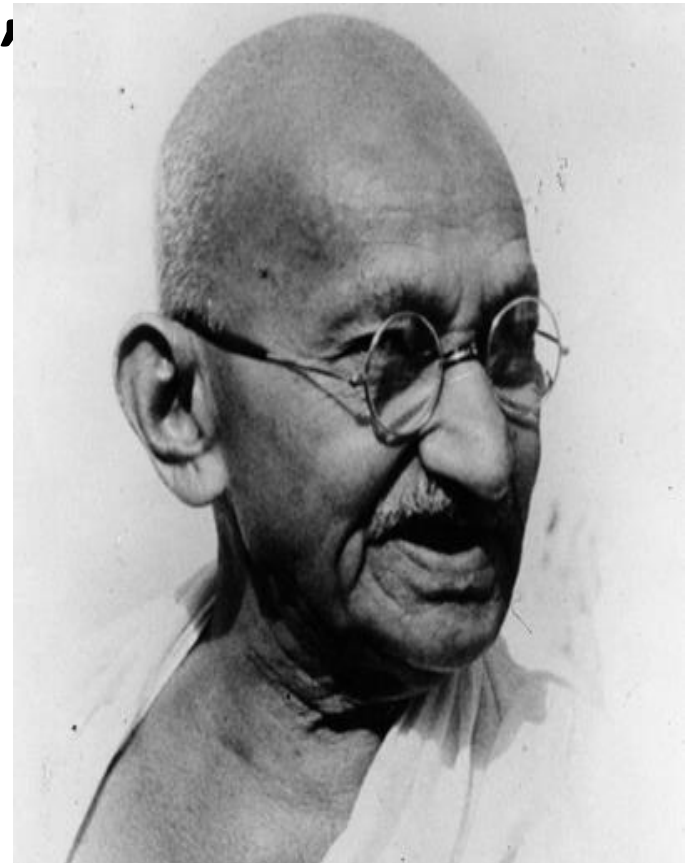
