Visit to the Institutions in the Village PRIMARY SCHOOL

Highlights:

- No of Primary Schools in Bhavanipet Village 3
- Total enrolments in Primary school 127
- No of Boys enrolled are 66; and No of Girls enrolled are 61.
- Students can read and write in English and Telugu.
- Quality food in Mid-Day meal scheme.

- No proper drinking water facility and no separate toilet for boys and girls.
- No Sweeper as regular staff.



Visit to the Institutions in the Village HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL

Highlights:

- 103 Students
- Total Boys = 48; Total girls = 55
- The enrolment was mainly from SC community.
- Students were able to read and write in English and Telugu also.
- Since last five years there no drop out case of any students.
- Two students in last session were also selected in IIIT Nizamabad.
- E-Learning facilities are also available for students.
- Quality food in mid-day meal scheme.

- Kitchen needs proper coverage.
- Girls toilet was under Construction.
- Lack of availability of pure drinking water.
- No separate toilet facility for male and female faculty.



PHC SUB CENTRE:

Highlights:

- Newly Constructed in 2023.
- Total Staff=5
- 1 MPHA (Multi purpose health assistant)
- 1 ANM (Auxiliary Nurse and Midwife.)
- 3 ASHA(Accredited Social Health Activist) Workers.
- Vaccination program and other health awareness programmes were conducted.
- ASHA activist monitoring health of pregnant women and children.
- Common Diseases- Hypertension, Diabetes, Dengue .
- KCR kit is distributed by Telangana

- No regular sweeper staff.
- No Lab technician.





ANGANWADI:

Highlights:

- 4 Anganwadi located at different places, out of which 3 were in rented buildings and 1 was in government building.
- The enrollment age was 3-5 years.
- Total enrollment in all 4 anganwadis are 55
- 11 pregnant women and 17 lactating mother are also enrolled.
- All the beneficiaries are provided with nutritious food including egg and milk on daily basis.
- Had facilities for children like toys, weighing machine and instruments for creative learning.
- Children are able to recite poems in English and Telugu.

- No electricity connection.
- Not enough spacious and no proper ventilation in the buildings.





RAYTHU VEDIKA:

Discussion on farming activities meetings conducted.



Soil testing should be done and recorded.



Crop diversification is needed, there is over-dependence on rice cultivation.



GRAM PANCHAYAT:


Highlights:

- Located at the center of the village.
- Proper drinking water facility.
- Found elected members are approachable.
- Street lighting, sanitation were available.
- House tax collection for maintenance of street-lights, drainage and for library.
- Digital services present .
- Exhibits religious harmony- temple with GP.
- Records updating done well.
- Officials like secretary has IT skills.

MGNREGS

Highlights:

- 6 plants given to every house hold in the village at free of cost.
- Nursery maintained to increase green cover.
- Regular monitoring of given saplings.



SELF HELP GROUP:

Highlights:

- Total 67 groups .
- 10 Members in each group.
- Participant-women.
- Basically the purpose of the Group is to provide the loan from bank to support the family for agriculture.
- Maximum amount of loan is 10 lakh for each group and loan recovered within 30 month.
- Interest value for loan is 3%.
- Security for Loan- husband and son.
- Benefit of loan under this scheme
 - Removed third party.
 - Small interest rate.
 - Load distributed loan.
 - Pay on monthly basis.





PDS Ration Shop

- The scheme covers BPL families to fulfill their basic food requirements.
- As rice is counted as the staple food of Telangana, this scheme provides rice to the BPL families.
- 6 kg per person is provided in the Bhavanipet village.

MGNREGS

- ▶ 1061 cards registered; among them Active cards = 790.
- Total labourer = 1336. Max wage (per day) = 272.
- Average wage (per day) = 173
- No progressive work under MGNREGA in this financial year due to lesser demand.

Desiltation of lakes/ waterbodies

TELANGANA KU HARITHA HAARAM

- The scheme's goal is to raise the existing green cover from 24% to 33%.
- Currently, the village is working to achieve the green cover target. Their diverse efforts such as planting trees along roads, homes, and different institutions. Additionally, the Gram Panchayat has effectively managed a nursery, funded through MGNREGA, for tree planting etc.

PALLE PRAGTHI VANAALU

- The village park project has focused on developing
 0.5 acres of land, incurring a cost of Rs. 72,677.
- ► The maintenance and tree plantation, carried out as part of the MGNREGS scheme encompasses a variety of trees.



MISSION BHAGEERATHA

- Primary objective 100 LPCD of drinking water to every household.
- Among the various services evaluated by the villagers drinking water received the highest ranking.
- ► The water treatment plant is strategically positioned at the village entrance.
- Furthermore, regular cleaning of the overhead water tank is also undertaken as part of the scheme's maintenance efforts.





RYTHU BANDHU (INPUT SUBSIDY) SCHEME

- The scheme offers a financial assistance of Rs. 5000 per acre per season to ensure that farmers have timely access to funds for purchasing agriculture necessities such as seeds, fertilizer and costs associated with preparing their farms.
- As a result, farmers are liberated from relying on money lenders and incurring high interest loans from banks.

SWACHH BHARAT MISSION

- Each household and institution is equipped with toilets.
- A dedicated vehicle is employed for daily garbage collection, additionally, a segregation facility is established to classify biodegradable and non biodegradable waste.
- The biodegradable waste is subsequently transformed into valuable manure through appropriate processes.



KALYANA LAKSHMI/SHADI MUBARAK

- Provides financial support for girl child's wedding at/after marriageable age.
- Total benficiaries under this scheme are 84 (in the last four years).
- The financial assistance is transferred into the bank account of bride's mother.
- Financial aid given per head to the villagers 100016.
- This programme helps avoid early marriages and improve their literacy.
- Women gains independence and empowerment through this programme.

TELANGANA KREEDA PROGRAMME

- To Increase and promote sports Activities in the villages.
- Under this Programme following facilities are provided to the people of Bhavanipet:
 - Playground;
 - ii. Kho-Kho poles;
 - iii. Volleyball Net and Poles;
 - iv. Single bar and double bar dips.



RYTHU BHIMA

- It is a state government scheme in which 5 lakh rupees are paid to the nominee of the farmer on untimely demise of the farmer.
- The farmers who have more than 5 acres of land are not covered under this scheme.
- Total eligible farmers in the Bhavanipet village are 1470.
- Total Bhima beneficiaries are 36.

Types of Pensions in Bhavanipet

- Overall there were 9 types of pension are provided in which total beneficiaries were 771.
- Types of pension were:
 - 1. old age (213* 2016);
 - 2. widow (190* 2016)
 - 3. PWD (64* 2016)
 - 4. Weavers (2016)
 - 5. Beedi workers (2016)
 - 6. Single woman (Divorcee)(2016)
 - 7. AIDS Patients (2016)
 - 8. Filaria (2016)
 - 9. Toddy Tappers (2016)

Bhavanipet village - Development

- Major part of the village is covered by concrete & tar roads.
- Availability of 24/7 electricity.

Agriculture

- Jakulcheru lake developed under mission Kakatiya.
- 70 houses of fishermen called Gangaputra.
- Availability of water for irrigation throughout the year.
- Alternative income source from tadi for farmers.
