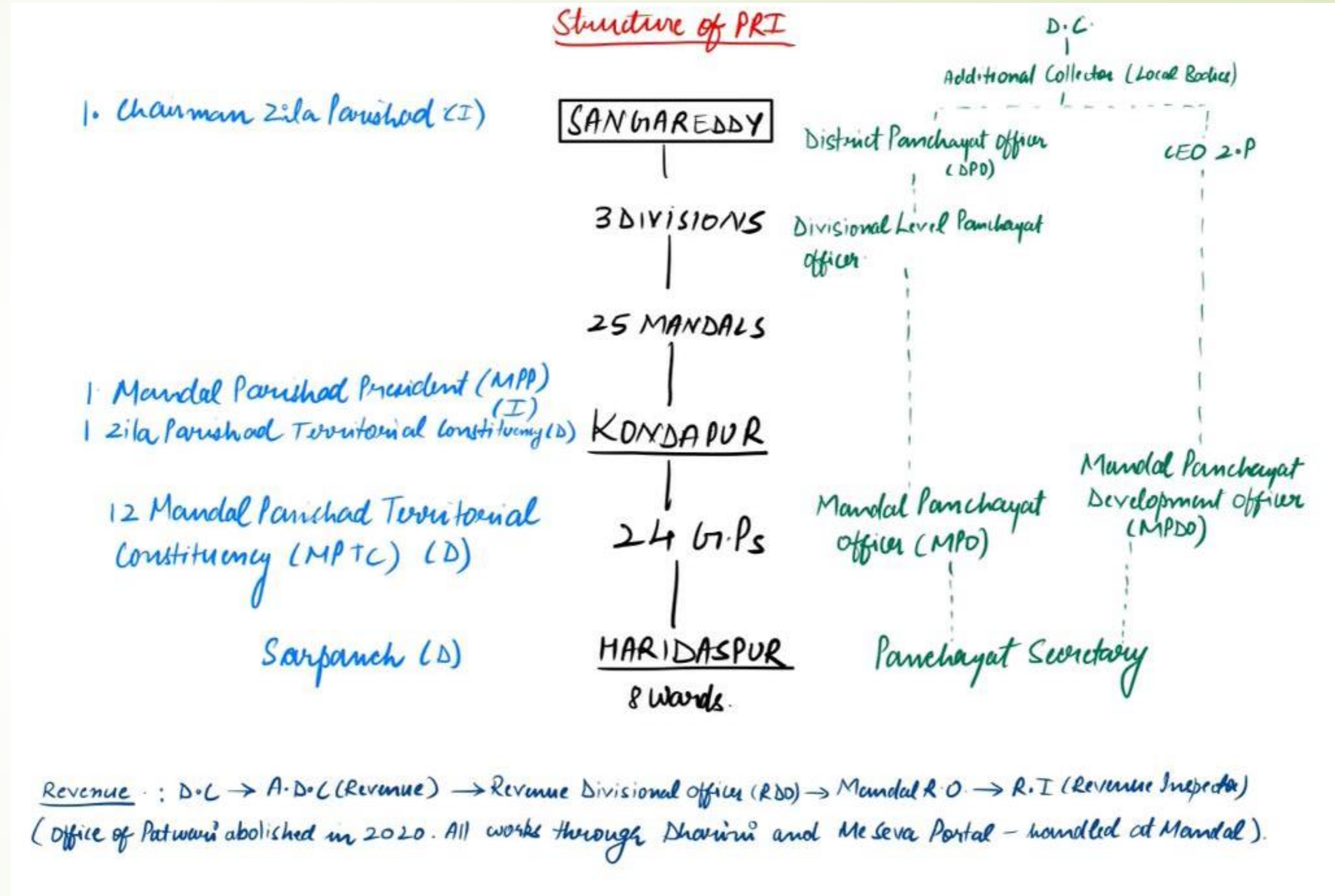
Social Map

- Celebration of girl child is being celebrated at GP office with villagers.

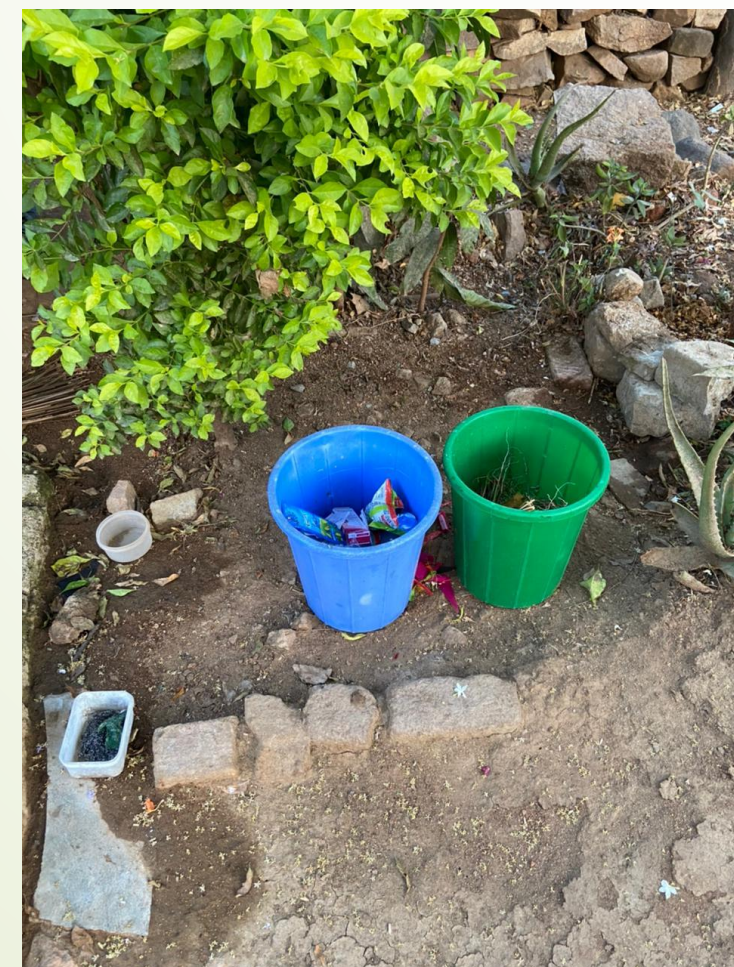


Timeline

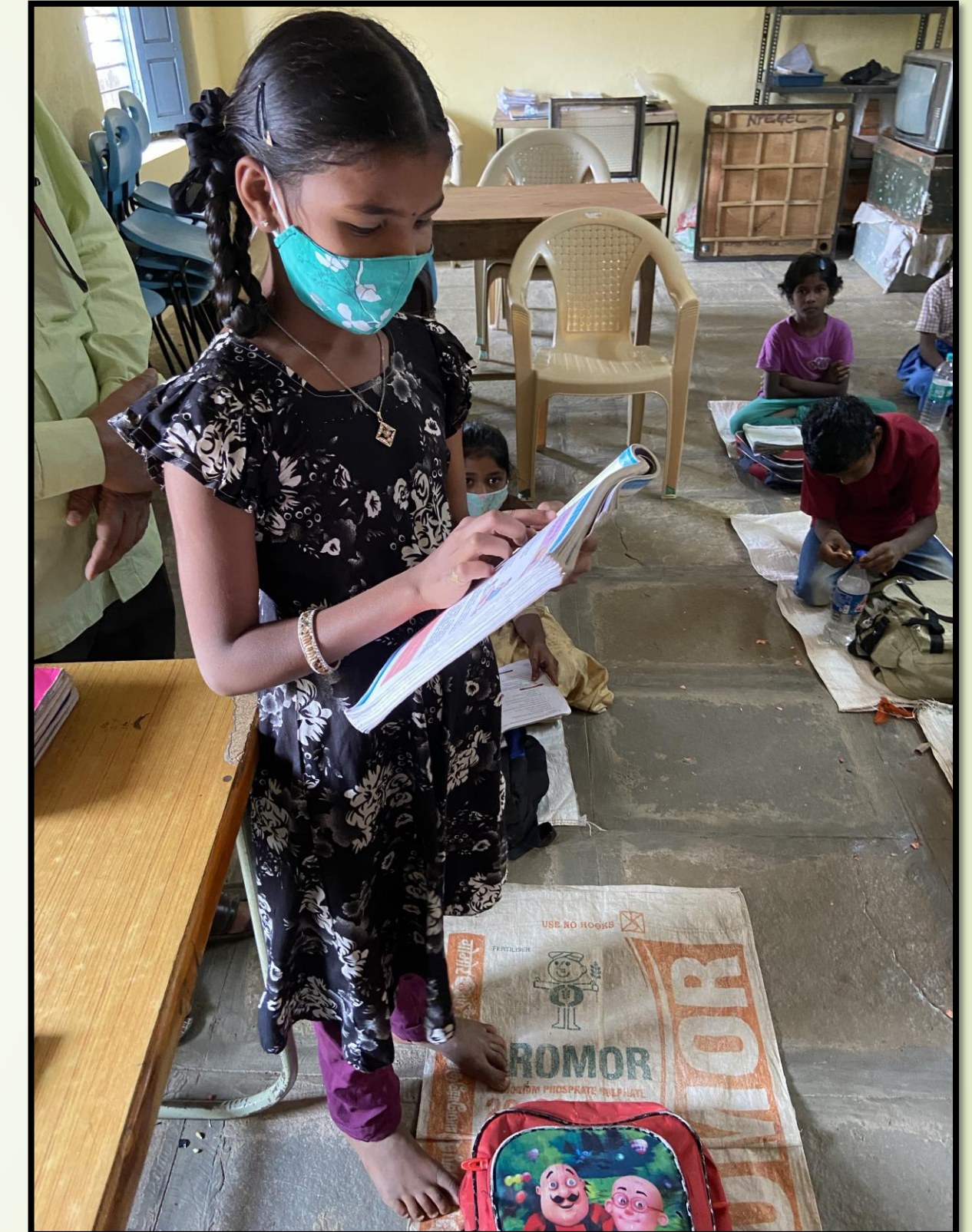
