





Palle Pragathi Scheme

- The Government of Telangana has launched Palle Pragati program to improve the quality of life in the rural areas. This scheme also ensures minimum one park, nursery, sanitation in every village of telangana.
- □ Infrastructure development Under the rural development programme, a total of Rs 13,528 crore has been spent under which every gram panchayat in Telangana has been equipped with a tractor, trolley and tanker to carry out developmental activities.



- Sanitation- New toilets have been built and waste management systems have been implemented which has improved sanitation and ensured hygiene in every village across the state. Since the launch of the programme, Rs 279.10 crore has been spent on 12,753 gram panchayats for the construction of village dumping yards.
- □ Green Drive Palle Pragathi, functional nurseries were established in 12,756 gram panchayats at a cost of Rs 238.09 crores. As many as 20.16 crore plants have been raised so far in these nurseries. Apart from this, 6.61 crore saplings have been planted in villages at a cost of Rs 118.68 crores. Brihat Palle Nature Parks have been established too in 1,552 mandals at a cost of Rs 34.79 crores







Rythu Bandhu/Rythu Beema

■ Rythu Bandhu scheme, also known as Farmer's Investment Support Scheme (FISS), is a welfare program to support farmer's investment for two crops a year by the Government of Telangana. The government is providing 58.33 lakh (5.8 million) farmers ₹5000 per acre per season to support the farm investment, twice a year, for rabi (winter) and kharif (rainy) seasons. This is a first direct farmer investment support scheme in India, where the cash is paid directly.

As part of **Rythu Bima**, the State government provides a life insurance cover of Rs 5 lakh each to farmers. So far, a total of 7 families of farmers during the last five years were extended Rs 35 Lakh as compensation. Rythu Bima is the first of its kind scheme under which the government pays the premium, while the insurance claim amount is remitted to the account of the nominee of the insured farmer within one week to 10 days of the death of the farmer.

Dalit Bandhu

"Telangana Dalit Bandhu" is introduced to intensify the level of financial assistance to SC households for establishment of suitable income generating economic support schemes as the delivery of credit by banks in the form of loans has become a constraint.

One time capital assistance of Rs.10 lakhs per SC family is provided for all SC families as 100% grant / subsidy to establish a suitable income generating schemes as per their choice (without bank loan linkage).
