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
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What is Leadership?

- IGNORANT TOWARDS OTHER'S



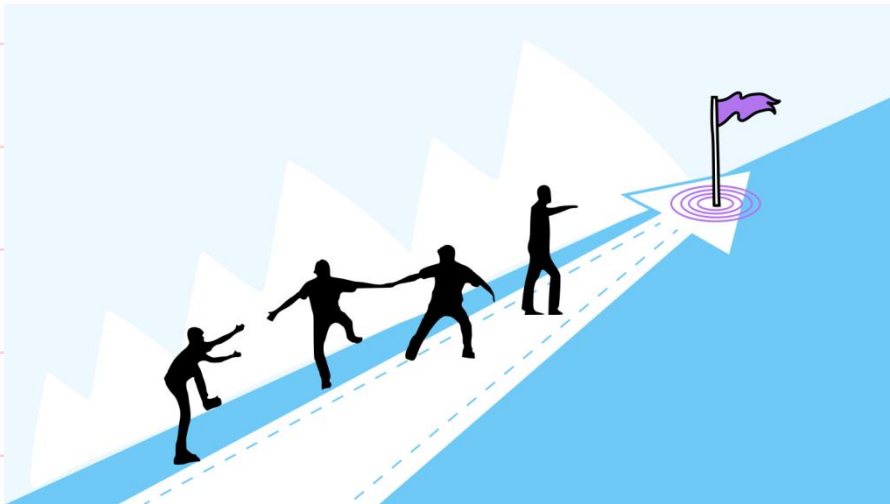
TRAITS TO BE EMULATED
