Burgula Village


- It is the birth place of the first elected CM of Hyderabad state (1952-1956) Mr. Burgula Ramakrishna Rao.









Social map Of Burgula village

Rythu Vedika

- Rythu vedikas are unique structures built under Rythu samanvaya samitis, where farmers come together and discuss about agriculture.
- It is a big building which is used for farmers meeting and and grains storage as well.
- It will be maintained by Rythu samanvaya samiti chairman and the mandal Agricultural extension officer.



Vaikuntha dhamam

- A village crematorium.
- Built with an expenditure of Rs 12 Lakhs.
- It has 2 changing rooms for men and women.
- 2 burning beds for burning dead bodies.



Mission Bhagiratha

- Tap drinking water to all households.
- A gram panchayat water tap is also available.



Visit to fields

- Visited ground nut, paddy crops and orchards.
- Good availability of water resources through ground water, rain water and mission Bhagiratha.
- Farmers are informed about Govt initiatives by Agri extension officer.
- Farmers getting input subsidy through Rythu Bandhu.
- Farmers shifting from Paddy to other crops on Govt instructions.



Visit to the Nursery

- Nursery developed under Telangana ku Haritha Haram scheme.
- Two types plantation available -
 - Avenue plantation
 - Horticulture plantation
- 1 Lakh saplings planted in last year.

Visit to Primary school

- Number of students 161
 - Boys 89
 - Girls 71
- Teacher strength 5
- The school land was donated by Burgula family.
- Issues:
 - Single washroom for whole school and staff.
 - Head Master post is vacant.
 - Lack of extra curricular like sports.
 - Pending and untimely wage payment to mid day meal staff.

Visit to High school

- School strength 396
 - Boys 218
 - Girls 178
- Staff 16 teachers
- Achieved 100% pass percentage in last 3 yrs
- Issues:
 - Caste mentioned in attendance roll.
 - Head Master post vacant.
 - No attender and sweeper.
 - Poor maintenance of computer lab.
 - Outdated library with old books.





Visit to Anganwadi school

- Staff 1 teacher and 1 worker.
- Provides admission to small children as play school.
- Provides quality food to infants, lactating mothers and school kids.
- Issues:
 - Small school premises congested.
 - Lack of toilets.





Visit to Primary Health centre

- Well maintained PHC serving to 45,858 people.
- Many NGOs and companies are providing medical equipment. Eg: Rotopack, a company nearby has donated 10 medical beds.
- Has 8 sub centres with 8 ANMs and 35 ASHAs.
- Average footfall per day is 50-60 patients.

• Issues:

- Doctor position is vacant and is given as an incharge to adjacent PHC doctor.
- Patients visiting RMP (Rural Medical Practitioner) in emergency cases.

Ayurvedic tablets - first time manufactured in Telangana, instead of powder.







MGNREGA work site - De-silting lake



Villagers owning up works and enthusiastically participating.

• Issues:

- Late wage payment.
- SC community workers getting late wages.
- Only one Engineering Consultant (EC) for 17 mandals to assess work site.
- Poor assessment of work by Field Assistant leading to low wages. Eg: The maximum payment was Rs.240 but majority were paid around Rs.186.



- Interacted with SHG members 44 groups (440 members)
- Loan received and some invested in capital goods like cows. While some used for personal use like house construction, educational expenses, etc.

• Issues :-

- Most loan was utilised for personal use.
- Lack of guidance on financial management and lack of entrepreneurial activities by SHG members.
