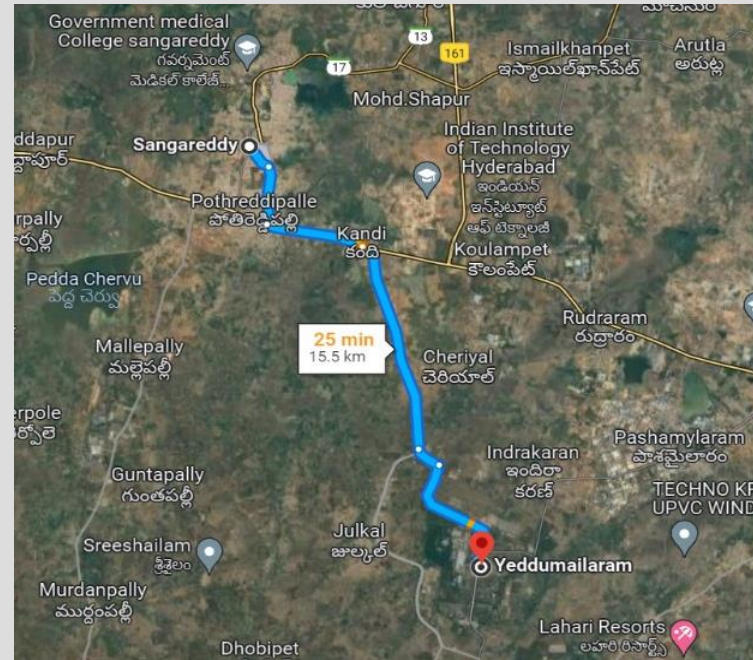

- Yeddumailaram village is located in Kandi Mandal within the Sangareddy Constituency of Telangana State, India. It is located 15 kms from district headquarters along Mumbai-Benguluru Highway Bypass. Co-ordinates of the village being 17.5034° N, 78.1365° E.

HEALTH & WELLNESS CENTRE

- Major medicines and treatment are available for diseases like TB, Leprosy etc.
- Immunization/Vaccination takes place every Wednesday.
- Most of the cases are of BP and Sugar.
- Pregnancy kits and testing are also provided.



AGRICULTURE

- Agricultural area is around 638 acre.
- There are around 156 farmers in the village.
- Major crops grown are Cotton, Paddy, Maize, Bengal Gram etc.
- Major vegetables grown are Tomato, Brinjal etc.

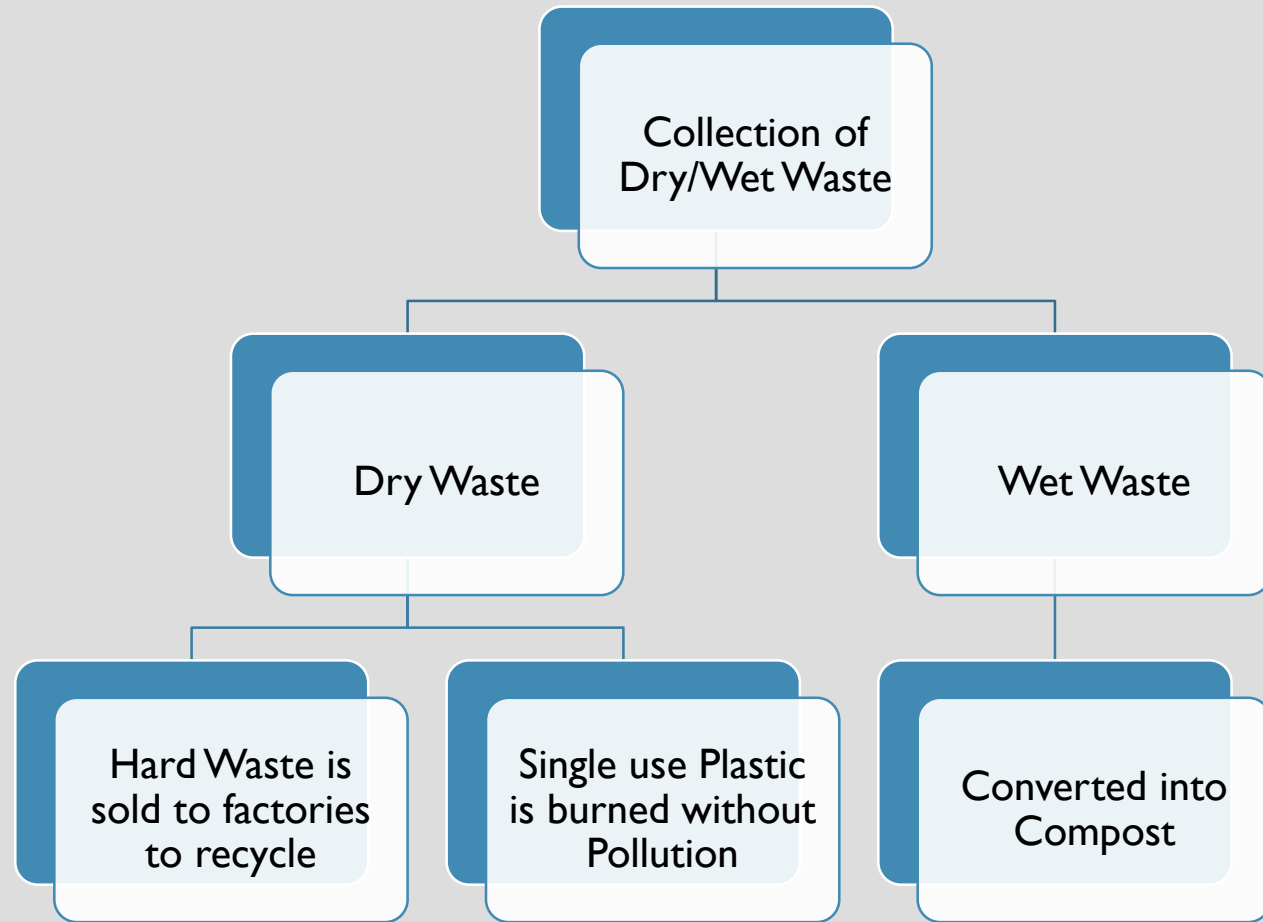


SANITATION & CLEANLINESS

- Every households have 2 dustbin: 1 for dry waste and 1 for wet waste
- Collection of waste early morning through mini trucks.
- Clean roads
- Underground Drainage system

SELF HELP GROUPS

- Name- Yeddumailaram Velugu Gramaikya Sangam
- Total Members- 387 females in groups of 38
- Source of income: Selling products like chilli powder, spices, turmeric, paper plates etc to general stores; ironing of cloths
- Loans: Internal loan, Bank Loans (@12%p.a), Stree Nidhi Loan (from SERP)
- Participated in Swach Bharat Mission, Telangana Haritha Haaram
- Do Sharamdaan once every month
- Also do door to door awareness for waste segregation.
- Self earning and Self dependent.

OTHER INFRASTRUCTURE

- Solar Plant of 63 KW capacity
- Community Halls (2-SC & 1-BC) for group meetings, marriages & small gatherings
- Free RO water plant
- Library
- Play ground

MGNREGS

- Objectives

- Provide at least 100 days wage employment/HH/Yr
- Ensure minimum wage
- Ensure payment within 15 days

- Ground Level Report:

- People are getting average 80-100 days employment
- Average wage rate is around Rs 250-270 per day.
- Delivery of payment within 15 days.
- Crematorium, Dumping yard and CC roads etc are built with the help of MGNREGS workers

VAIKUNTHA DHAAMAM

- Dignified place for last rites and Ecologically pleasant place. Well maintained by the Gram Panchayat.



TELANGANA KU HARITHA HAARAM

- Telangana Ku Haritha Haaram, a flagship programme of the Telangana Government envisages to increase the present 24% tree cover in the State to 33% of the total geographical area of the State.
- There are 6 saplings in every house, 80% participating and 5% increase in green area last year



PALLE PRAGTHI VANAALU

- A Park for every village & Pleasant place for community gatherings and physical activities having different type of fruit and flowering plants.
- Condition:
 - Fruit and flowering plants are there
 - Not conducive for physical activities
 - No maintenance
 - Not much useful for villagers as it don't have enough space for walking and other activities



MISSION BHAGEERATHA

- Objectives
 - Provide piped drinking water to each house hold. Provide 100 LPCD & Avoid community taps and wastage.
- Ground Level Report:
 - All people are getting benefit of this scheme. Even before mission Bhageeratha there were 100% water availability in the village.



RYTHU BANDHU

- Objectives

- DBT for inputs to farmers @Rs.5,000/acre/season
- Ensure timely money to buy inputs
- Avoid money lenders

- Ground Level Report:

- Around 156 farmers get Rs 5000 per acre per season each.
- In addition to Rythu Bandu, farmers also getting Rs 2000 every four months under PM Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana.
- In addition to this they are getting loans from banks thus role of money lenders is totally avoided

RYTHU BIMA

- Objectives
 - Cover the life of farmer's family in the event of his/her demise
 - Rs.5.0 lakh to be paid to the nominee
- Ground Level Report:
 - 70% farmers are getting benefit of this scheme



MISSION KAKATIYA / JAL JEEVANI

- Objectives
 - Restore minor/medium irrigation tanks
 - Stabilize ayacut under tanks
- Ground Level Report:
 - Two tanks built in the village under this scheme.
 - Total capacity is 110000 litres



SWACHHA BHARAT MISSION (RURAL)

- **Objectives:**

- Open defecation free status
- Provision of household latrines
- Overall cleanliness

- **Ground Level Report:**

- No open defecation, ODF++ Village
- Everyday garbage truck to collect garbage early morning
- Village is very green and clean
- Dumping yard for the segregation & recycling of waste
- Underground Drainage system



PENSIONS

- Objectives
 - Rs.2,000/month
 - Provide economic security
- Beneficiaries
 - Widow Pension- 114
 - Old age- 70
 - Disabled- 30



DALIT BANDHU

- Objectives
 - Encourage entrepreneurship among SC Youth
 - Provide Rs.10 lakh assistance
- Ground Level Report:
 - There is no beneficiary under this scheme hence some applications are under process



KALYAN LAKSHMI / SHADI MUBARAK

- Objectives

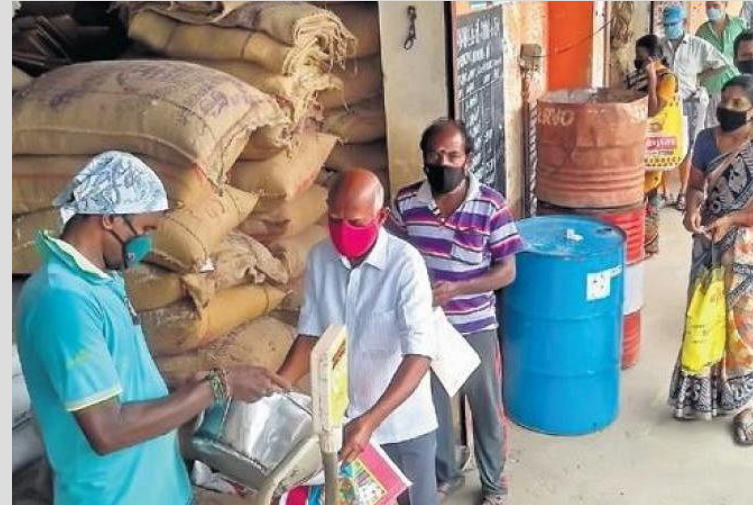
- Provide financial support for girl child's wedding at/after marriageable age
- Reduce borrowings by family
- Rs.1,00,116/- assistance, for low income families

- Ground Level Report:

- Total 8 beneficiaries this year

PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM

- Objectives
 - 30 Kg/family rice
 - Fine quality rice
- Ground Level Report:
 - Each member is getting 6kg rice
 - Total 567 Beneficiaries
 - Distribution in the 2nd week till the end of first half of the month



SOCIAL MAP

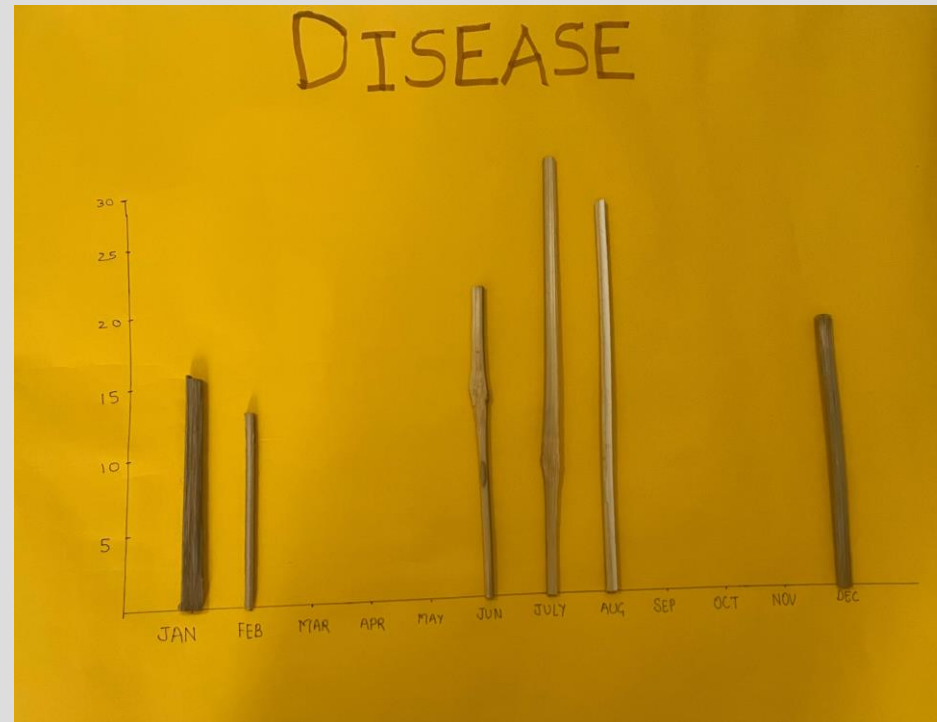


RESOURCE MAP
