When did RTI come in to force?

- 15th June 2005 President of India gave assent

In how many days should government appoint PIO & Asst.PIOs?

- 100 days from the date of assent of President

Proactive disclosure by Public authorities to be completed by ?

- 120 days from enactment i.e June 15, 2005

How many Chapters and Sections?

- Six Chapters and 31 sections

Who is a public authority?

- Bodies under constitution, law, act, NGOs if substantially funded by govt.

Obligations of public authority ?

- Appoint PIO/APIO, Access to records, Communicate reasons to affected persons in quasi-judicial cases, publish information

PIO give information in how many days?

- 30 days, 48 hours in case of life/liberty

Should applicant give reason for seeking information ?

- No

Can PIO give third party information?

- Not directly, give notice in 5 days, time to represent in 10 days, if public interest outweighs can give even if third party objects

Can information in note file be given
under RTI?

- Yes

In how many days should first appeal
be disposed?

- 30 days

To whom should second appeal be preferred?

- State information commission, to be disposed in 90 days

What is the minimum penalty for delay in giving information?

- Rs.250 per day, maximum so far Rs. 25,000/-
