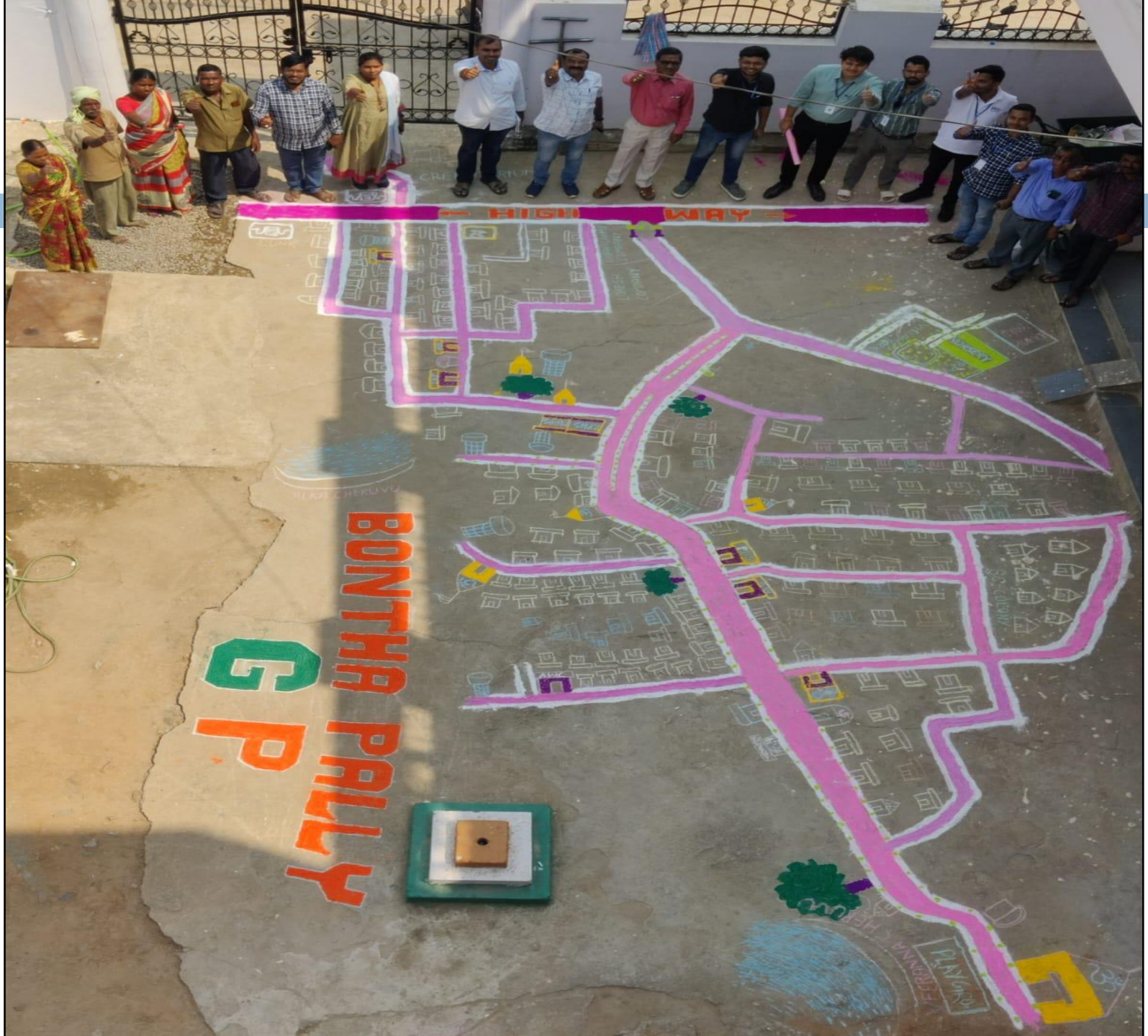

# Agricultural Aspects

# Agricultural Aspects

## ❑ Rythu Vedika -

- for cluster containing Bonthapally was constructed in 2021
- approximately 12-15 farmers gather every Tuesday and Friday to discuss various agricultural practices like new variety of seeds, type of irrigation for specific pattern of farming etc.



# Agricultural Aspects

## ❑ Rythu Bima –

- life insurance scheme of Govt. of Telangana to provide financial relief and social security to the family members
- has benefited families of **eleven** farmers in the village Bonthapally since its launch in 2020 amounting **55L** (5L each)



# Agricultural Aspects

## ❑ Rythu Bandhu –

- Each farmer is provided with Rs. 5,000.00 per acre each season through DBT
- Impact:
  - i) Relief to farmers from debt burden
  - ii) Protection from falling into vicious cycle of debt



## ❑ PM Kisan Samman Nidhi Yojana –

- Under this scheme farmers are assisted with Rs. 2,000 every four months (Rs. 6,000 per year)

# Environmental Aspects

## ❑ **Telangana Ku Haritha Haram**

- To promote ecological conservation as a sub-goal under SDG Goal 5
- This program is aimed at increasing the green cover of the state from existing 24% to 33%



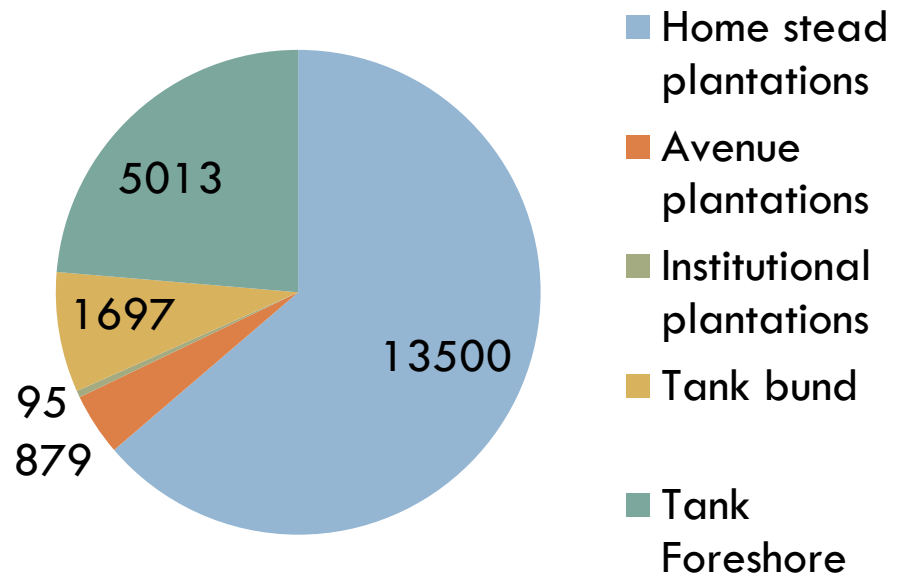
# Environmental Aspects

## ❑ Telangana Ku Haritha Haram

- Multiple models of plantation is carried out to attain the goal:

Home stead plantations	: 13,500
Avenue plantations	: 879
Institutional plantations	: 95
Tank pund	: 1,697
Tank foreshore	: 5,013

# Environmental Aspects

## ❑ **Palle Prakruthi Vanam-**

- aims at creating small forest patches or nature parks within the villages to enhance biodiversity, protect natural resources and improve the livelihoods of local communities
- The Bonthapally village has an operational nursery under PPV project and has adopted a system where each household in the village is provided **6 saplings** every year for plantation
- **2,336 Saplings** have been planted by villagers under Community Plantations

# Environmental Aspects

## ❑ Waste Management-

- Every household has been provided with separate dustbins for dry and wet waste for the segregation of waste at source itself
- A dump yard has been constructed in the village to process wet waste for production of vermi-compost





# Social Welfare

## ❑ **Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS)-**

- To guarantee 100 days of wage employment in a financial year to at least one member of every rural household
- Types of works includes de-silting of tanks, feeder canals, plantation, raising common nursery, etc.

## ❑ **Kalyan Lakshmi / Shadi Mubarak**

- to offer financial help to brides from SC, ST, and minority households
- Rs. 1,00,116 is transferred to the mother's bank account at the time of bride's marriage
- In Bonthapally village, there have been 152 beneficiaries under Kalyan-Lakshmi, and 18 such beneficiaries under Shaadi-Mubarak.
- Helps preventing child marriage

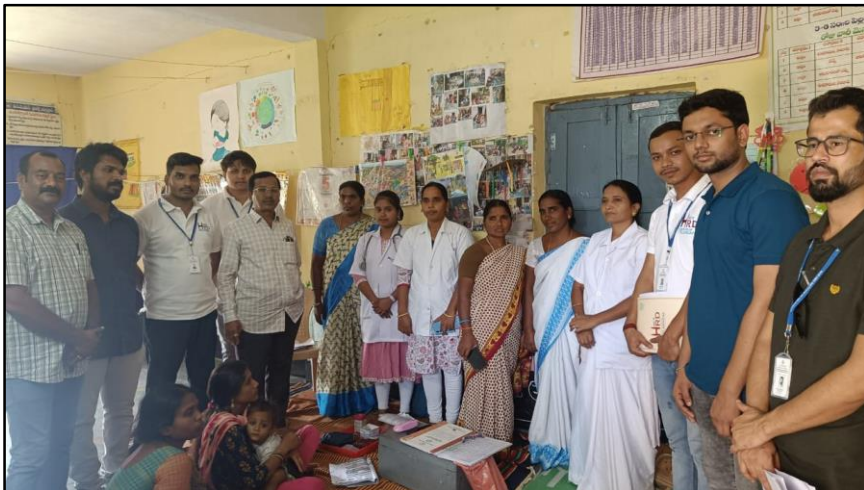
## □ Health Facilities

- One health sub-centre which is attached with Gummadidala Primary Health Centre.
- The immunisation services, antenatal care and other pregnancy related services are provided eg. OPV, Hepatitis-B, Jaundice, etc.

# Self-Help Groups

## ■ Indira Kranthi Patham (IKP)

- rural poverty reduction project to enable the poor to improve their livelihoods and quality of life through their entrepreneurship (SHG)
- Bonthapally contains two IKP units, one containing 45 groups and the other 42 groups,
- loan of upto 15 lacs is provided by APGVB to each group in order to carry out their own entrepreneurial activities and up to 20L by SBI
- The loans are taken through five routes namely,
  - Bank loan
  - Shrinidhi
  - Velgu
  - Savings
  - Mandal Samkhya.





# Water Security

## ❑ Mission Kakatiya

- Restoration of irrigation tanks and lakes
- Ensuring water security
- Two lakes **Aluka Chevuru** and **Veeranna Cheruvu** in **30 acres** and **80 acres** respectively



# Water Security

## ❑ **Mission Bhageerathi**

- Safe drinking water project for every village
- **Regional Water System:**
  - No. of Water Storage Tanks : 2
  - No. of Overhead Tanks : 6
  - No. of Mini Tanks : 9
  - No. of Bore Wells : 19



# Miscellaneous

## ❑ **Baikunth Dhamam**

- Identified land parcels outside the village for burial and cremation



## ❑ **Sheep Rearing**

- It is launched by Telangana Govt. To support the traditional shepherd community, the Kurumas and the Gollas.
- Since 2017, 60 units of sheep have been distributed in Bonthapally village under this scheme.
