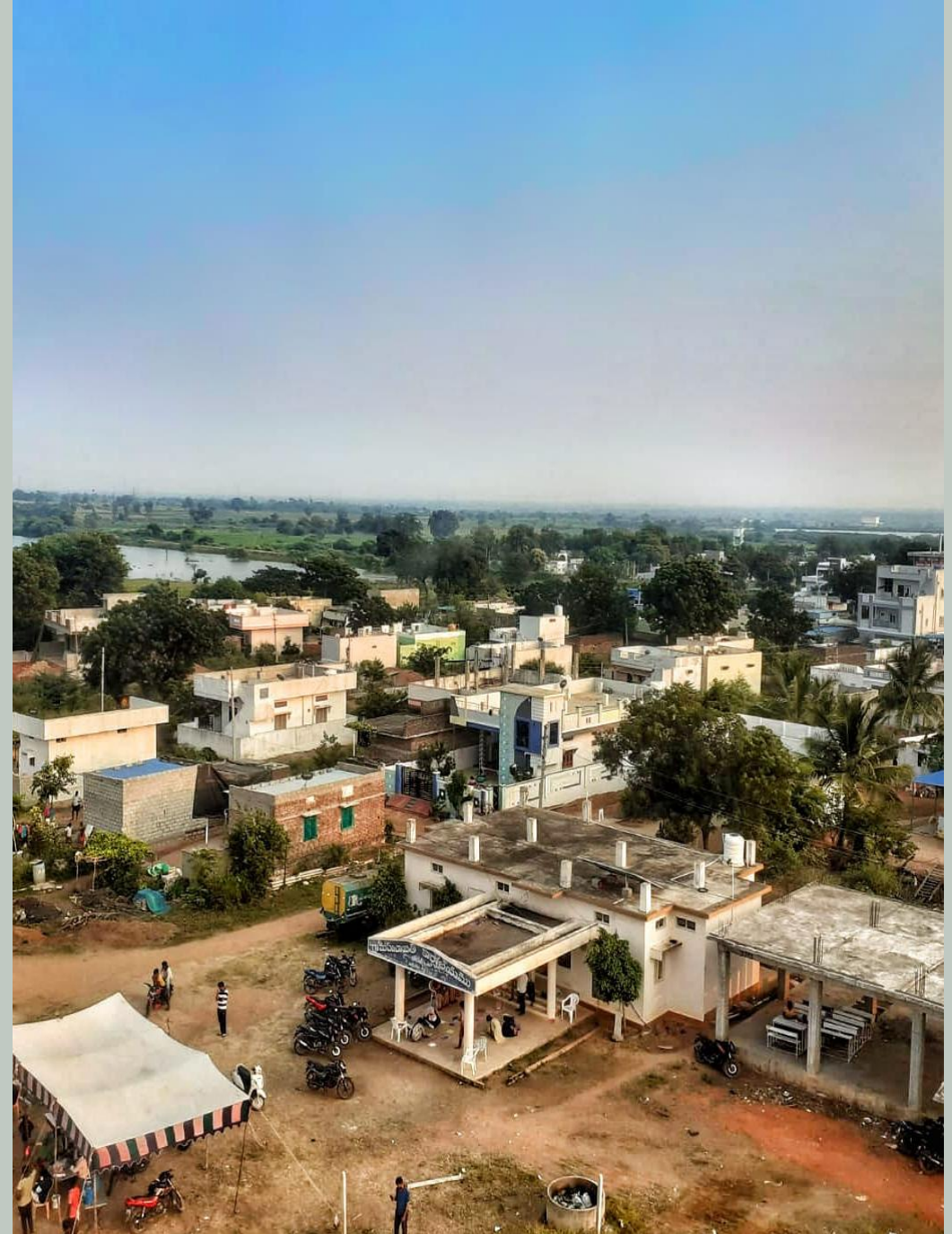

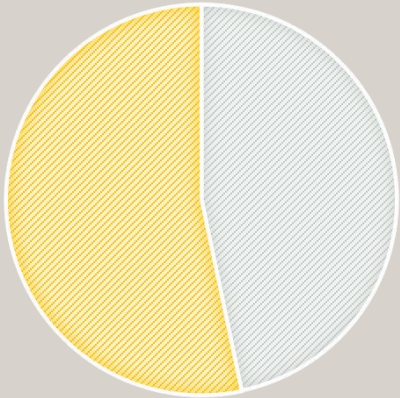

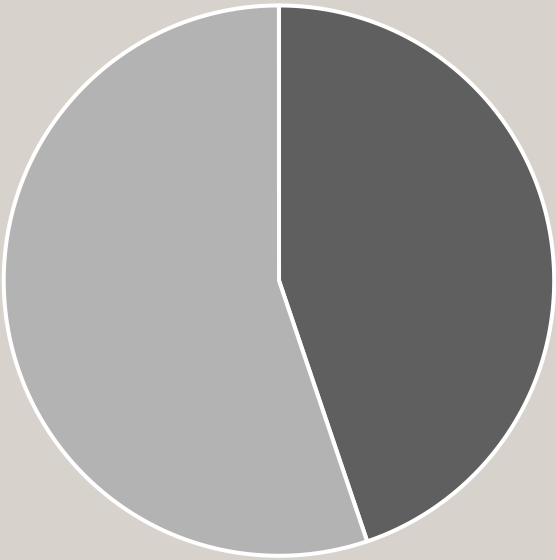


GENDER CHART

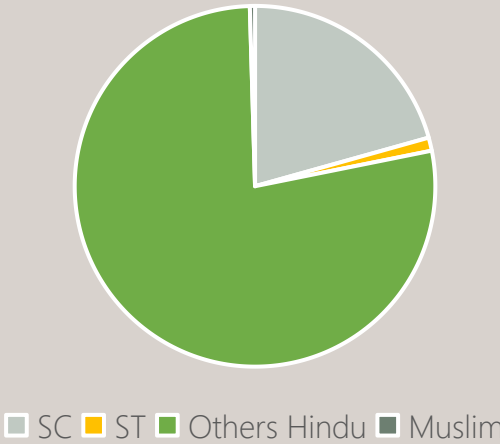
Male Female



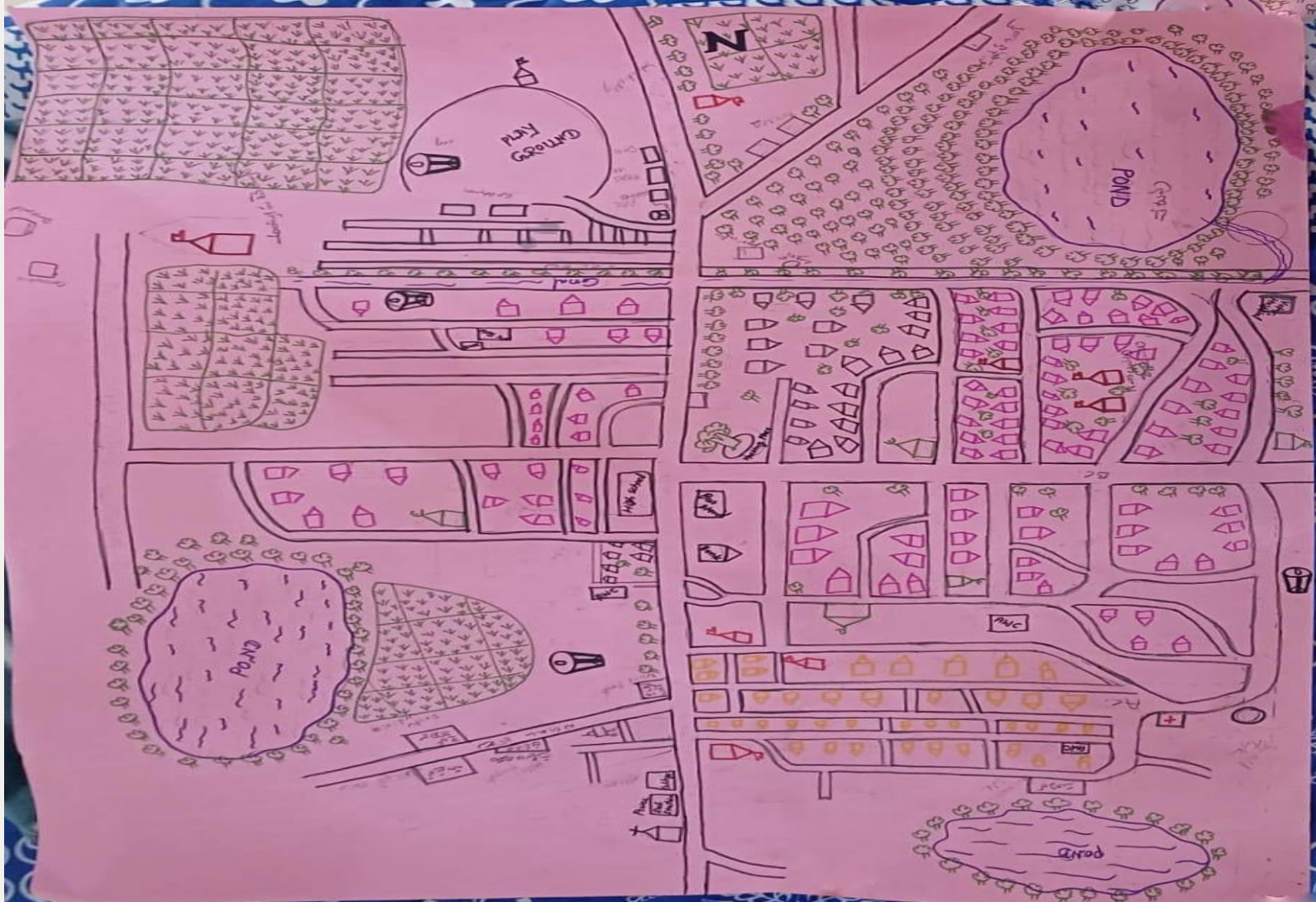
Litracy Rate

MGNREGA

AIM

- ❖ Provide 100 days wages employment and ensure income within 15 days.

Coverage

Total number of workers : 920

Active numbers: 400

Impact

- ❖ : Participation of SC Community increasing in past 2-3 years. 2020-21: 8.34% from SC Cat; 2023-24: 31.30% from SC Category.

Challenges

Low income and late payment along with seasonal employment ie few peoples not getting 100 days job.
Currently nobody gets payment from last 4 months.
Avg Wages: Rs. 250 per days
Payment Period : Approx 1 Month (4 weeks)



Mission Kakatiya/ Jal Jeevan

AIM

- ❖ Restore irrigations tanks and stabilize ayacut under tanks.

Coverage

- ❖ Total Tanks: 6 (KOTHAKUNTA , BOMMI KUNTA , ERRA KUNTA, KOTHA KUNTA 2, CHINTHAL KUNTA, Thirmala bavi kunta)
- ❖ Area of AYACUT: 300 acres

Impact

- ❖ Farmers have sufficient water for irrigations. Till 2018 they have not sufficient water for irrigation and they have to migrate to big cities for labor work but now migration reduces.



Telangana ku Haritha Haaram

AIM

- ❖ Increase Green cover from 24% to 33% and increase public participation in greenery..

General Details

Budget: Rs 3,57,470 (2022-23)

Total saplings planted: 20,000

Impact

- ❖ Nursery established, greenery on both side of roads, Indoor plants in the houses.

Challenges

- ❖ To involve people to participate in this mission and to teach them about the positives of green environment.



Vaikuntha Dhaamam

AIM

Dignified place for last rites.

General Details

- ❖ Established: 05/07/2020
- ❖ Budget: Rs. 12,48,542
- ❖ Maintenance: Good
- ❖ Status: Digging not available
- ❖ Far from village (Approx 3 km)
- ❖ SC Community dig at common places in villages and other community at their private property.

Impact

- ❖ Ecologically Pleasant

Challenges

Due to long distance from village, people are preferring nearby place for last rites hence this mission is not successful till now.

No special workers provided for maintenance by government.



Palle Pragathi Vanaalu

AIM

A park for every village which will be pleasant place for community gatherings and physical activities.

General Details

Established: 04/05/2021

Cost: 5.90 lakh

Area: 15 guntas

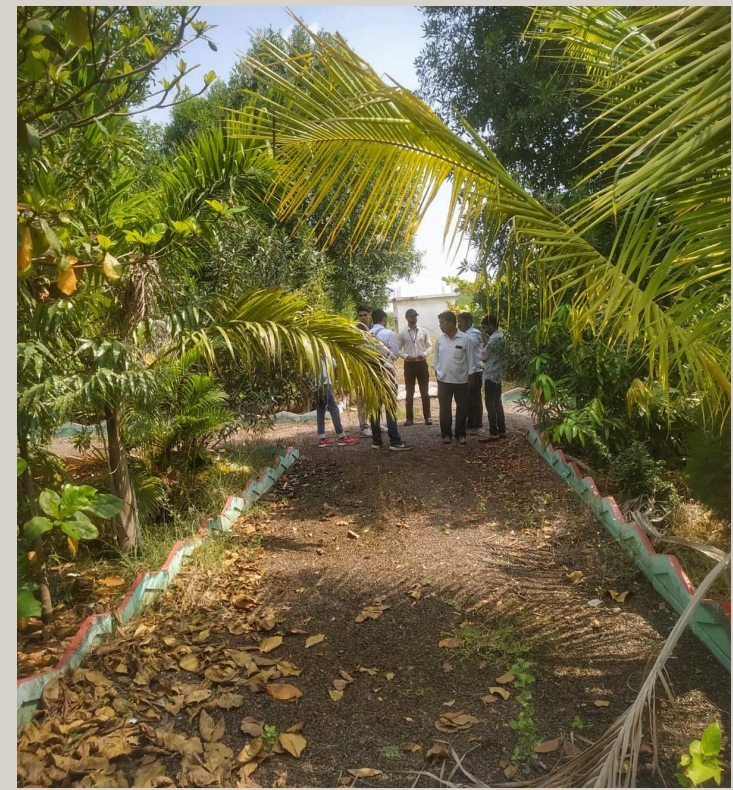
Approx 4000 plants of fruits, flowers, conarcorpus, mango, sapota, papaya etc.

1 NREGA worker for daily cleaning.

Overall maintenance: Once in 2 years

Challenges

Maintenance should be better and should have proper seating facilities for the visitors.



Mission Bhageeratha

AIM :

Provide piped drinking water to reach household

Coverage

Budget : 11,62,580 (2021-22)

Reports properly maintained and anybody can check.

Impact

Sanctioned household: 1445

Fitted household: 1445

Supply: 100 litre per capita per day.

5 water tank installed

Challenges

Some people complained about less water supply during evening times on few days in months



Swachh Bharat Mission (Rural)

AIM :

Open Defecation free and overall cleanliness of the village.

Coverage

Total Sanctioned toilet- 377

Released amount- Rs. 45,00,000

Impact

All the people have toilets in their household.

Challenges

All the household have the toilets but still approx 10% population go in open area for defecation.



Rythu Bandhu (input subsidy)

AIM :

DBT for inputs to farmers @ Rs. 5,000/acre/season.

Coverage

Sanction Farmers: 2642

Actual DBT success: 2499

Money transferred in two seasons i.e. Rabi and Kharif (June and December as per English calendar)

All the farmers have bank account and they get passbook having details of lands. It gets updated after every buy/sell of land.

Impact

: No suicide case among farmer after this scheme i.e.2018

Low migration/ reverse migration

Money lending decrease by 75%

Challenges

To give training to farmers to maintain their passbook and about all the digital process.



Rythu Bima

AIM :

Cover the life of farmer's family in the event of their demise.

Coverage

Age: 18-59 years

Money credited to bank account within 15 days.

Every year govt pays Rs 3136 to LIC as subscription fee

2018- 5 members; 2019- 4 members; 2020- 11

members; 2021- 10 members; 2022- 6 members; 2023- 1 (till september 2023)

Impact

Money Support to Family.

Rythu Vedica

AEO (Agriculture Extension Officer) is the supervisor of this office. Cluster of 2-3 villages in 1 office.

Contains a samiti (committee) of 15 peoples and have training scheduled on Tuesday and Friday.

Challenges: Low level implementations, Farmers doesn't come for training purpose because this office is Outside the village.



Kalyana Lakshmi/ Shadi Mubarak

AIM :

Provide financial support for girl's child wedding at/after marriageable age.

Coverage

Kalyani lakshmi scheme is basically for Hindu family and Shadi Mubarak is for Muslims family.

Money Provided: Rs. 1,00,116

Beneficiary: 82 families (Hindu-77 Families, Muslim- 5 Families)

Impact

: Reduction in Child Marriage

Challenges

Few girls marries between age group of 18-21. No focus on education of girls.

Pension, Dalitha Bandhu and Sheep Rearing Scheme

PENSION (AASARA)

- AIM: To provide monthly pension of Rs. 2000 and overall economic security.
- Coverage: All eligible people are getting the pension.
- Beneficiaries: OLD age - 189 WIDOW -284 Disabled -65 Single Women-25

DALITHA BANDHU

- AIM: To encourage entrepreneurship among SC Youth and to provide Rs. 10 lakh assistance.
- Status: Applications received but sanctioned amount not delivered due to Model Code of Conduct in State Election.

SHEEP REARING

- AIM: To provide livelihood for shepherds by assisting Rs.1,75,000/unit.
- Beneficiaries:
Applied- 134
Delivered-88 units(1 unit- 24 F & 1M)

PDS RATION SHOP

AIM:

- ❖ To provide 6kg/person upto 30kg/ family rice of fine quality.
- ❖ Providing ration to BPL Families.

Details

- ❖ Quantity : 6 kg per person.
- ❖ Authentication: Either finger or eye verification(Both online)
- ❖ Digital weighing machine
- ❖ Advanced Stock of 2 weeks.
- ❖ Antodya Card Holders get 35kgs rice.



PRIMARY AGRICULTURE COOPRATIVE SOCIETY

AIM:

- ❖ To provide loans to different sectors and subsidized items.

General Details:

- ❖ Type of loans: Agriculture, Education, Business, Vehicle etc.
- ❖ Anyone can take loan but have to give something for security.

Impact:

- ❖ Providing Fertilizer and other items at low price.

Challenges:

- ❖ Landless/ poor not getting loans because they have nothing to submit as Security.



Self Help Groups (Women)

- ❖ Established in 2003 in this mandal.
- ❖ Approx 55 SHGs group with around 550 members.

Working:

- ❖ Take loan from bank to help people; Amount Range : upto 20 lakh, Interest of 12% paid by govt to bank.
- ❖ Startup Village Program gave loan of 71 lakh and 68 thousands to SHGs.
- ❖ Everybody get jobs in MGNREGA scheme.
- ❖ Mode of Business: Photo Studio, Kirana Shop, Xerox and Mobile repair shop.
- ❖ Recovery Rate : 98%

Impact:

- ❖ Women are becoming Financially Stable.



Health Care Centres

- ❖ Total Hospitals: 2 (1 PHC & 1 health sub centre)
- ❖ Facility Available: Lab test, immunization, Pharmacy, Injection, Delivery (Labour Room)
- ❖ Vaccines Available: Polio, Hepatitis B, Vitamin K, Pregnant(TD-2 times)
- ❖ Nutrition Kit and KCR kit(only for 2 deliveries) available
- ❖ Approx 150 patient come per day(120 in PHC and 30 in Health sub Centres)
- ❖ Other Facilities Available: Dressing, 102 emergency call service, Ambulance available, Routine Immunization(Wednesday(Centre) and Saturday(Outreach)

Impact:

- ❖ Improvement in Medical Treatment, People getting medicines and other facility on time

Challenges:

- ❖ Internet Connectivity, Normal Delivery



Schools

- ❖ Total Schools : 3 (2 Primary and 1 Secondary)
- ❖ Total Students in current session: 126 (64 Boys & 62 Girls), 2022:142, 2021:150
- Category wise: GEN:42, BC: 54, SC:22, ST:8

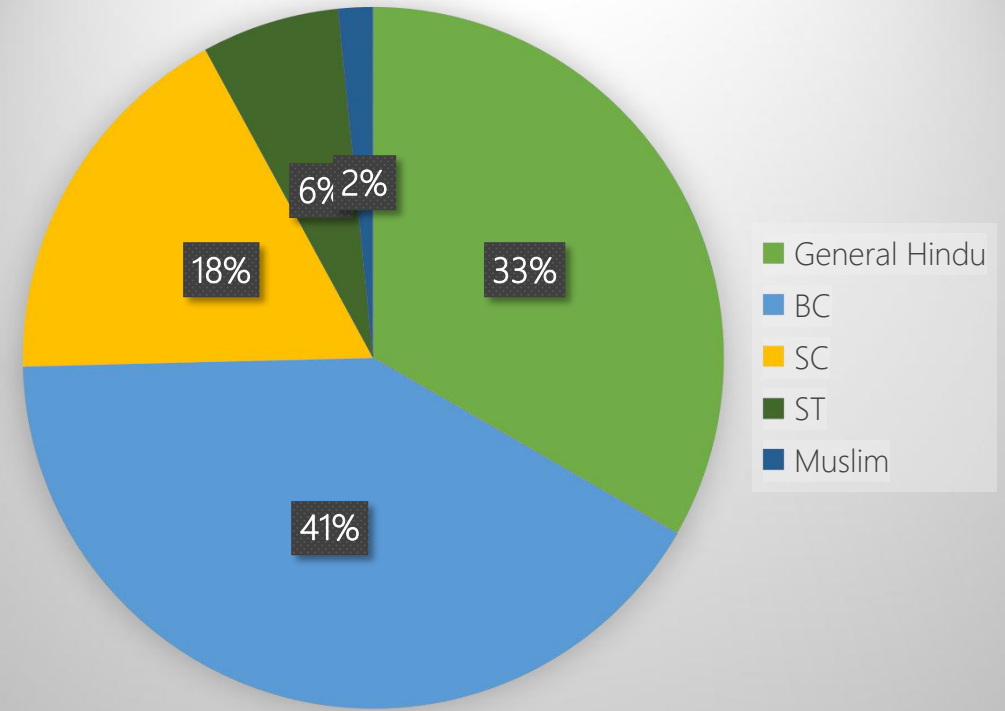
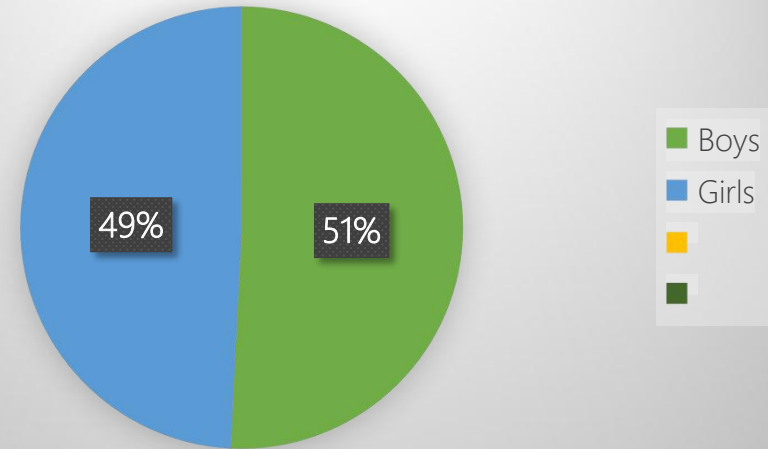

Challenges:

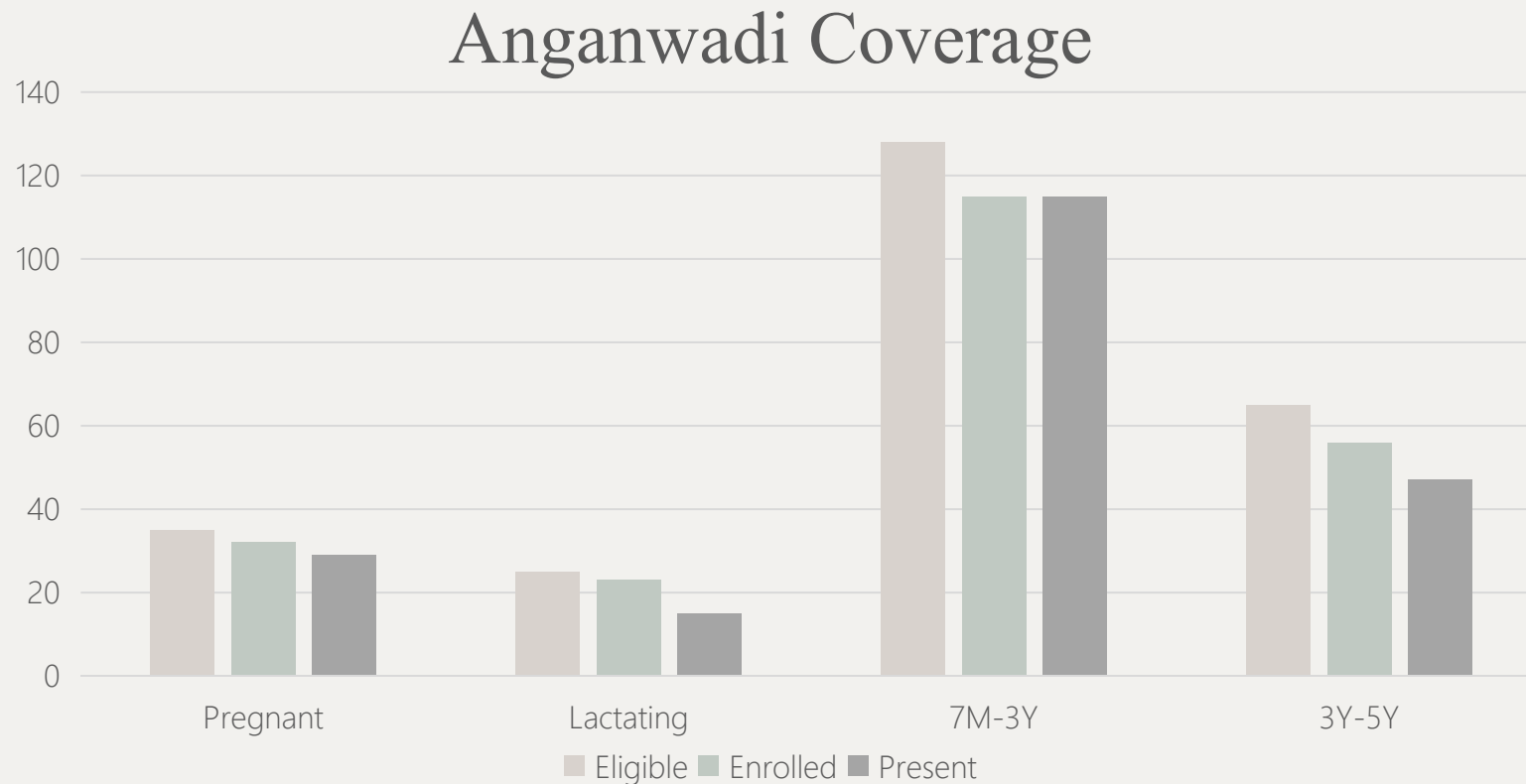
- ❖ Less Staff, late salary for MDM Cooks, Poor Infrastructure.
