








- Clear social demarcation s observed on caste lines and religious lines

- Households having all amenities, like drinking water, under ground drainage etc





CHEGUR VILLAGE MAP IN RANGOLI







- Since the village is fairly urbanised and the industries nearby provide employment constantly there is less demand for the MGNREG




- ALL HOUSES IN THE VILLAGE HAS TOILET FACILITY
