ANGANWADI CENTER

Data Collected:

- 1 Anganwadi Teacher, 2 helper to look after 10 children in the Anganwadi center visited by group.

Observation:

- Creative way of teaching children through visualization.
- Nutritious food for children.

16 eggs per month - (0-3 years)

29 eggs per month - (3-6 years) and Milk.

HEALTH SYSTEM REVIEW

Data Collected and Observation:

- Health Sub-Centre under construction, Temporarily working in rented Place.
- 1 Gen Physician, 3 ANMs and 7 ASHA workers.
- Nearby Government Hospital is in Bhupalpally (8km away).
- For safe institutional delivery:
 - Nutritious food (Arogya Lakshmi)
 - Financial assistance (Rs. 12,000 (Boy) and Rs. 13,000 (Girl)) Under KCR Kit Scheme.
- 70% patients are of old age group with problems such as Hypertension and Diabities.
- Attached Lab for regular tests and online report sent on patient's mobile.



DISCUSSION WITH ASHA WORKERS

- Immunisation drive (Wed and Sat) and regular checkups conducted by ASHA Workers.
- House to House Survey for maintaining record of new births, deaths and provide care to lactating mothers.



INTERACTION WITH MGNREGS WORKERS AND OTHER DAILY WAGE WORKERS

Data Collected and Observations

- Total Job Cards: 1881,
- Average days: 100, Average Wage: Rs. 260
- Cost Distribution Ratio - 60:40 (Labour Cost : Material).
- Type of work depends on season eg: Labour work in construction of playgrounds and building, De-silting during Summer, Nursery maintenance etc.
- Daily wages : 500 (men) 400(women) (180 days/year)
- Some of them also do agricultural work.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT

Data Collected and Observation:

- Total SHG Groups: 108
- Each Group consists of 10-15 women.
- 2 VOAs for each group elected by members
- Meeting is scheduled on every fifth day of month .
- Kalyanlakshmi / Shaadi Mubarak (Rs. 1,00,116 for marriage assistance). (64 Beneficiaries)
- Adequate political representation of women. (60% ward members).
- Loan process is digitized.
- SHG is ensuring the independency of women.
- SHG loans are mostly used for opening grocery shops.

SOCIAL REFORM SCHEMES

- Dalit Bandhu Scheme.
- Observations:
 - 10 Beneficiaries
 - Each one of them got 10 lacs as benefit.



PENSIONS (OLD AGE AND WIDOW PENSION)

- Observations:
 - OAPs : 361 Beneficiaries (2016 per person)
 - Widow pensions: 512 Beneficiaries (2016 per persons)

EDUCATION REVIEW – PRIMARY SCHOOL

Data Collected and Observations:

- There are 4 primary schools and one high school.
- 3 private schools.
- 347 Students go to school.
- 28 Teachers
- Availability of drinking water and toilets.
- Primary and high school in same building.
- Bilingual Textbook (English and Telugu) and promoting Hindi Language from Nursery.
- Textbooks / Uniforms are provided by the school.
- Extra curricular activities and regular Sports tournaments.

MID DAY MEAL SCHEME

Data Collected:

- Meal is prepared by SHGs.
- For breakfast TIFFINS are also provided.

Observation:

- Proper Cleanliness in the kitchen.
- Properly cooked nutritious food is provided.
- Use of firewood to cook food. (Clean cooking fuel should be provided to prepare the food such as LPG)

GOVERNMENT SCHEMES FOR AGRICULTURE

- Mission Kakatiya
- Rythu Bandhu
- Rythu Bima
- Rythu Vedika

01 AEO (Agriculture Extension Officer for a cluster (5000 Acres)).

MISSION KAKATIYA

- Mission Kakatiya is a tank restoration and rejuvenation program for minor irrigation projects.
- Motto of this mission "OUR VILLAGE, OUR TANK".
- It is a success to the villagers.



RYTHU BANDHU/ RYTHU BIMA

Data Collected and Observation:

- Rythu Bima beneficiaries – 11 (Age Limit – 18 to 58 yrs.)
- Disbursement of amount through DBT within 7 to 10 days
- Rythu Bandhu beneficiaries – 1810.
- 5000/- per acre per season to the individual.
- Timely payment of eligible amount to the individuals.
- Amount gives financial security to the farmers for farming purpose.
- The given amount is less as per the farmers, they have to borrow money from other sources such as SHGs and Private Lenders.



RYTHU VEDIKA/ PACS

Data Collected and Observation :

- Chelpur has 3 rythu vedikas.
- To provide higher returns to the farmer.
- Meeting on every Tuesday and Friday
- PACS for distribution of fertilizers, agricultural equipment and loans.
- Rythu Vedika:- 1 cluster of 7 villages.
- Good initiative to train farmers on advance method of farming.
- Easy access for farmers to agriculture inputs like seeds, fertilizers etc.
- ◆ Farmers don't take part in that meeting regularly.



ENVIRONMENTAL SCHEMES

- Nursery Maintained by Gram Panchayat with providing employment to MGNREGS workers for making saplings.
- Distribution of 6 saplings to each family per annum to increase green coverage (Fruit bearing, Flower bearing, Tulsi, Neem, Lemon Grass, Curry Leaves).
- A public park is under construction.
- Nursery is not properly maintained.



PALLE PRAKRUTHI VANAMS

- It is community plantation center.
- Manure from decomposition of wet waste used as fertilizer in PPV.

DRINKING WATER

Data Collected and Observation

- Mission Bhageeratha:- 11 Water tanks (7,20,000 L)
- Hand Pumps - 87
- Tap connection to houses- 2952
- Water Treatment plant in Ghanpur(M).
- Daily chlorination of drinking water in village itself.
- Water awareness programme on timely basis.
