SCHOOL (UPS)


- Books & uniform provided to children


HEALTH

- **No PHC** in Village , nearest PHC is 5km away & nearest CHC is 8km away
- 1 ANM & 7 ASHA Workers looking after 6 villages
- **100%** deliveries in Hospitals
- **100%** Vaccination for everyone above 15 years of age
- **KCR Kit** –
 - all essentials to women who gives birth in Hospital
 - financial assistance of Rs. 13000 on birth of Baby Girl & Rs. 12000 on birth of Baby Boy
 - App where ANM workers enter data of all pregnant women keeping track of Delivery dates, Vaccination & other events during pregnancy
- **Transportation issues** for Health Workers



AGRICULTURE

- Total land holding is 3553 acres
- Practise Mechanised Agriculture
- Presence of NSP Left canal & Minor canals
- Mainly **two Crops** – Paddy & Cotton
- **Limited Diversification** of crop due to low productivity and MSP (Groundnut, Orange)
- No organic farming/sustainable farming
- **YANTRA LAKSHMI** scheme now not Functional
- **RYTHU BANDHU** scheme – big farmers benefitting more








