Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration

 To Acknowledge, Recognize and Reward the extraordinary and Innovative work done and Excellence in implementing Priority Programmes by Districts! Organizations of the Central and State Governments every year on 21st April

Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration

- Innovations in environment conservation, disaster management, water conservation, energy, education and health, women and child centric initiatives etc.
- In 2018 four priority programmes selected:
 - I. Pradhan Mantri Fasal BimaYojana
 - II. Promoting Digital Payments
 - III. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban & Rural
 - IV. Deen Dayal Upadhayay Grameen Kaushalya Yojana(DDUGKY)

Eligibility

- Awards for implementation of Priority Programme: District Implementing Unit.
- Awards for Innovation: Organizations of Central! State Governments! Districts.
- Performance assessment period 1st April 2016 to 31st
 December 2017.

Number of Awards

- Grouping of states/ UTs for awards in priority programmes:
 - Group 1 North-East States (8) and Hill States (J&K, HP, Uttarakhand) =1
 - Group 2 -Union Territories = 7
 - Group 3 Remaining States = 18
- For each group in an identified priority programme, there is one award. the maximum number of awards are 12.
- Two awards for organizations of central/ state governments/ districts for innovation in public governance, of which one shall be given to a backward district. there is no grouping of states

Composition of award

- The award consist of :
 - ♦ (i) Trophy♦ (ii) Scroll.
- The awarded District/ Organization is given an incentive of Rs. Ten lakh, to be utilized for implementation of project/ programme or bridging resource gaps in any area of public welfare.

Evaluations criteria

- The Priority Programme is evaluated on the basis of predetermined parameters in consultation with Line Ministry/ Department.
- The awards for Innovations is evaluated on the basis of :
 - Introducing and implementing an innovative idea/ scheme/project to meet stake holders' requirement.
 - Bringing perceptible improvements in processes/ systems and building institutions.
 - Making public delivery systems responsive, transparent and efficient, particularly by leveraging technology.
- Preparedness/ performance in emergent situations, disasters like cyclone, earthquake, flood etc.

Processing of applications:

- Applications are received through online.
- Step I: Short-listing of districts / organization by the screening committee
- Step II: Short-listing after feed back from beneficiaries
 / stake holders received through call centers.
- Step III: evaluation by the expert committee –field verification.
- Step IV: Recommendation of the empowered
- o committee- presentation by the applicant.
- Step V: Approval of the Prime Minister.
