

- Population: 933 members
- Households: 231
- Total Area: 473 Ha.
- Agriculture Area: 343.96 Ha
- Adjacent to Bangalore Hyderabad Highway, High land value
- 1 Upper Primary School upto class 7th
- Low adult literacy – 57%
- High enrolment in schemes
- Semi clustered settlements
- Good work in sanitation: 7 Awards

Infrastructure

- Total 2KM stretch has not been covered by Cement Concrete road
- Only 2 stretches are covered with CC road, remaining 7 stretches are non motorable
- Villagers face problems in commuting during rainy season and day to day work

Employment and Skill Development

- Factory closure resulted in unemployment, CSR Activities stopped
- Mid aged and Older women suffered the most
- District Training Program not convenient
- Concept of Multipurpose Worker resulted in job loss of unskilled
- Huge demand of Skill Development training at village level



Meeting: Discussion on Skill development and unemployment

Health

- No PHC in the village
- Difficulty in getting timely transport biggest challenge
- Nearest PHC in Rajapur and Jadcharla
- No regular medical check up camps for Sugar, BP, Cataract etc
- No disbursal of monetary benefits under KCR Kit scheme
- Limited knowledge about Health Insurance Benefits
- Good performance in Institutional Delivery

Education

Positives:

- Learning outcomes of students in Language and arithmetic were good.
- Separate playing area with amenities is well maintained
- Modes of Digital learning such as TV are used



Visit to School

Issues:

- Only 3 rooms to accommodate students of 7 different classes
- No table and chair facility for students
- No uniform and book distribution took place after COVID

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Mission Bhagiratha

- Source: Kollur reservoir - Kalavakurthi
- Udandapur project : Water for agriculture
- 100% piped water supply
- One Overhead storage reservoir(OHSR) in village
- Flow control valve system and its misuse

Order of factors responsible for poverty:

Landlessness > Factory closure > Lack of training > Indebtness > Ignorance of schemes = Illiteracy > Immigration

Recommendations:

- CC road sanction to improve the lives of villagers
- Improve transport facilities using NRLM or Dalitbandhu
- Skill development programs at village level given the fact that one factory on which most of the people were dependent were closed last year.
- PDS quality of rice can be improved.
- Salary of teacher working on volunteer basis without receiving salary should be looked into.
- Up gradation of school infrastructure
- Intervention to improve the speed of water in taps
- Regular check-up medical camps for sugar, BP,
- Compartmentalisation of class rooms
- School teacher shortage
