





## **PRA Activities**: *Transect Walk*










### Transect Walk - Observations

- Vegetation: Dry and moist deciduous (Neem, Teak etc)
  - Agriculture- Maize, Cotton, Paddy, Chillies etc
    - Irrigation: Mostly tube wells, wells and lakes
    - Good plantation all around
    - Road- Metalled road & Kutcha road
  - Habitation: Mix of Pucca and mud wall houses











## **Quality of Life**: Sanitation

- Door to door garbage is collected everyday with the help of tractor and trolley
- Garbage is properly segregated at dumping ground







## **Quality of Life**: Sanitation .... Contd

- The compost prepared from dumping ground is used for monkey feeding plantation
- Toilets: 100% families reported construction and usage of toilets





#### **Crematorium**

- Crematorium constructed in 2020 which has facilities like washrooms, solar lamps, water tank etc.
- All people use same crematorium irrespective of their caste or creed

#### Major crops:

- ✓ Paddy
- ✓ Maize
- ✓ Cotton

#### • Irrigation:

- o Tubewells
- Wells
- Lakes
- o Tanks

#### Problems anticipated:

- Water scarcity
- Supply of labour for cultivation
- Soil degradation due to flood irrigation

#### Recommendations:

- Cultivation of Paddy only for Kharif
- For Rabi crops shifting to Maize, Groundnut, Millets, Sunflower etc

## **SHG** Meeting

- 100% households linked to SHG
- Most of the women successfully got the loans and repaid back
- Total 14 SHG groups are functional
- Regular meetings are held and issues are being solved
- Issue
  - SHG groups don't have building or community hall of their own and are using Gram Panchayat building for their meetings
- Actions taken from group
  - During debriefing with District Collector, matter was highlighted





## **Poverty Alleviation Programmes**

- Social Assistance Programmes:
  - No of Aasara pensions: 73
- MGNREGA: Mostly during Summer season
   MGNREGA activities are undertaken
  - No of Job cards: 175
- Food Security schemes:
  - No of Food Security Cards: 168
  - Only Rice is provided

# **Conclusion**: *Weaknesses, Opportunities & Threats*

#### Weaknesses:

- Poor connectivity
- Low livestock population and hence complete reliance on farming
- Absence of local crafts that can be commercialised

#### **Threats:**

- Out-migration of educated youth due to Pull Factors
- Shortage of workforce

#### **Opportunities:**

- Convergence with skill development would be helpful to the SHGs.
- Diversification of crops
- Local youth can be given training in tailoring and other activities
- Mechanised cultivation and harvesting
- Farm based commercial activities like Rice mill etc
- Animal husbandry, poultry farming
