ORDER:

In pursuance of the State Training Initiative the Government have decided to decentralise the training effort by establishing District Training Centres and Regional Training Centres. In the G.O. read above orders were issued appointing the District Collectors as the District Training Commissioners.

- 2. The question of developing the infrastructure for the District Training Centres came up for discussion and reviewed in the Collectors Conference held on 12th and 13th April 1999. In the said conference the suggestion made by the Director General. Dr. Marri Chenna Reddy Human Resource Development Institute of A.P. in regard to the utilisation of the existing training infrastructure in all the districts was accepted and it was decided that the Collectors my integrate the proposed training centres with the existing training institutes instead of creating parallel infrastructure.
- 3. Training infrastructure relating to different departments of the Government is already existing in the districts in the nature of District Institute for Education and Training (DIET). Village Development Officers training Centres. District Training and Technology Centre etc.
- 4. Government after careful examination have considered that instead of creating parallel infrastructure for the proposed District Training Centre. It is felt advisable to integrate them with the existing training infrastructure already available in the district or proposed to be crated in the district so that a well defined District Training Complex in each district could be developed and accordingly permit the Collectors to integrate the District Training Centres with the existing of proposed training infrastructure in the district.

5. This does not require the concurrence of Finance Department.
