

KARIMNAGAR


- ▶ Major urban agglomeration and fifth largest City in the state
- ▶ 2 revenue division(Karimnagar & Huzurabad) and 16 mandals
- ▶ Population of 4,97,447 with literacy rate of 89.9%

RUKMAPUR VILLAGE


- ▶ Choppadandi Mandal in Karimnagar District







AREAS TO BE IMPROVED

- ▶ Sports Facility and regular PT classes
- ▶ Library
- ▶ Extracurricular Activity
- ▶ Infrastructure in Anganwadis
- ▶ Lab Facility
- ▶ Infrastructure deficiencies in furniture, comp/science labs, hostel beds, library

HEALTH

- ▶ PHC under construction
- ▶ Health Sub Centre with 1 Doctor, 2 ANM and 3 ASHA workers
- ▶ Disease profile- Diabetes, Hypertension
- ▶ Ambulance service-108
- ▶ Safe drinking water is available- Mission Bhagirathi/Bore wells
- ▶ 100% institutional delivery
- ▶ 100% immunization of children
- ▶ PHC- 7Kms(Choppadandi-mandal)
- ▶ DHC- 13Kms(Karimnagar)
- ▶ Nearest private hospital is around 12 Kms away

FOCUS ON DISEASE PREVENTION

AGRICULTURE

- ▶ Agriculture is the major occupation
- ▶ Major crop- paddy – two seasons
- ▶ Other crops- Sunflower, Maize, Cotton
- ▶ Approx 2000 acres of land under cultivation
- ▶ Irrigation - Canal irrigation and Bore wells
- ▶ 80%- red soil, 20% - black soil
- ▶ 100% mechanised harvesting
- ▶ One government procurement centre in the village
- ▶ Two rice mill

ISSUES

- ▶ Monoculture of Paddy in both Rabhi and Kharif seasons
- ▶ Storage godowns and drying platforms are inadequate. Farmers sell their produce immediately after harvest.

SUGGESTIONS

- ▶ Need to diversify crop pattern. To maintain soil fertility and reduce crop failure risks
- ▶ Need for awareness about organic farming practices
- ▶ Scientific livestock development

PANCHAYATI RAJ INSTITUTION(PRI)

- ▶ Gramsabha meetings held regularly
- ▶ Participation from vulnerable sections – women and SC/ST communities
- ▶ Major decisions during Gramsabha meeting :-
 1. Construction of CC roads and closed drainage.
 2. To address water leakage issue
 3. Installation of street lights
- ▶ General perception that good work is done by the gram panchayat

SUGGESTIONS

- ▶ Training for gram panchayat members for better understanding of their duties and PRI proceeding especially women
- ▶ Record keeping can be digitized
- ▶ Awareness to be created among people – to increase participation in the gram sabha meetings.
- ▶ Participation is less in gram sabhas as gram sabhas are held during daytime when labourers go for work.

- ▶ 100% household with toilets
- ▶ Door to door collection of waste
- ▶ Segregation of Dry & Wet Waste and Dumping Yard
- ▶ Roads were clean and maintained
- ▶ Open Drainage
- ▶ Soak pits for water conservation
- ▶ RO Plant as source of drinking water



SELF HELP GROUPS

- ▶ Around 67 SHGs in the village
- ▶ 452 members
- ▶ Provides financial independence
- ▶ Total 23.52 Cr loan from banks
- ▶ Srinidhi organization is also lending money to SHGs
- ▶ Engaged in Vegetable farming, Kirana Shops, Carpentry, Livestock production, Tailoring etc
- ▶ Empowerment of women in the village


