Language is called a complex skill comprising the skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. It is this complexity, of language, differs from others skill like driving, swimming and dancing etc., they have to be learnt at different stages.

At primary levels of learning, there are four general skills to be learnt by pupils they are.

- 1. Listening
- 2. Reading
- 3. Speaking
- 4. Writing
- ➤ 1 & 3 are known as passive or receptive or decoding or comprehensive skills
- > 2 & 4 are called active or production or encoding or expensive or creative skills

At higher levels different skills are there. They are literary appreciation, translation, creation – thinking problem solving, correspondence etc..
