Dr. MCR HRD Institute Conducts Army Symposium for the Trainee Civil Servants

Dr. MCR HRD Institute of Telangana conducted an Army Symposium on November 15th, 2017 for the 207 All India Services and Central Civil Services Officers who are attending the 92nd Foundation Course. The objective of the event was to sensitise them on issues relating to national security.

Major General N Srinivas Rao, General Officer Commanding, Telangana and Andhra Sub Area was the Chief Guest at the event. In his keynote address on “Shaping Our Immediate Neighbourhood: India’s Biggest Security Challenge”, Major General Rao said that the national security environment of the country and the neighbourhood has become particularly challenging due to its complexity. He covered a wide range of issues with respect to the existing neighbourhood scenario and recommended strategies and the way forward for dealing with them. Major General Rao gave away Gold, Silver, and Bronze Medals to Sri Mohit Handa, IPS, Sri Ganesh Kumar (IPoS), and Sri Wavhal Vaibhav Balasaheb, IRS (C & CE), respectively in the Army Essay Competition 2017, conducted by the Army HQ for the All India Services and Central Civil Services officers.
