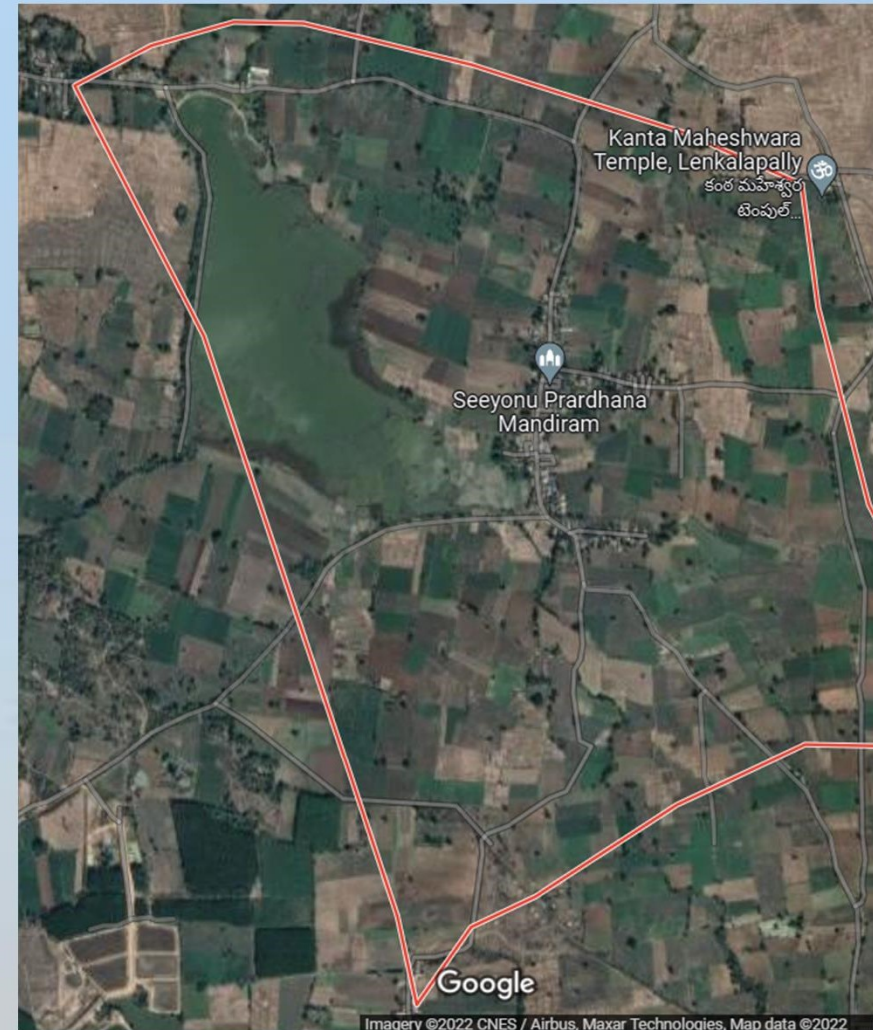

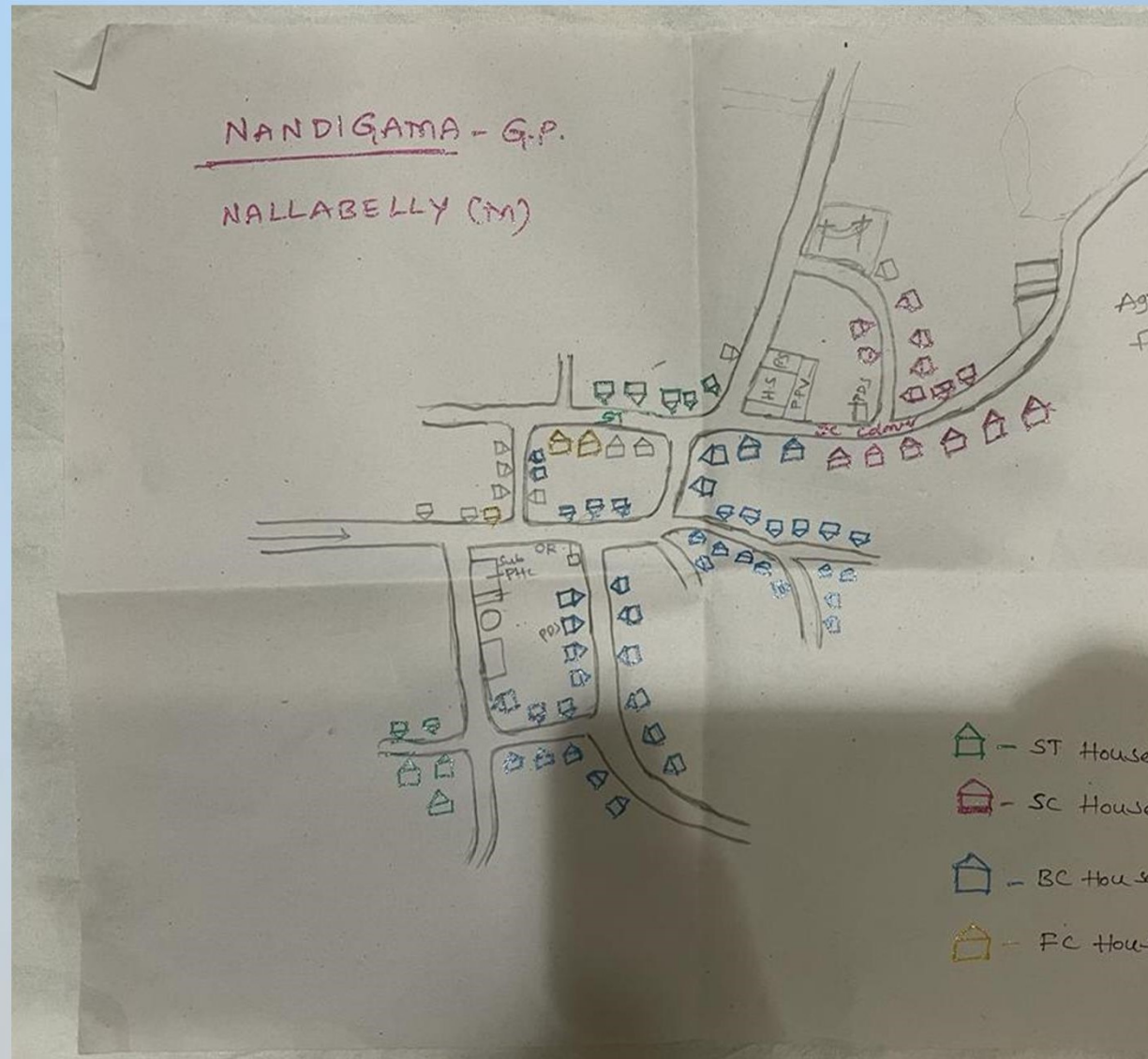

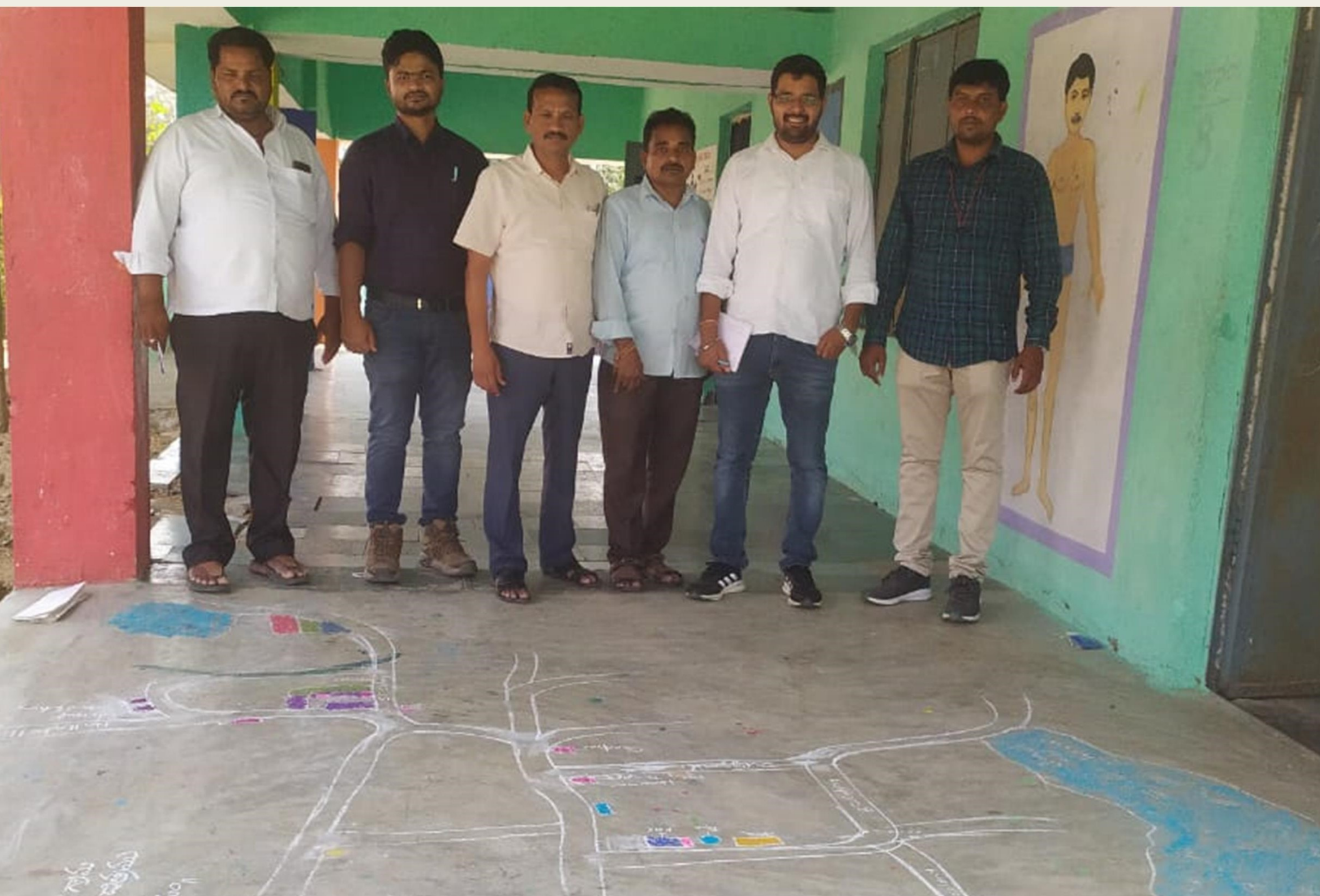

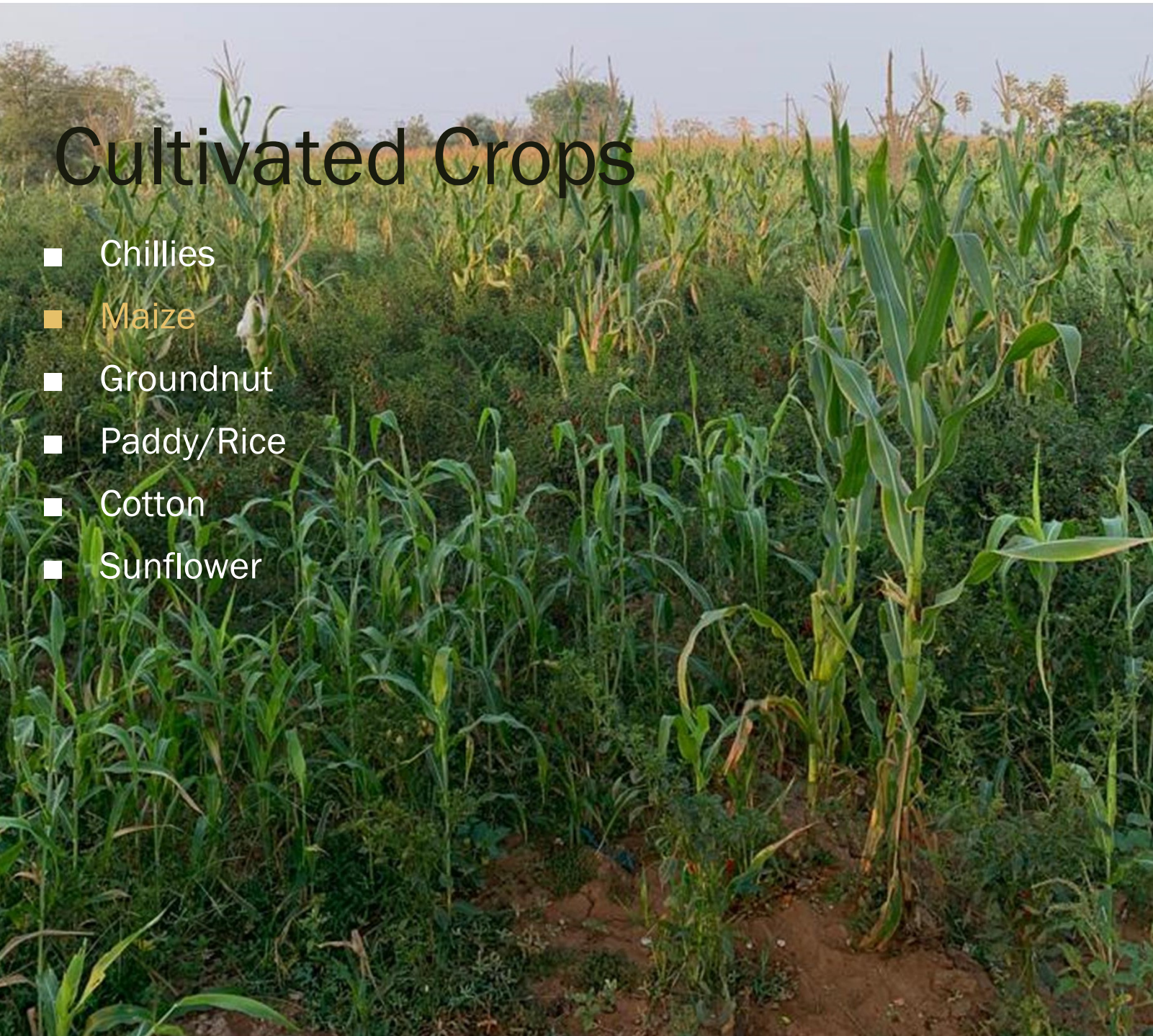

❖ Telangana ku Haritha Haram- Nursery

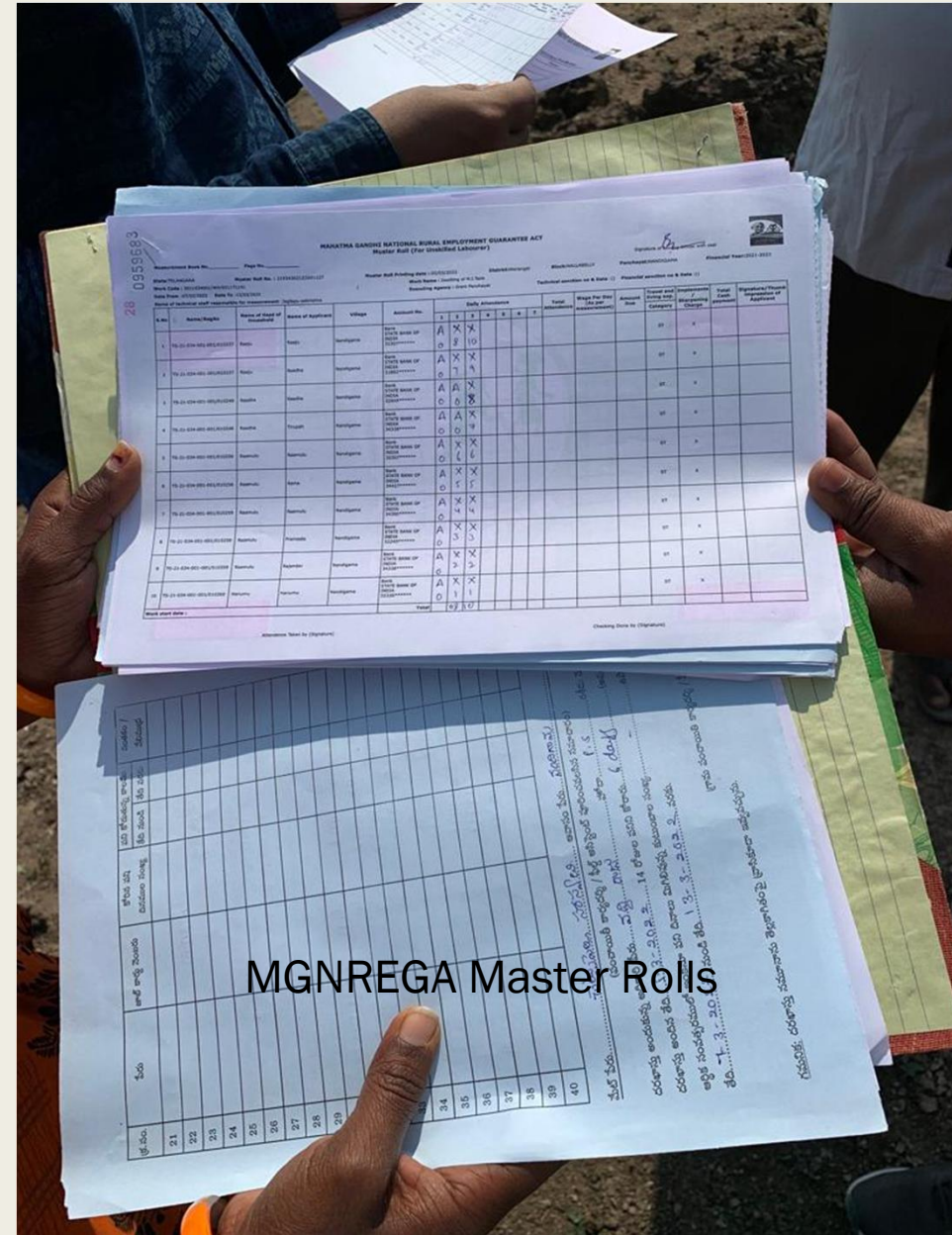


❖ MGNREGA

Issues:

- Lack of transport facility to reach PHC
- Awareness driven counselling sessions required
- Timely delivery of stipends should be ensured
- Fixed salary of ASHA
- Need of flexible staff for delivery at night

Self Help Group

Observations:

- 63 SHGs having 620 members.
- 100% household link to SHGs
- They were getting timely loans
- Many have had diversified businesses started like Kirana shop, dairy, beauty salons and boutiques
- Decisions were based on consensus
- Interaction with two SHGs - Venkateshwara Group and Geetanjali Group



Issues:

- Agricultural and family responsibilities as hindrance
- Lack of skills/upgaradation
- Lack of formal education and Inadequate assured institutional credit
- Biased decisions

Village Development Action Plan



- PRA Tools
- - Paired Ranking Tool was applied to get sense of priority of local needs like School Infrastructure Improvement, Skill Training/Upgradation, Commercial Dairy Development.
- -Venn Diagram Analysis with a lot of brainstorming with all stakeholders like, adult male and female, elders, children, etc, done we get know that School, PHC, AWC, PDS, GP, Banking/Post Office.

Reflections and Suggestions

■ **Agriculture:** Crop Diversification, Development of Food Processing Industry based on Hub & Spoke and Cluster Model and, and Water Budgeting

■ **SHGs:** Skill Upgradation, Financial Inclusion and Entrepreneurship Development

■ **Institutions:** Women-led Development to discourage practice of “Sarpanch Pati”, Regular GS Meetings, Quality School Infrastructure

■ **Sanitation and Water Supply:** Lined drainage systems, Regulated Quantity RO Water Outflow
